AGREED ORDER DOCKET NO. 2006-1200-DCL-E

I. JURISDICTION AND STIPULATIONS

At its _____ agenda, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality ("the Commission" or "TCEQ") considered this agreement of the parties, resolving an enforcement action regarding Aly Mohammad, Inc. dba Dapper Dan Cleaners ("Aly Mohammad") under the authority of TEX. HEALTH & SAFETY CODE ch. 374 and TEX. WATER CODE ch. 7. The Executive Director of the TCEQ, through the Enforcement Division, and Aly Mohammad appear before the Commission and together stipulate that:

1. Aly Mohammad owns and operates three dry cleaner drop stations at 14709 West Farm-to-Market Road 529, 9317 Katy Freeway, and 15123 Memorial Drive in Houston, Harris County, Texas (the "Facilities").
2. The TCEQ has general authority to regulate the Facilities pursuant to TEX. HEALTH & SAFETY CODE § 374.051.
3. The Commission and Aly Mohammad agree that the Commission has jurisdiction to enter this Agreed Order, and that Aly Mohammad is subject to the Commission's jurisdiction.
4. Aly Mohammad received notice of the violations alleged in Section II ("Allegations") on or about August 5, 2006, August 7, 2006, and August 13, 2006.
5. The occurrence of any violation is in dispute and the entry of this Agreed Order shall not constitute an admission by Aly Mohammad of any violation alleged in Section II ("Allegations"), nor of any statute or rule.
6. An administrative penalty in the amount of Three Thousand Three Hundred Nineteen Dollars (\$3,319) is assessed by the Commission in settlement of the violations alleged in Section II ("Allegations"). Aly Mohammad has paid One Hundred Twenty Six Dollars (\$126) of the administrative penalty and Six Hundred Sixty-Three Dollars (\$663) is deferred contingent upon Aly

Mohammad's timely and satisfactory compliance with all the terms of this Agreed Order. The deferred amount will be waived upon full compliance with the terms of this Agreed Order. If Aly Mohammad fails to timely and satisfactorily comply with all requirements of this Agreed Order, including the payment schedule, the Executive Director may require Aly Mohammad to pay all or part of the deferred penalty.

The remaining amount of Two Thousand Five Hundred Thirty Dollars (\$2,530) of the administrative penalty shall be payable in 23 monthly payments of One Hundred Ten Dollars (\$110) each. The next monthly payment shall be paid within 30 days after the effective date of this Agreed Order. The subsequent payments shall each be paid not later than 30 days following the due date of the previous payment until paid in full. If Aly Mohammad fails to timely and satisfactorily comply with the payment requirements of this Agreed Order, the Executive Director may, at the Executive Director's option, accelerate the maturity of the remaining installments, in which event the unpaid balance shall become immediately due and payable without demand or notice. In addition, the failure of Aly Mohammad to meet the payment schedule of this Agreed Order constitutes the failure by Aly Mohammad to timely and satisfactorily comply with all the terms of this Agreed Order.

7. Any notice and procedures which might otherwise be authorized or required in this action are waived in the interest of a more timely resolution of the matter.
8. The Executive Director of the TCEQ and Aly Mohammad have agreed on a settlement of the matters alleged in this enforcement action, subject to the approval of the Commission.
9. The Executive Director recognizes that Aly Mohammad has obtained the Facilities' registration by completing and submitting the required form to the TCEQ for the Facilities on August 21, 2006 and August 22, 2006.
10. The Executive Director may, without further notice or hearing, refer this matter to the Office of the Attorney General of the State of Texas ("OAG") for further enforcement proceedings if the Executive Director determines that Aly Mohammad has not complied with one or more of the terms or conditions in this Agreed Order.
11. This Agreed Order shall terminate five years from its effective date or upon compliance with all the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreed Order, whichever is later.
12. The provisions of this Agreed Order are deemed severable and, if a court of competent jurisdiction or other appropriate authority deems any provision of this Agreed Order unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall be valid and enforceable.

II. ALLEGATIONS

As owner and operator of the Facilities, Aly Mohammad is alleged to have failed to complete and submit the required registration form to the TCEQ for the Facilities, in violation of 30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 337.10(a) and TEX. HEALTH & SAFETY CODE § 374.102, as documented during investigations conducted on May 22, 2006 and May 24, 2006.

III. DENIALS

Aly Mohammad generally denies each allegation in Section II ("Allegations").

IV. ORDERING PROVISIONS

1. It is, therefore, ordered by the TCEQ that Aly Mohammad pay an administrative penalty as set forth in Section I, Paragraph 6 above. The payment of this administrative penalty and Aly Mohammad's compliance with all the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreed Order resolve only the allegations in Section II. The Commission shall not be constrained in any manner from requiring corrective action or penalties for violations which are not raised here. Administrative penalty payments shall be made payable to "TCEQ" and shall be sent with the notation "Re: Aly Mohammad, Inc. dba Dapper Dan Cleaners, Docket No. 2006-1200-DCL-E" to:

2. The provisions of this Agreed Order shall apply to and be binding upon Aly Mohammad. Aly Mohammad is ordered to give notice of the Agreed Order to personnel who maintain day-to-day control over the Facilities operations referenced in this Agreed Order.
3. If Aly Mohammad fails to comply with any of the Ordering Provisions in this Agreed Order within the prescribed schedules, and that failure is caused solely by an act of God, war, strike, riot, or other catastrophe, Aly Mohammad's failure to comply is not a violation of this Agreed Order. Aly Mohammad shall have the burden of establishing to the Executive Director's satisfaction that such an event has occurred. Aly Mohammad shall notify the Executive Director within seven days after Aly Mohammad becomes aware of a delaying event and shall take all reasonable measures to mitigate and minimize any delay.
4. The Executive Director may grant an extension of any deadline in this Agreed Order or in any plan, report, or other document submitted pursuant to this Agreed Order, upon a written and substantiated showing of good cause. All requests for extensions by Aly Mohammad shall be made in writing to the Executive Director. Extensions are not effective until Aly Mohammad receives written approval from the Executive Director. The determination of what constitutes good cause rests solely with the Executive Director.
5. This Agreed Order, issued by the Commission, shall not be admissible against Aly Mohammad in a civil proceeding, unless the proceeding is brought by the OAG to: (1) enforce the terms of this Agreed Order; or (2) pursue violations of a statute within the Commission's jurisdiction, or of a rule adopted or an order or permit issued by the Commission under such a statute.




