**THE OFFICE OF PUBLIC INTEREST COUNSEL'S RESPONSE
TO HEARING REQUESTS AND REQUESTS FOR RECONSIDERATION**

COMES NOW, the Office of Public Interest Counsel ("OPIC") of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (the "Commission" or "TCEQ") and files this Response to Hearing Requests and Requests for Reconsideration in the above-referenced matter, and would respectfully recommend referring this matter to the State Office of Administrative Hearings ("SOAH").

I. INTRODUCTION

The Applicant has applied to the TCEQ for a new permit that would authorize the construction and operation of a new Type IV municipal solid waste landfill in Montgomery County, Texas. The proposed landfill would receive construction and demolition waste materials from Montgomery County, and may also receive waste materials from surrounding counties. The total permitted facility would include 473 acres of land, of which 207.1 acres will be used for waste disposal. The final elevation of the waste fill and soil cover would be 408.29 feet above mean sea level. Waste acceptance rate is expected to average approximately 3,000 tons per day.

The draft permit authorizes the Applicant to accept municipal solid waste resulting from, or incidental to, construction, demolition, and grounds keeping activities, including brush, construction and demolition waste, rubbish, inert material, man-made inert material, trash, yard waste that is free from putrescible and household waste, scrap tires that have been slit and

quartered or shredded, but not from a tire disposer or recycler that is reimbursed from the State Waste Tire Recycling Fund, and other waste as approved by the Executive Director. The site is not able to accept waste streams expressly prohibited by 30 TAC Chapter 330, including but not limited to hazardous waste, Class 1 non-hazardous industrial waste, Class 2 non-hazardous industrial waste, Class 3 non-hazardous industrial waste, regulated radioactive waste, waste containing regulated polychlorinated biphenyls, putrescible waste, household waste, liquid waste, water and wastewater treatment sludge, grease or grit trap wastes, special wastes, and waste material that may cause odor or nuisance or that may require excessive or special on-site procedures and handling requirements.

The proposed facility would be located at 3761 North Walker Road, approximately 1.4 miles north of the intersection of North Walker Road. The location is outside any city limits. The land within one mile of the proposed facility is 60% undeveloped or agricultural, 39% residential with some agricultural use, and 1% industrial. The structures that are within one mile of the facility are primarily homes and some structures incidental to agricultural uses. There are approximately 780 people that reside within one mile of the proposed facility, with nine structures and habitable buildings within 500 feet of the permit boundary. The nearest structure is approximately 75 feet east of the permit boundary and about 1,150 feet east of the proposed waste cell.

The application was received on March 17, 2004, and declared administratively complete on April 4, 2004. Notice of Notice of Receipt of Application and Intent to Obtain a Municipal Solid Waste Permit (NORI) was published on April 21, 2004 in the *Conroe Courier*. Notice of Public Meeting was published July 19, 26, and August 2, 2004 in the *Conroe Courier*, and a public meeting was held in Conroe, Texas, on August 9, 2004. The Executive Director

completed the technical review of the application on October 21, 2004, and prepared a draft permit. On November 25, 2004, the Notice of Application and Preliminary Decision for a Municipal Solid Waste Permit (NAPD) was published. Notice of Public Meeting was published on February 17, 24, and March 3, 2005 in the *Conroe Courier* and the *Houston Chronicle*, and a public meeting was held in Conroe, Texas on March 10, 2005. The Executive Director filed an original Response to Public Comment with the TCEQ Office of the Chief Clerk on July 6, 2006.

On November 10, 2006, the Executive Director received an amended application for review. The Executive Director completed technical review of the amended application on September 7, 2007, and a second NAPD was published on December 21, 2007 in English in the *Conroe Courier* and *Houston Chronicle*, and in Spanish in *El Sol*. Notice of Public Meeting was published on March 20, 27, and April 3, 2008 in the *Conroe Courier* and the *Houston Chronicle*, and a public meeting was held on April 10, 2008 in Conroe, Texas. The comment period ended on April 10, 2008. An amended Response to Comments was submitted to the Chief Clerk on June 19, 2008 and mailed by the Chief Clerk on February 13, 2009. OPIC received two requests for reconsideration and 325 requests for a contested case hearing in which a valid mailing address was provided and the author clearly requested a contested case hearing on their behalf. As discussed more fully below, OPIC recommends denying both requests for reconsideration and granting the hearing requests of each affected requestor.

