




Dear Ms. Castanuela:

Thank you for providing the above referenced SPIF form. This letter serves as comment on the permit undertaking from the State Historic Preservation Officer, the Executive Director of the Texas Historical Commission. As the state agency responsible for administering the Antiquities Code of Texas, these comments also provide recommendations on compliance with state antiquities laws and regulations.

The review staff, led by Ed Baker, has completed its review. Our files show that the proposed project area may contain historic and prehistoric sites, some of which may be eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places or for State Archeological Landmark status. We recommend that an archeologist conduct a cultural resources survey of the proposed project area including any related access roads, utility lines, or construction easements. Previously disturbed areas do not need to be surveyed.

A qualified professional should conduct the cultural resources survey. You can obtain lists of most professional archeologists in Texas (many of which perform contract archeological investigations), on-line at: www.c-tx-arch.org/ or <http://www.rpanet.org/>. Please note that other potentially qualified archeologists not included on these lists may be used. If the property is owned or controlled by the state or any of its political subdivisions, an Antiquities Permit application will be necessary. A draft report of investigations should be submitted to this office for review.

Thank you for your cooperation in this federal and state review process, and for your efforts to preserve the irreplaceable heritage of Texas. **If you have any questions concerning our review or if we can be of further assistance, please contact Ed Baker at 512/463-5866.**

pollutant so close to a residential area.


Air quality in the Kaufman and Dallas area already

TPDES WQ 0014535001.







We have received your request for a public meeting on the permit application submitted by Wynne Jackson, Inc.
