AN ORDER

AUTHORIZING THE DISSOLUTION OF FORT BEND MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 51 TCEQ DOCKET NO. 2013-1323-DIS

On January 15, 2014 the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (Commission) met in regular session at its offices in Austin, Texas, to consider the petition to dissolve Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 51 in Fort Bend County (District) submitted by Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 25 (FBC MUD No. 25) pursuant to Texas Water Code Chapter 49 and Title 30 of the Texas Administrative Code, Sections 293.131 to 293.136.

The Commission, after having considered the petition and the September 16, 2013, staff memorandum regarding the petition (*See Attachment*) finds that the petition for dissolution should be approved. The Commission finds that the District has performed none of the functions for which it was created for a period of five consecutive years before the date the petition was submitted and has no outstanding bonded indebtedness.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE TEXAS COMMISSION ON ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY that the petition for the dissolution of the District filed by FBC MUD No. 25 is granted pursuant to Texas Water Code Chapter 49 and Title 30 Texas Administrative Code Sections 293.131 to 293.136.

The Commission will file a certified copy of this Order in the deed records of Fort Bend County. The District is directed to escheat the District's assets, if any, to the State of Texas, which will be administered by the Comptroller of Public Accounts and disposed of in the manner provided by Texas Property Code Sections 74.001 to 74.710.

A. BACKGROUND

On July 2, 2012, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) received a petition requesting the dissolution of Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 51 (District). The District contains 261,654 acres of land within Fort Bend County and is subject to the requirements of Texas Water Code (TWC) Chapters 49 and 54.

The petition for the dissolution of the District was signed by David W. Mertin, President, of Grand Parkway Baptist Church Inc. (Landowner), which designated Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District 25 (Petitioner) as their agent for purposes of this dissolution. A certified appraisal roll from the Fort Bend Central Appraisal District lists the properties that were originally coded by the appraisal district as being within the District, along with their current owners.

The District was originally created by the Texas Water Commission on July 11, 1984 for purposes of providing water service, sewer service, a storm sewer system, and a levee for flood protection to its service area. However, the District has remained inactive since its creation.

B. BASIS FOR DISTRICT DISSOLUTION

Pursuant to TWC Section 49.321, the Commission is authorized to dissolve a district that meets the following requirements:

Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 51

1. Is inactive for a period of five consecutive years preceding the petition for dissolution;
and
2. Has no outstanding bond indebtedness.

The petition is supported by documents affirming that the District has performed none of the functions it was authorized to perform when it was created for the five consecutive years preceding the date of the petition. In addition, the District has been financially dormant since its creation. Therefore, the District does not have outstanding bonded indebtedness. The Cash and Securities Management Division of the Comptroller of Public Accounts of the State of Texas certified that a review of their records found no registration by the Comptroller of bonds issued by the District.

Pursuant to 30 Texas Administrative Code Section 293.131, if the dissolution is initiated by a party other than the Executive Director, in addition to submitting support that the above requirements were met, the application must include the following:

1. A statement by the Petitioner requesting dissolution, including reasons why a dissolution is desirable or necessary;
2. A list of District assets and liabilities, if any;
3. Evidence that all landowners not signing the petition for dissolution were notified of the dissolution request; and
4. A filing fee of \$100.

The Petitioner states that dissolution is desirable as it would allow for the annexation of 6.0902 acres of land owned by the Landowner that is currently located within the District boundaries. The Petitioner states that it has sufficient water and sanitary sewer capacity to serve this property and would be able to serve the Landowner as an in-district customer so that they may pay in-district water and sewer rates. The Landowner also has donated land and easements to Petitioner for the construction of a lift station and related lines. Additionally, the Petitioner constructed said lift station and related lines.

The Petitioner states that they are unaware of any assets or liabilities of the District and submitted documentation that current owners of property within the District were notified by mail of the petition for District dissolution. The \$100 filing fee was submitted.

C. CONCLUSION

Based on a review of the application and information on file, the District meets the dissolution requirements set forth in TWC Section 49.321 and 30 TAC Section 293.131.

2. Direct that the District's assets, if any, will escheat to the State of Texas, will be administered by the Comptroller of Public Accounts of the State of Texas, and will be disposed of in the manner provided by Texas Property Code Chapter 74 and in accordance with TWC Section 49.327 and 30 TAC Section 293.134.





**PETITION FOR DISSOLUTION
OF FORT BEND COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 51**

TO THE HONORABLE COMMISSIONERS OF THE TEXAS COMMISSION ON ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY:

FORT BEND COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 25, OF FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS ("Petitioner"), being a party interested party in the dissolution of a dormant, inactive municipal utility district known as Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 51 ("MUD 51"), and acting pursuant to the provisions of Sections 293.131 – 293.136 of the Texas Administrative Code, respectfully petitions the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (the "Commission") for the dissolution of MUD 51. In support of this petition, Petitioner shows as follows:

I.

The District has received a petition from Grand Parkway Baptist Church ("Landowner"), an owner of land within MUD 51, for annexation of the 6.0902 acres of its land located in MUD 51 into the boundaries of Petitioner. At the time Landowner submitted its annexation petition to Petitioner, it was not aware that a portion of its land was included within the boundaries of MUD 51 because since its creation in 1984, MUD 51 has never levied a tax, issued bonds or provided water and/or sewer service to Landowner's property.

II.

Petitioner has sufficient water and sanitary sewer capacity to serve Landowner's property and would like to provide water and sewer service to Landowner as an in-district customer. Landowner has donated land and easements to Petitioner for the construction of a lift station and related lines and Petitioner has constructed a lift station and related lines on the donated land. It is in the best interests of Landowner to be within the boundaries of the District so that it can receive water and sewer service from the District and pay in-district rates for same. It is in the best interest of the District for Landowner's property to be in the boundaries of the District so that the lift station constructed and operated by the District is within the boundaries of the District.

III.

Petitioner is not aware of any assets owned by MUD 51. Petitioner does not know of any liabilities of MUD 51. Based upon information available from the Commission, the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts and other sources, it is Petitioner's understanding that (i) MUD 51 has never issued bonds and has no outstanding bonded indebtedness, (ii) MUD 51 has been financially dormant since at least 1995 (the last time a financial dormancy affidavit was filed with the Commission), and (iii) MUD 51 has performed no functions for the five (5) years preceding the date of this petition.

IV.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 293.131(2)(F), Petitioner has notified all landowners in MUD 51 of its intent to submit this Petition to the Commission. Evidence of such mailing will be provided to the Commission.

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


**NOTICE OF A REQUEST FOR THE DISSOLUTION OF FORT BEND COUNTY MUNICIPAL
UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 51**

Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 25, of Fort Bend County, Texas (the "District"), has filed a petition with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (the "TCEQ") requesting the dissolution of Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 51 ("MUD 51"). MUD 51 was created in 1984 and has never levied a tax, issued bonds or provided water or sanitary sewer service to land within its boundaries.

Upon the dissolution of MUD 51, the land formerly within its boundaries will not be within the boundaries of any other municipal utility district unless a petition for annexation is filed with another municipal utility district and that district adopts an order adding the land described in the petition to its boundaries.

The TCEQ will conduct a hearing on the District's petition for the dissolution of MUD 51. Notice of the hearing will be published in a newspaper of general circulation within Fort Bend County, Texas, with the first publication occurring at least thirty (30) days before the hearing date.


