PROBLEM 1

A particle of mass  $m$  is confined to a one-dimensional infinite potential well of width  $a$ . The wave function is given by  $\psi(x) = \sqrt{\frac{2}{a}} \sin\left(\frac{n\pi x}{a}\right)$  for  $0 < x < a$  and zero elsewhere. Calculate the probability of finding the particle in the region  $0 < x < \frac{a}{4}$ .

Solution: The probability is given by

$$P = \int_0^{a/4} |\psi(x)|^2 dx = \int_0^{a/4} \frac{2}{a} \sin^2\left(\frac{n\pi x}{a}\right) dx$$

$$= \frac{2}{a} \int_0^{a/4} \frac{1 - \cos\left(\frac{2n\pi x}{a}\right)}{2} dx = \frac{1}{a} \left[ x - \frac{a}{2n\pi} \sin\left(\frac{2n\pi x}{a}\right) \right]_0^{a/4}$$

$$= \frac{1}{a} \left[ \frac{a}{4} - \frac{a}{2n\pi} \sin\left(\frac{n\pi}{2}\right) \right] = \frac{1}{4} - \frac{\sin\left(\frac{n\pi}{2}\right)}{2n\pi}$$

$$= \frac{1}{4} - \frac{(-1)^{(n-1)/2}}{2n\pi} \quad \text{for } n \text{ odd}$$

$$= \frac{1}{4} \quad \text{for } n \text{ even}$$

$$= \frac{1}{4} - \frac{\sin\left(\frac{n\pi}{2}\right)}{2n\pi} \quad \text{for } n \text{ even}$$

$$= \frac{1}{4} - \frac{0}{2n\pi} = \frac{1}{4}$$

$$= \frac{1}{4} - \frac{\sin\left(\frac{n\pi}{2}\right)}{2n\pi} \quad \text{for } n \text{ odd}$$

**AGREED ORDER**  
**DOCKET NO. 2006-1291-DCL-E**

**I. JURISDICTION AND STIPULATIONS**

At its \_\_\_\_\_ agenda, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality ("the Commission" or "TCEQ") considered this agreement of the parties, resolving an enforcement action regarding Gulamali Bandali dba Afton Oaks Cleaners ("Mr. Bandali") under the authority of TEX. HEALTH & SAFETY CODE ch. 374 and TEX. WATER CODE ch. 7. The Executive Director of the TCEQ, through the Enforcement Division, and Mr. Bandali appear before the Commission and together stipulate that:

1. Mr. Bandali owns and operates a dry cleaning drop station at 725 International Boulevard, Houston, Harris County, Texas (the "Facility").
2. The TCEQ has general authority to regulate the Facility pursuant to TEX. HEALTH & SAFETY CODE § 374.051.
3. The Commission and Mr. Bandali agree that the Commission has jurisdiction to enter this Agreed Order, and that Mr. Bandali is subject to the Commission's jurisdiction.
4. Mr. Bandali received notice of the violations alleged in Section II ("Allegations") on or about August 13, 2006.
5. The occurrence of any violation is in dispute and the entry of this Agreed Order shall not constitute an admission by Mr. Bandali of any violation alleged in Section II ("Allegations"), nor of any statute or rule.
6. An administrative penalty in the amount of One Thousand One Hundred Eighty-Five Dollars (\$1,185) is assessed by the Commission in settlement of the violations alleged in Section II ("Allegations"). Mr. Bandali has paid Nine Hundred Forty-Eight Dollars (\$948) of the administrative penalty and Two Hundred Thirty-Seven Dollars (\$237) is deferred contingent upon Mr. Bandali's timely and satisfactory compliance with all the terms of this Agreed Order. The deferred amount will be waived upon full compliance with the terms of this Agreed Order. If Mr.



