The HGAC waste management plan discourages landfill clustering, as does HB 1053 passed by the 79th Legislature. I do not see a justifiable need for an additional landfill in this area, especially when there is no barrier to the Security Landfill from accepting Type IV waste in the future. 

Many resident in East Montgomery County use shallow wells for water; the proposed landfill imposes a threat to the quality of that water.

The county faces an imminent shortage of groundwater, and it would be irresponsible to unduly risk contaminating this limited supply.
