## **AGREED ORDER DOCKET NO. 2007-1277-AIR-E**

### **I. JURISDICTION AND STIPULATIONS**

At its \_\_\_\_\_ agenda, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality ("the Commission" or "TCEQ") considered this agreement of the parties, resolving an enforcement action regarding Ofelia Bosquez dba Wencho's Gas and Food Mart ("Ms. Bosquez") under the authority of TEX. HEALTH & SAFETY CODE ch. 382 and TEX. WATER CODE ch. 7. The Executive Director of the TCEQ, through the Enforcement Division, and Ms. Bosquez appear before the Commission and together stipulate that:

1. Ms. Bosquez owns and operates a convenience store with retail gasoline sales at 140 O T Smith Road in Tornillo, El Paso County, Texas (the "Station").
2. The Station consists of one or more sources as defined in TEX. HEALTH & SAFETY CODE § 382.003(12).
3. The Commission and Ms. Bosquez agree that the Commission has jurisdiction to enter this Agreed Order, and that Ms. Bosquez is subject to the Commission's jurisdiction.
4. Ms. Bosquez received notice of the violations alleged in Section II ("Allegations") on or about July 31, 2007.
5. The occurrence of any violation is in dispute and the entry of this Agreed Order shall not constitute an admission by Ms. Bosquez of any violation alleged in Section II ("Allegations"), nor of any statute or rule.



6. An administrative penalty in the amount of One Thousand One Hundred Twenty Dollars (\$1,120) is assessed by the Commission in settlement of the violations alleged in Section II ("Allegations"). Ms. Bosquez has paid Eight Hundred Ninety-Six Dollars (\$896) of the administrative penalty and Two Hundred Twenty-Four Dollars (\$224) is deferred contingent upon Ms. Bosquez's timely and satisfactory compliance with all the terms of this Agreed Order. The deferred amount will be waived upon full compliance with the terms of this Agreed Order. If Ms. Bosquez fails to timely and satisfactorily comply with all requirements of this Agreed Order, the Executive Director may require Ms. Bosquez to pay all or part of the deferred penalty.
7. Any notice and procedures, which might otherwise be authorized or required in this action, are waived in the interest of a more timely resolution of the matter.
8. The Executive Director of the TCEQ and Ms. Bosquez have agreed on a settlement of the matters alleged in this enforcement action, subject to the approval of the Commission.
9. The Executive Director recognizes that Ms. Bosquez returned to compliance on August 3, 2007, with the Reid Vapor Pressure ("RVP") requirements at no more than 7.0 pounds per square inch absolute ("psia").
10. The Executive Director may, without further notice or hearing, refer this matter to the Office of the Attorney General of the State of Texas ("OAG") for further enforcement proceedings if the Executive Director determines that Ms. Bosquez has not complied with one or more of the terms or conditions in this Agreed Order.
11. This Agreed Order shall terminate five years from its effective date or upon compliance with all the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreed Order, whichever is later.
12. The provisions of this Agreed Order are deemed severable and, if a court of competent jurisdiction or other appropriate authority deems any provision of this Agreed Order unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall be valid and enforceable.

## **II. ALLEGATIONS**

As owner and operator of the Station, Ms. Bosquez is alleged to have failed to ensure the gasoline sold as motor vehicle fuel in El Paso County, during the control period of June 1, 2007 through September 16, 2007, contained no greater than 7.0 psia of RVP, in violation of 30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 115.252(2) and TEX. HEALTH & SAFETY CODE § 382.085(b), as documented during an investigation conducted on June 11, 2007. Specifically, sample results on premium gasoline revealed a RVP of 7.86 psia.

## **III. DENIALS**

Ms. Bosquez generally denies each allegation in Section II ("Allegations").



#### IV. ORDERING PROVISIONS

1. It is, therefore, ordered by the TCEQ that Ms. Bosquez pay an administrative penalty as set forth in Section I, Paragraph 6 above. The payment of this administrative penalty and Ms. Bosquez's compliance with all the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreed Order resolve only the allegations in Section II. The Commission shall not be constrained in any manner from requiring corrective action or penalties for violations, which are not raised here. Administrative penalty payments shall be made payable to "TCEQ" and shall be sent with the notation "Re: Ofelia Bosquez dba Wencho's Gas and Food Mart, Docket No. 2007-1277-AIR-E" to:

2. The provisions of this Agreed Order shall apply to and be binding upon Ms. Bosquez. Ms. Bosquez is ordered to give notice of the Agreed Order to personnel who maintain day-to-day control over the Station operations referenced in this Agreed Order.
3. This Agreed Order, issued by the Commission, shall not be admissible against Ms. Bosquez in a civil proceeding, unless the proceeding is brought by the OAG to: (1) enforce the terms of this Agreed Order; or (2) pursue violations of a statute within the Commission's jurisdiction, or of a rule adopted or an order or permit issued by the Commission under such a statute.
4. This agreement may be executed in multiple counterparts, which together shall constitute a single original instrument. Any executed signature page to this Agreement may be transmitted by facsimile transmission to the other parties, which shall constitute an original signature for all purposes.
5. Under 30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 70.10(b), the effective date is the date of hand-delivery of the Order to Ms. Bosquez, or three days after the date on which the Commission mails notice of the Order to Ms. Bosquez, whichever is earlier. The Chief Clerk shall provide a copy of this Agreed Order to each of the parties.

In addition, any falsification of any compliance documents may result in criminal prosecution.
