I. JURISDICTION AND STIPULATIONS

At its _____ agenda, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality ("the Commission" or "TCEQ") considered this agreement of the parties, resolving an enforcement action regarding F. Basra Inc dba Mr & Mrs Cleaners ("F. Basra Inc") under the authority of TEX. HEALTH & SAFETY CODE ch. 374 and TEX. WATER CODE ch. 7. The Executive Director of the TCEQ, through the Enforcement Division, and F. Basra Inc appear before the Commission and together stipulate that:

1. F. Basra Inc owns and operates a dry cleaner drop station at 2000 Esters Road, Suite 106 in Irving, Dallas County, Texas (the "Facility").
2. The TCEQ has general authority to regulated the Facility pursuant to TEX. HEALTH & SAFETY CODE § 374.051.
3. The Commission and F. Basra Inc agree that the Commission has jurisdiction to enter this Agreed Order, and that F. Basra Inc is subject to the Commission's jurisdiction.
4. F. Basra Inc received notice of the violations alleged in Section II ("Allegations") on or about July 11, 2006.
5. The occurrence of any violation is in dispute and the entry of this Agreed Order shall not constitute an admission by F. Basra Inc of any violation alleged in Section II ("Allegations"), nor of any statute or rule.

6. An administrative penalty in the amount of Three Hundred Eight Dollars (\$308) is assessed by the Commission in settlement of the violations alleged in Section II ("Allegations"). F. Basra Inc has paid Two Hundred Forty-Six Dollars (\$246) of the administrative penalty and Sixty-Two Dollars (\$62) is deferred contingent upon F. Basra Inc's timely and satisfactory compliance with all the terms of this Agreed Order. The deferred amount will be waived upon full compliance with the terms of this Agreed Order. If F. Basra Inc fails to timely and satisfactorily comply with all requirements of this Agreed Order, the Executive Director may require F. Basra Inc to pay all or part of the deferred penalty.

Any notice and procedure which might otherwise be required in this section shall be waived in the event of a reasonably prompt resolution of the matter.

The Board shall have the authority to suspend, modify, or terminate any of the provisions of this section.

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ARTICLE III

The Board shall have the authority to suspend, modify, or terminate any of the provisions of this section.

7. Any notice and procedures which might otherwise be authorized or required in this action are waived in the interest of a more timely resolution of the matter.
8. The Executive Director of the TCEQ and F. Basra Inc have agreed on a settlement of the matters alleged in this enforcement action, subject to the approval of the Commission.
9. The Executive Director recognizes that on May 26, 2006, F. Basra Inc completed and submitted the required registration form to the TCEQ for the Facility.
10. The Executive Director may, without further notice or hearing, refer this matter to the Office of the Attorney General of the State of Texas ("OAG") for further enforcement proceedings if the Executive Director determines that F. Basra Inc has not complied with one or more of the terms or conditions in this Agreed Order.
11. This Agreed Order shall terminate five years from its effective date or upon compliance with all the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreed Order, whichever is later.
12. The provisions of this Agreed Order are deemed severable and, if a court of competent jurisdiction or other appropriate authority deems any provision of this Agreed Order unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall be valid and enforceable.

II. ALLEGATIONS

As owner and operator of the Facility, F. Basra Inc is alleged to have failed to complete and submit the required registration form to the TCEQ for the Facility, in violation of 30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 337.10(a) and TEX. HEALTH & SAFETY CODE § 374.102, as documented during an investigation conducted on May 26, 2006.

III. DENIALS

F. Basra Inc generally denies each allegation in Section II ("Allegations").

IV. ORDERING PROVISIONS

1. It is, therefore, ordered by the TCEQ that F. Basra Inc pay an administrative penalty as set forth in Section I, Paragraph 6 above. The payment of this administrative penalty and F. Basra Inc's compliance with all the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreed Order resolve only the allegations in Section II. The Commission shall not be constrained in any manner from requiring corrective action or penalties for violations which are not raised here. Administrative penalty payments shall be made payable to "TCEQ" and shall be sent with the notation "Re: F. Basra Inc dba Mr & Mrs Cleaners, Docket No. 2006-0952-DCL-E" to:

2. The provisions of this Agreed Order shall apply to and be binding upon F. Basra Inc. F. Basra Inc is ordered to give notice of the Agreed Order to personnel who maintain day-to-day control over the Facility operations referenced in this Agreed Order.
3. This Agreed Order, issued by the Commission, shall not be admissible against F. Basra Inc in a civil proceeding, unless the proceeding is brought by the OAG to: (1) enforce the terms of this Agreed Order; or (2) pursue violations of a statute within the Commission's jurisdiction, or of a rule adopted or an order or permit issued by the Commission under such a statute.
4. This agreement may be executed in multiple counterparts, which together shall constitute a single original instrument. Any executed signature page to this Agreement may be transmitted by facsimile transmission to the other parties, which shall constitute an original signature for all purposes.
5. Under 30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 70.10(b), the effective date is the date of hand-delivery of the Order to F. Basra Inc, or three days after the date on which the Commission mails notice of the Order to F. Basra Inc, whichever is earlier. The Chief Clerk shall provide a copy of this Agreed Order to each of the parties.