- Bandali fails to timely and satisfactorily comply with all requirements of this Agreed Order, the Executive Director may require Mr. Bandali to pay all or part of the deferred penalty.
7. Any notice and procedures which might otherwise be authorized or required in this action are waived in the interest of a more timely resolution of the matter.
  8. The Executive Director of the TCEQ and Mr. Bandali have agreed on a settlement of the matters alleged in this enforcement action, subject to the approval of the Commission.
  9. The Executive Director may, without further notice or hearing, refer this matter to the Office of the Attorney General of the State of Texas ("OAG") for further enforcement proceedings if the Executive Director determines that Mr. Bandali has not complied with one or more of the terms or conditions in this Agreed Order.
  10. This Agreed Order shall terminate five years from its effective date or upon compliance with all the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreed Order, whichever is later.
  11. The provisions of this Agreed Order are deemed severable and, if a court of competent jurisdiction or other appropriate authority deems any provision of this Agreed Order unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall be valid and enforceable.

## **II. ALLEGATIONS**

As owner and operator of the Facility, Mr. Bandali is alleged to have failed to complete and submit the required registration form to the TCEQ for the Facility, in violation of 30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 337.10(a) and TEX. HEALTH & SAFETY CODE § 374.102, as documented during an investigation conducted on May 24, 2006.

## **III. DENIALS**

Mr. Bandali generally denies each allegation in Section II ("Allegations").

## **IV. ORDERING PROVISIONS**

1. It is, therefore, ordered by the TCEQ that Mr. Bandali pay an administrative penalty as set forth in Section I, Paragraph 6 above. The payment of this administrative penalty and Mr. Bandali's compliance with all the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreed Order resolve only the allegations in Section II. The Commission shall not be constrained in any manner from requiring corrective action or penalties for violations which are not raised here. 2. It is further ordered that Mr. Bandali shall undertake the following technical requirements:
- a. Within 15 days after the effective date of this Agreed Order, complete and submit the required drycleaner and/or drop station registration form for the Facility, in accordance with 30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE ch. 337 to:

- b. Within 30 days after the effective date of this Agreed Order, submit written certification of compliance with Ordering Provision 2.a. as described below:

The certification shall include detailed supporting documentation including receipts, and/or other records to demonstrate compliance, be notarized by a State of Texas Notary Public and include the following certification language:

"I certify under penalty of law that I have personally examined and am familiar with the information submitted and all attached documents, and that based on my inquiry of those individuals immediately responsible for obtaining the information, I believe that the submitted information is true, accurate and complete. I am aware that there are significant penalties for submitting false information, including the possibility of fine and imprisonment for knowing violations."

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3. The provisions of this Agreed Order shall apply to and be binding upon Mr. Bandali. Mr. Bandali is ordered to give notice of the Agreed Order to personnel who maintain day-to-day control over the Facility operations referenced in this Agreed Order.
4. If Mr. Bandali fails to comply with any of the Ordering Provisions in this Agreed Order within the prescribed schedules, and that failure is caused solely by an act of God, war, strike, riot, or other catastrophe, Mr. Bandali's failure to comply is not a violation of this Agreed Order. Mr. Bandali shall have the burden of establishing to the Executive Director's satisfaction that such an event has occurred. Mr. Bandali shall notify the Executive Director within seven days after Mr. Bandali becomes aware of a delaying event and shall take all reasonable measures to mitigate and minimize any delay.
5. The Executive Director may grant an extension of any deadline in this Agreed Order or in any plan, report, or other document submitted pursuant to this Agreed Order, upon a written and substantiated showing of good cause. All requests for extensions by Mr. Bandali shall be made in writing to the Executive Director. Extensions are not effective until Mr. Bandali receives written approval from the Executive Director. The determination of what constitutes good cause rests solely with the Executive Director.
6. This Agreed Order, issued by the Commission, shall not be admissible against Mr. Bandali in a civil proceeding, unless the proceeding is brought by the OAG to: (1) enforce the terms of this Agreed Order; or (2) pursue violations of a statute within the Commission's jurisdiction, or of a rule adopted or an order or permit issued by the Commission under such a statute.
7. This agreement may be executed in multiple counterparts, which together shall constitute a single original instrument. Any executed signature page to this Agreement may be transmitted by facsimile transmission to the other parties, which shall constitute an original signature for all purposes.
8. Under 30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 70.10(b), the effective date is the date of hand-delivery of the Order to Mr. Bandali, or three days after the date on which the Commission mails notice of the Order to Mr. Bandali, whichever is earlier. The Chief Clerk shall provide a copy of this Agreed Order to each of the parties.
