

A. GENERAL INFORMATION

On March 15, 2007 the Commission received an application, in the form of a petition, requesting the dissolution of Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 104 (District). The Texas Water Commission, predecessor to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality, created the District on March 9, 1988. The District contains 340.8 acres of land within Fort Bend County and is subject to Texas Water Code Chapters 49 and 54.

The petition for the dissolution of the District was signed by Tony K. Love, Assistant Vice President – Real Estate of the Union Pacific Railroad Company, a Delaware Corporation (Applicant). The petition asserts that the Applicant holds title to all of the land within the District. A certificate of ownership from Fort Bend Central Appraisal District confirms the Applicant's ownership.

The Commission created the District for the purpose of purchasing, constructing, operating and maintaining all facilities necessary for the supply and distribution of water; the collection, transportation and treatment of wastewater; and the drainage of storm water to service the land in the District. The District has remained inactive since its creation. The petition states that dissolution is desirable because “. . . none of the development for which the District was created has ever taken place . . . and the District no longer has any function to perform or duties to fulfill . . .” and consequently, the District's statutory services are not needed for the land comprising the territory of the District.

The petition is supported by documents affirming that the District has performed none of the functions for which it was created for five consecutive years preceding the date of the petition.

In addition, the District has been financially dormant since its creation, does not have outstanding bonded indebtedness, and has no known assets or liabilities.

Affirming the District's dormancy are certified copies of the Annual Financial Dormancy and Filing Affidavit (Affidavit) for the calendar years 2002 through 2006. Affirming that the District does not have any outstanding debt is a certification from the Comptroller of Public Accounts of the State of Texas (Comptroller).

The certification from the Comptroller was included with the application. It certifies that their review of records on January 23, 2007 revealed that the District had not incurred bonded debt for the period January 1, 1986 through January 23, 2007.

B. CONCLUSION

Based on a review of the application and information on file, the District meets the dissolution requirements set forth in the Texas Water Code Sections 49.321 to 49.327 and Texas Administrative Code Sections 293.131 to 293.136.

C. RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Approve the request to dissolve Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 104.
2. Direct that the District's assets, if any, will escheat to the State of Texas, will be administered by the Comptroller of Public Accounts of the State of Texas, and will be disposed of in the manner provided by Texas Property Code Chapter 74 and in accordance with Texas Water Code Section 49.327 and Texas Administrative Code Section 293.134.

AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE DISSOLUTION OF FORT BEND COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 104

On August 22, 2007, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (hereafter "Commission") met in regular session at its offices in Austin, Texas, with notice of the meeting issued in compliance with the Open Meetings Act, TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 551.001 - 551.146 and the Administrative Procedure Act, TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.001 - 2001.902, to consider the petition submitted by Tony K. Love, authorized agent for the Union Pacific Railroad Company which is the owner of property located within Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 104 (hereafter "District"); to dissolve the District pursuant to TEX. WATER CODE §§ 49.321 - 49.327 and 30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 293.131 - 293.136.

The Commission, after having considered the petition, application material, and the May 8, 2007 memorandum from the Executive Director regarding the petition, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit "A," finds that the petition for dissolution should be approved. The Commission finds that the District has performed none of the functions for which it was created for a period of five consecutive years before the day of the proceeding and has no outstanding bonded indebtedness. The District should be directed to escheat the District's assets, if any, to the State of Texas, which will be administered by the Comptroller of Public Accounts and disposed of in the manner provided by TEX. PROP. CODE §§ 74.001 - 74.710.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE TEXAS COMMISSION ON ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY that the petition for the dissolution of the District filed by Tony K. Love, authorized agent for Union Pacific Railroad Company which is the owner of property in the District, is granted pursuant to TEX. WATER CODE §§ 49.321 - 49.327 and 30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 293.131 - 293.136 (Dissolution of Districts). The Commission will file a certified copy of this order of dissolution in the deed records of Fort Bend County. The District is directed to escheat the District's assets, if any, to the State of Texas, which will be administered by the Comptroller of Public Accounts and disposed of in the manner provided by TEX. PROP. CODE §§ 74.001 - 74.710.

TO THE HONORABLE TEXAS COMMISSION ON ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY:

COMES NOW UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY ("Petitioner"), a Delaware corporation, under the authority of 30 TAC § 293.131, to petition the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality pursuant to the Texas Water Code § 49.321 and 30 TAC §293.131(2)(A) to dissolve Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 104, and in support thereof shows the following:

I.

