AGREED ORDER

I. JURISDICTION AND STIPULATIONS

At its \_\_\_\_\_ agenda, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality ("Commission" or "TCEQ") considered this agreement of the parties, resolving an enforcement action regarding Shane Walls ("Mr. Walls") under the authority of TEX. WATER CODE chs. 7 and 37 and TEX. OCC. CODE ch. 1903. The Executive Director of the TCEQ, represented by the Litigation Division, and Mr. Walls, appear before the Commission and together stipulate that:

1. Mr. Walls owned and operated a landscape irrigation business located at 12750 Preston Road, Bldg. E-1, Frisco, Collin County, Texas (the "Business").
2. This Agreed Order is entered into pursuant to TEX. WATER CODE §§ 7.051 and 7.070. The Commission has jurisdiction of this matter pursuant to TEX. WATER CODE § 5.013 because it alleges violations of TEX. OCCUPATIONS CODE ch. 1903, TEX. WATER CODE ch. 37, and the TCEQ rules.
3. The Commission and Mr. Walls agree that the Commission has jurisdiction to enter this Agreed Order, and that Mr. Walls is subject to the Commission's jurisdiction.
4. Mr. Walls received notice of the violations alleged in Section II ("Allegations") on or about October 3, 2007.
5. The occurrence of any violation is in dispute and the entry of this Agreed Order shall not constitute an admission by Mr. Walls of any violation alleged in Section II ("Allegations"), nor of any statute or rule.

6. An administrative penalty in the amount of four hundred dollars (\$400.00) is assessed by the Commission in settlement of the violations alleged in Section II ("Allegations"). Mr. Walls has paid four hundred dollars (\$400.00) of the administrative penalty.
7. Any notice and procedures which might otherwise be authorized or required in this action are waived in the interest of a more timely resolution of the matter.
8. The Executive Director of the TCEQ and Mr. Walls have agreed on a settlement of the matters alleged in this enforcement action, subject to the approval of the Commission.
9. The Executive Director recognizes that Mr. Walls has ceased advertising irrigation services, has ceased the unauthorized use of someone else's license, and has changed business cards as of August 29, 2007.
10. The Executive Director may, without further notice or hearing, refer this matter to the Office of the Attorney General of the State of Texas ("OAG") for further enforcement proceedings if the Executive Director determines that Mr. Walls has not complied with one or more of the terms or conditions in this Agreed Order.
11. This Agreed Order shall terminate five years from its effective date or upon compliance with all the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreed Order, whichever is later.
12. The provisions of this Agreed Order are deemed severable and, if a court of competent jurisdiction or other appropriate authority deems any provision of this Agreed Order unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall be valid and enforceable.

## II. ALLEGATIONS

Mr. Walls is alleged to have violated:

1. TEX. WATER CODE § 37.003, TEX. OCCUPATIONS CODE § 1903.251, and 30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 30.5(b) and 344.4(a) by failing to refrain from advertising or representing himself to the public as a person who can perform services for which a license or registration is required, when not possessing a current license or registration. Specifically, Mr. Walls advertised for irrigation installation and repair services without holding an irrigator license, as documented during a record review conducted by a TCEQ Central Office investigator on June 14, 2007.
2. TEX. OCCUPATIONS CODE § 1903.251 and 30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 344.58(b) by failing to comply with irrigator installer requirements by unauthorized use of the license of someone else who is a licensed irrigator. Specifically, Mr. Walls used irrigator license number

LI0005244, which he is not authorized to use, as documented during a record review conducted by a TCEQ Central Office investigator on June 14, 2007.

### III. DENIALS

Mr. Walls generally denies each allegation in Section II ("Allegations").

### IV. ORDER

1. It is, therefore, ordered by the TCEQ that Mr. Walls pay an administrative penalty as set forth in Section I, Paragraph 6 above. The payment of this administrative penalty and Mr. Walls' compliance with all the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreed Order resolve only the allegations in Section II. The Commission shall not be constrained in any manner from considering or requiring corrective action or penalties for violations which are not raised here. Administrative penalty payments shall be made payable to "Texas Commission on Environmental Quality" and shall be sent with the notation "Re: Shane Walls, Docket No. 2007-1743-LII-E" to:

2. The provisions of this Agreed Order shall apply to and be binding upon Mr. Walls. Mr. Walls is ordered to give notice of the Agreed Order to personnel who maintain day-to-day control over the Business operations referenced in this Agreed Order.
3. This Agreed Order, issued by the Commission, shall not be admissible against Mr. Walls in a civil proceeding, unless the proceeding is brought by the OAG to: (1) enforce the terms of this Agreed Order; or (2) pursue violations of a statute within the Commission's jurisdiction, or of a rule adopted or an order or permit issued by the Commission under such a statute.
4. This agreement may be executed in multiple counterparts, which together shall constitute a single original instrument. Any executed signature page to this Agreement may be transmitted by facsimile transmission to the other parties, which shall constitute an original signature for all purposes.