II. REQUESTS FOR RECONSIDERATION

A. Applicable Law

Because the application was declared administratively complete after September 1, 1999, it is subject to the requirements of Texas Water Code Chapter 5, Subchapter M, Environmental

Permitting Procedures, §§5.551 to 5.556, added by Acts 1999, 76th Leg., ch 1350 (commonly known as "House Bill 801"). House Bill 801 created a procedural mechanism whereby, following the executive director's technical review and consideration of comments, a person may file a request for reconsideration or a request for contested case hearing, or both. The request for reconsideration in particular allows the Commission to review and reconsider the executive director's decision on an application. TEXAS WATER CODE §5.556; 30 TEXAS ADMINISTRATIVE CODE ("TAC") §55.201(e).

Any person may file a request for reconsideration of the executive director's decision. 30 TAC 55.201(e). The request for reconsideration must state the reasons why the Executive Director's decision should be reconsidered. 30 TAC 55.201(e). Responses to requests for reconsideration should address the issues raised in the request. 30 TAC §55.209(f).

B. Discussion

Timely requests for reconsideration of the Executive Director's (ED) decision were filed by Ms. Linda Standley and Ms. Deborah Doran. For the reasons discussed below, OPIC recommends that the Commission deny the pending requests for reconsideration.

Ms. Standley requests reconsideration of the ED's decision because the Spanish-speaking population has been left out of the process, and concerns regarding flooding, traffic, environmental contamination, clustering of landfill facilities, lack of community need for such a facility, and the possibility of the Applicant having overlooked major and potentially crucial details given the major amendment that was submitted which corrected some of the problems that had been pointed out by the community the Applicant had overlooked.

Ms. Doran requests reconsideration of the ED's decision based on concerns regarding property values, increased and dangerous traffic, contamination of water and soil, flooding,

destruction of the wetlands, negative impact on endangered species and their critical habitats, destruction of plant life, use of outdated information by MLS in its application materials, clustering of landfill facilities, and land use incompatibility conflicts.

Although we are sympathetic to the issues raised by Ms. Standley and Ms. Doran concerning the proposed application, without further development of the record demonstrating why the draft permit does not provide sufficient protections to address these issues, OPIC cannot recommend denial of the permit at this time. We note, however, that OPIC does recommend that each justiciable interest raised in these Requests for Reconsideration be referred to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) by virtue of the hearing requests submitted by other requestors, addressed below. OPIC further recommends that Ms. Standley and Ms. Doran be allowed to seek party status at the preliminary hearing if a contested case hearing request is approved by the Commission for any other requestor.

III. REQUESTS FOR A CONTESTED CASE HEARING

A. Applicable Law

This application was declared administratively complete after September 1, 1999; therefore, it is subject to the requirements of Texas Water Code section 5.556, added by Act 1999, 76th Leg., ch. 1350 (commonly known as "House Bill 801"). Under the applicable statutory and regulatory requirements, a hearing request must substantially comply with the following: give the name, address, daytime telephone number, and, where possible, fax number of the person who files the request; identify the requestor's personal justiciable interest affected by the application showing why the requestor is an "affected person" who may be adversely affected by the proposed facility or activity in a manner not common to members of the general public; request a contested case hearing; list all relevant and material disputed issues of fact that

were raised during the comment period that are the basis of the hearing request; and provide any other information specified in the public notice of the application. 30 TEXAS ADMIN. CODE (“TAC”) § 55.201(d).

