

a facility does not consider the future treatment needs of this quickly growing area, nor does it consider the regional alternatives provided by NTMWD's existing wastewater treatment facilities. The proposed Wynne Jackson/West Foundation project is also located adjacent to the City of Forney's northern extra-territorial jurisdictional area. The City of Forney is a participant in the Buffalo Creek Interceptor pipeline project. Wynne Jackson has requested service into the Buffalo Creek Interceptor pipeline project through the City of Forney. The proposed discharge permit is in conflict with the request for service into the proposed pipeline project that is under construction and due to be in service by April 2005.

The regional wastewater treatment options provided by NTMWD should and must be considered by the Commission pursuant to TEX. WATER CODE § 26.0282 as part of the permit application review process of Wynne Jackson/West Foundation's TPDES permit application. State law and policy favor providing regional service as opposed to a proliferation of small wastewater treatment plants that are more costly, less efficient, and less protective of the environment. If regional treatment issues are not considered by the Commission, the NTWMD's ability to efficiently serve this rapidly growing area east of the Metroplex will be severely restricted.

Because it is NTMWD's policy as well as the stated policy of the Commission to regional wastewater treatment services wherever feasible, NTMWD must file an objection to the issuance of Proposed Permit No. WQ0014535001. Please accept this letter as NTMWD's notice of its request for a public meeting and for a contested case hearing. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to call me at the above number.



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

We have received your request for a public meeting on the permit application submitted by Wynne Jackson, Inc. To determine if a public meeting should be held, the Executive Director considers the factors set out in Title 30 of the Texas Administrative Code, Section 55.154. These rules require that a public meeting be held if: (1) the Executive Director determines that there is a substantial or significant degree of public interest in an application; (2) a member of the legislature who represents the general area in which the facility is located or proposed to be located requests that a public meeting be held; or (3) when a public meeting is otherwise required by law. Based on these factors, the Executive Director has determined not to hold a public meeting.

TCEQ appreciates your interest in environmental issues. Any other substantive comments about the application in your letter will be addressed in the Executive Director's Response to Public Comment that is currently being prepared. Your request for a contested case hearing will be processed at a later time.