BACKGROUND

Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 104 (the "District") was created by the Texas Water Commission under Article XVI, Section 59 of the Constitution of Texas and Chapter 54 of the Texas Water Code by Order dated March 9, 1988. The District contains approximately 340.8 acres as more fully described by metes and bounds in **Exhibit "A"** attached hereto. Although the creation of the District was predicated on the prompt development of the property within the District, no development was undertaken by the original developer. To the

best knowledge and belief of Petitioner, the majority in acreage and in value of the property within the District is now owned by Petitioner.

Petitioner desires to dissolve the District because none of the development for which the District was created has ever taken place and the owners of the property within the District no longer desire the existence of the District; therefore, there is no longer any need for the continued existence of the District, and the District no longer has any function to perform or duties to fulfill, and dissolution of the District is desirable and necessary.

II.

INACTIVITY AND FINANCIAL DORMANCY

The District has been inactive for a period of five consecutive years or more. Texas Water Code §49.321; 30 TAC §293.131(2)(B). The District has not performed any of the functions for which it was created for a period of five consecutive years or more. Texas Water Code §49.321; 30 TAC §293.131(2)(B). The District has been financially dormant for the preceding five year period, as evidenced by the copies of Financial Dormancy and Filing Affidavits for the years 2002 through 2006, attached hereto as **Exhibit "B"** and incorporated herein by reference. 30 TAC §293.131(2)(C).

III.

NO OUTSTANDING BONDED INDEBTEDNESS

The District has no outstanding bonded indebtedness (Texas Water Code §§49.321 and 49.324; 30 TAC §293.131(2)(D)), as evidenced by statements made to the Petitioner by the District's attorneys and by a detailed review conducted by Petitioner of the District's files, and as further evidenced by the original Certificate of No Bonded Indebtedness, provided by the

Comptroller of Public Accounts of the State of Texas, attached hereto as Exhibit "C" and incorporated herein by reference, in which the Comptroller certifies that the District has never registered any bonds with the Comptroller.

IV.

ASSETS AND LIABILITIES

A review of the District's files by the District's attorneys and the attached letter dated January 24, 2007 from Municipal Accounts & Consulting, L.P., the bookkeeper for the District, indicate that the District has no assets or liabilities (see Exhibit "D").

V.

NOTICE TO OTHER LANDOWNERS

A recent Ownership Certificate provided by the Fort Bend Central Appraisal District pertaining to property within the District, attached hereto as Exhibit "E" and incorporated herein by reference, reflects the Petitioner as the owner of all of the property within the District. Therefore, no notice to other landowners is required.

VI.

NOTICE OF HEARING

As required by Texas Water Code §49.322(b) and 30 TAC §293.132, Petitioner will publish at its own cost the Notice of Hearing provided by the Chief Clerk pursuant to Texas Water Code §49.322(a) and 30 TAC §293.132. Petitioner understands that the Commission will give the Notice of Hearing to the members of the Board of Directors of the District according to the last record on file with the Executive Director as required by Texas Water Code §49.322(c) and 30 TAC §293.132.

VII.

ORDER OF DISSOLUTION

The Commission will enter an order that the District be dissolved if the Commission finds that the District has performed none of the functions for which it was created for a period of five consecutive years before the day of the hearing and the District has no outstanding bonded indebtedness. Petitioner understands and agrees that, pursuant to Texas Water Code §49.327 and 30 TAC §293.134, the assets of the District, if any, shall escheat to the State of Texas and shall be administered by the Comptroller of Public Accounts (as successor to the State Treasurer) and disposed of in the manner provided by law.

VIII.

CERTIFIED COPY OF ORDER

Petitioner understands and agrees that, pursuant to Texas Water Code §49.325 and 30 TAC §293.135, the Commission will cause to be filed a certified copy of the Order of Dissolution of the District in the Deed Records of Fort Bend County, Texas.

IX.

FILING FEE

Included with the filing of this petition, Petitioner has provided the One Hundred Dollar (\$100.00) filing fee required by 30 TAC §293.136.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully prays that this petition be properly filed, as provided by law; that it be set down for hearing at a date to be fixed in keeping with the provisions of Chapter 49 and Chapter 54, Texas Water Code, as amended; that Notice of Hearing be given as provided therein; that the hearing be held and this petition be in all things granted;