Under 30 TAC section 55.203(a), an “affected person” is “one who has a personal justiciable interest related to a legal right, duty, privilege, power, or economic interest affected by the application.” This justiciable interest does not include an interest common to the general public. *Id.* Relevant factors that will be considered in determining whether a person is affected include:

- (1) whether the interest claimed is one protected by the law under which the application will be considered;
- (2) distance restrictions or other limitations imposed by law on the affected interest;
- (3) whether a reasonable relationship exists between the interest claimed and the activity regulated;
- (4) likely impact of the regulated activity on the health, safety, and use of property of the person;
- (5) likely impact of the regulated activity on use of the impacted natural resource by the person; and
- (6) for governmental entities, their statutory authority over or interest in the issues relevant to the application.

30 TAC § 55.203(c).

The Commission shall grant an affected person’s timely filed hearing request if: (1) the request is made pursuant to a right to hearing authorized by law; and (2) the request raises disputed issues of fact that were raised during the comment period and that are relevant and material to the Commission’s decision on the application. 30 TAC § 55.211(c).

The Commission has also set forth specific criteria for judging whether a group or organization should be considered an “affected person.” 30 TAC § 55.205(a) states that a group or association may request a hearing if:

- 1) one or more members of the group or association would otherwise have standing to request a hearing in their own right;

- 2) the interests the group or association seeks to protect are germane to the organization's purpose; and
- 3) neither the claim asserted nor the relief requested requires the participation of the individual members in the case.

Any group or association which meets all of these criteria shall be considered an "affected person."

Accordingly, responses to hearing requests must specifically address:

- (1) whether the requestor is an affected person;
- (2) which issues raised in the hearing request are disputed;
- (3) whether the dispute involves questions of fact or law;
- (4) whether the issues were raised during the public comment period;
- (5) whether the hearing request is based on issues raised solely in a public comment withdrawn by the commenter in writing by filing a withdrawal letter with the Chief Clerk prior to the filing of the Executive Director's Response to Comment;
- (6) whether the issues are relevant and material to the decision on the application; and
- (7) a maximum expected duration for the contested case hearing.

30 TAC § 55.209(e).

B. Discussion

1. Determination of Affected Person Status

OPIC received 354 timely-filed hearing requests in which a valid mailing address was provided and the author clearly requested a contested case hearing on their behalf for this application.¹ For the sake of expediency, OPIC has separated these requests into six groups.

a. CAML

A timely hearing request was submitted by Mary Carter on behalf of Citizens Against Montgomery Landfills (CAML), which included relevant contact information and raised disputed issues outlining why the requestors would be adversely affected by the proposed activity in a manner not common to members of the general public.

CAML included a statement indicating the purpose of the group is to promote the advancement of education through the pursuit and dissemination of information about problems related to pollution, environmental hazards and health risks and solutions related to solid waste facilities, water and air discharge systems, and land development within Montgomery County, Texas; serve the charitable purpose of working toward a cleaner environment for Montgomery County, Texas through education, promotion of alternatives, and communication with the citizens, local and state elected officials; and serve the scientific purposes of investigating and disseminating information about potential environmental hazards and their effects on the health and well-being of person and other living entities.

CAML represents that several of their members would have standing in their own right to request a contested case hearing due to affected justiciable interests not common to members of the general public. Namely, these members include: Paul and Rebecca Zylman; Dale and Karen Welch; Travis and Lisa Selph; Woodrow and Mary Turner; Larry Rains; Paul Simmons, Barbara, Travis, and Matt Mayeux; and Sheila Freeman. Each member has concerns regarding properly justiciable interests including water contamination, use and enjoyment of property, and health impacts.

CAML additionally raises concerns that include: adequate lining; adequate run-on and runoff protections; storage, treatment, and disposal of contaminated water; provision of safe passage of any internal or externally adjacent floodwaters; correct documentation of the 100-year floodplain and inclusion of sufficient plans to safely withstand a 100-year flood; prevention of wetlands destruction; prevention of the alteration of natural drainage patterns; land use compatibility; nuisance conditions, including odor, debris, dust, and vectors; volume of traffic and adequacy of roads for plant operations; use of facility vehicles in a manner that poses a

hazard to members of the general public; clustering; lack of need and community benefit; disproportionate impact on people receiving low incomes and minorities; lack of sufficient ownership interest in the land where the proposed facility will be located; destruction or adverse modification of the critical habitat of endangered or threatened species; compliance with the Houston-Galveston Area Council (HGAC) regional solid waste management plan; closure and post-closure plans and cost estimates; Applicant's status with the Texas Secretary of State; and alternative language notice.

