### AGREED ORDER DOCKET NO. 2009-1025-MWD-E

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### I. JURISDICTION AND STIPULATIONS

At its \_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_ agenda, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality ("the Commission" or "TCEQ") considered this agreement of the parties, resolving an enforcement action regarding City of Elkhart ("the City") under the authority of TEX. WATER CODE chs. 7 and 26. The Executive Director of the TCEQ, through the Enforcement Division, and the City appear before the Commission and together stipulate that:

- 1. The City owns and operates a wastewater treatment facility with an associated collection system located approximately 0.3 mile east-southeast of the intersection of State Highway 294 and Farm-to-Market Road 319 and approximately 0.6 mile southwest of the intersection of State Highway 294 and Farm-to-Market Road 861 in Anderson County, Texas (the "Facility").
- 2. The City has discharged municipal waste into or adjacent to any water in the state under TEX. WATER CODE ch. 26.
- 3. The Commission and the City agree that the Commission has jurisdiction to enter this Agreed Order, and that the City is subject to the Commission's jurisdiction.
- 4. The City received notice of the violations alleged in Section  $\Pi$  ("Allegations") on or about June 21, 2009.
- 5. The occurrence of any violation is in dispute and the entry of this Agreed Order shall not constitute an admission by the City of any violation alleged in Section II ("Allegations"), nor of any statute or rule.

- 6. An administrative penalty in the amount of Two Thousand Seven Hundred Ninety Dollars (\$2,790) is assessed by the Commission in settlement of the violations alleged in Section II ("Allegations"). The City has paid Two Thousand Two Hundred Thirty-Two Dollars (\$2,232) of the administrative penalty and Five Hundred Fifty-Eight Dollars (\$558) is deferred contingent upon the City's timely and satisfactory compliance with all the terms of this Agreed Order. The deferred amount will be waived upon full compliance with the terms of this Agreed Order. If the City fails to timely and satisfactorily comply with all requirements of this Agreed Order, the Executive Director may require the City to pay all or part of the deferred penalty.
- 7. Any notice and procedures, which might otherwise be authorized or required in this action, are waived in the interest of a more timely resolution of the matter.
- 8. The Executive Director of the TCEQ and the City have agreed on a settlement of the matters alleged in this enforcement action, subject to the approval of the Commission.
- 9. The Executive Director recognizes that on or about March 25, 2009, the City cleaned and disinfected the area where the discharge occurred.
- 10. The Executive Director may, without further notice or hearing, refer this matter to the Office of the Attorney General of the State of Texas ("OAG") for further enforcement proceedings if the Executive Director determines that the City has not complied with one or more of the terms or conditions in this Agreed Order.
- 11. This Agreed Order shall terminate five years from its effective date or upon compliance with all the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreed Order, whichever is later.
- 12. The provisions of this Agreed Order are deemed severable and, if a court of competent jurisdiction or other appropriate authority deems any provision of this Agreed Order unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall be valid and enforceable.

### **II. ALLEGATIONS**

As owner and operator of the Facility, the City is alleged to have failed to prevent the unauthorized discharge of wastewater into or adjacent to water in the state, in violation of TEX. WATER CODE § 26.121(a), 30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 305.125(1), and TPDES Permit No. WQ0010735001, Permit Conditions No. 2.g, as documented during an investigation conducted on April 8, 2009. Specifically, the City reported an unauthorized discharge on March 24, 2009, of 150,000 gallons from the Jones Road Lift Station due to inflow from heavy rain.

### **III. DENIALS**

The City generally denies each allegation in Section II ("Allegations").

### **IV. ORDERING PROVISIONS**

1. It is, therefore, ordered by the TCEQ that the City pay an administrative penalty as set forth in Section I, Paragraph 6 above. The payment of this administrative penalty and the City's compliance with all the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreed Order resolve only the allegations in Section II. The Commission shall not be constrained in any manner from requiring corrective action or penalties for violations which are not raised here. Administrative penalty payments shall be made payable to "TCEQ" and shall be sent with the notation "Re: City of Elkhart, Docket No. 2009-1025-MWD-E" to:

- 2. It is further ordered that the City shall undertake the following technical requirements:
  - a. Within 90 days after the effective date of this Agreed Order, conduct an engineering evaluation of the Facility to assess the extent of inflow and infiltration ("I/I") of storm water into the collection system and the impacts of I/I on hydraulic loading and performance at the Facility. The evaluation shall be prepared by a licensed Texas professional engineer;
  - b. Within 105 days, submit written certification of compliance with Ordering Provision No. 2.a, in accordance with Ordering Provision No. 2.g below;
  - c. Within 180 days after the effective date of this Agreed Order, complete a plan and schedule for the completion of necessary corrective actions to fully rehabilitate the Facility based on the engineering evaluation. This schedule should allow for completion of all repairs within 365 days after the effective date of this Agreed Order. The City shall provide a copy of the plan and schedule to the addresses listed in Ordering Provision No. 2.g below;
  - d. Within 195 days, submit written certification of compliance with Ordering Provision No. 2.c, in accordance with Ordering Provision No. 2.g below;
  - e. Within 365 days after the effective date of this Agreed Order, complete all necessary corrective actions to fully rehabilitate the Facility based on the engineering plan and schedule referenced in Ordering Provision No. 2.c;
  - f. Within 380 days after the effective date of this Agreed Order, submit written certification of compliance with Ordering Provision No. 2. e, in accordance with Ordering Provision No. 2.g below; and
  - g. The certification shall include detailed supporting documentation including photographs, receipts, and/or other records to demonstrate compliance with Ordering Provisions Nos. 2.a, 2.c, and 2.e. The certification shall be notarized by a State of Texas Notary Public and include the following certification language:

"I certify under penalty of law that this document and all attachments were prepared under my direction or supervision in accordance with a system designed to assure that qualified personnel properly gather and evaluate the information submitted. Based on my inquiry of the person or persons who manage the system, or those persons directly responsible for gathering the information, the information submitted is, to the best of my knowledge and belief, true, accurate, and complete. I am aware that there are significant penalties for submitting false information, including the possibility of fines and imprisonment for knowing violations."

- 3. The provisions of this Agreed Order shall apply to and be binding upon the City. The City is ordered to give notice of the Agreed Order to personnel who maintain day-to-day control over the Facility operations referenced in this Agreed Order.
- 4. If the City fails to comply with any of the Ordering Provisions in this Agreed Order within the prescribed schedules, and that failure is caused solely by an act of God, war, strike, riot, or other catastrophe, the City's failure to comply is not a violation of this Agreed Order. The City shall have the burden of establishing to the Executive Director's satisfaction that such an event has occurred. The City shall notify the Executive Director within seven days after the City becomes aware of a delaying event and shall take all reasonable measures to mitigate and minimize any delay.
- 5. The Executive Director may grant an extension of any deadline in this Agreed Order or in any plan, report, or other document submitted pursuant to this Agreed Order, upon a written and substantiated showing of good cause. All requests for extensions by the City shall be made in writing to the Executive Director. Extensions are not effective until the City receives written approval from the Executive Director. The determination of what constitutes good cause rests solely with the Executive Director.
- 6. This Agreed Order, issued by the Commission, shall not be admissible against the City in a civil proceeding, unless the proceeding is brought by the OAG to: (1) enforce the terms of this Agreed Order; or (2) pursue violations of a statute within the Commission's jurisdiction, or of a rule adopted or an order or permit issued by the Commission under such a statute.

- 7. This Agreed Order may be executed in multiple counterparts, which together shall constitute a single original instrument. Any executed signature page to this Agreed Order may be transmitted by facsimile transmission to the other parties, which shall constitute an original signature for all purposes under this Agreed Order.
- 8. Under 30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 70.10(b), the effective date is the date of hand-delivery of the Order to the City, or three days after the date on which the Commission mails notice of the Order to the City, whichever is earlier. The Chief Clerk shall provide a copy of this Agreed Order to each of the parties.

- Referral of this case to the Attorney General's Office for contempt, injunctive relief, additional penalties, and/or attorney fees, or to a collection agency;
- Increased penalties in any future enforcement actions;
- Automatic referral to the Attorney General's Office of any future enforcement actions; and
- TCEQ seeking other relief as authorized by law.

In addition, any falsification of any compliance documents may result in criminal prosecution.
