The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) appreciates the opportunity to respond to the above-referenced U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) notice.

The EPA's July 17, 2015 notice proposes SIP approval of several TCEQ rules relating to minor NSR permitting and public notice requirements for portable facilities. Specifically, the EPA is proposing to approve 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §§ 116.20 and 116.178, which respectively contain definitions pertaining to portable facilities and provisions for the relocation and change of location of portable facilities. The EPA is also proposing to approve provisions relating to public notice for portable facilities at 30 TAC § 39.402(a)(12).

The TCEQ concurs with the EPA's determination that the Portable Facilities program codified in these rules meets the applicable requirements of the Federal Clean Air Act, and the TCEQ supports the EPA's proposed approval of the rules covered in the notice as revisions to the Texas SIP.