The stated purpose of CAML presents a purpose that is germane to the interests it seeks to protect in its hearing request.² Each of the named affected parties live within one half mile of the proposed facility, demonstrating that a reasonable relationship exists between the interests stated and the activity regulated.³ The request also states concerns that are protected by the law under which the application will be considered.⁴ OPIC therefore recommends that CAML be determined an affected person.

b. Representative Ruben Hope

A timely hearing request was submitted by Representative Ruben Hope. Representative Hope raised concerns that include need, safety, burden on the community, protection of human health, alteration of natural drainage patterns, provision for the safe passage of any internal or externally adjacent floodwaters, failure of the Applicant to take into account the volume of traffic and the adequacy of the roads for plant operations, and use of facility vehicles in a manner that poses a hazard to members of the general public. However, Mr. Hope did not provide any information relating the relative location between his home and the proposed site, and therefore

it is impossible for OPIC to conclude that a reasonable relationship between the interests claimed and the activity regulated exists in compliance with 30 TAC §203(c)(3).

OPIC appreciates Mr. Hope's interest in the proposed permit, and notes that although OPIC does not recommend Mr. Hope be granted individual affected party status, OPIC is recommending that the Commission hold a contested case hearing on this proposed permit. For the purpose of requesting a contested case hearing and participating as an affected party in any proceedings, legislators are subject to the same inquiry under 30 TAC § 55.203, 209, and 211 as any individual or private entity. Legislators may request a public meeting on behalf of their constituents, but there is no corresponding section automatically granting a legislator's request for a contested case hearing on behalf of their constituents.⁵

c. Requestor Groups A-E

Group A, consisting of 168 people,⁶ submitted their request on a form letter that begins, "This letter is in response to the Executive Director's Response to Public Comment and opportunity to request a contested case hearing dated February 26, 2009." Group B, consisting of 85 people,⁷ submitted their request on a form letter that begins, "My comments are being submitted in response to the Notice of Application and Preliminary Decision for a Municipal Solid Waste Permit issued by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) November 13, 2007." Group C, consisting of 23 people,⁸ submitted their request on a form letter that begins, "I am writing to register my objection to the above referenced Montgomery Landfill Solutions, L.P. (MLS) proposed landfill on SH 105 and North Walker Road, Montgomery

County, Texas.” Group D, consisting of 23 people,⁹ submitted their comments on a form letter that begins, “I am writing to register my objection to the proposed Montgomery Landfill Solutions, L.P. (MLS) proposed landfill on SH 105 and North Walker Road, Montgomery County, Texas.” Requestors in Group E, consisting of 53 people,¹⁰ composed only individual letters, or individual letters which contained concerns not already represented in an additionally-submitted form letter described above in reference to Groups A-D. Each of the requests included relevant contact information and raised disputed issues outlining why the requestor believed they would be adversely affected by the proposed activity in a manner not common to members of the general public.

The concerns of requestors in Group A include: inadequate alternative language notice, noncompliance with the Houston-Galveston Area Council (HGAC) regional solid waste management plan; opposition by public officials and administrative bodies in Montgomery County; protraction of the permitting process due to Applicant's errors; protection of human health; economic burden upon the communities effected by the permit in being compelled to retain counsel at the residents' expense; lack of need; clustering and redundancy of facilities; lack of commitment by Applicant to operate the facility in the future; land use compatibility conflicts; failure of the Applicant to take into account the volume of traffic and the adequacy of roads for plant operations; use of facility vehicles in a manner that poses a hazard to members of the general public; alteration of natural drainage patterns; inadequate runoff protections; inadequate lining; contamination of water sources; inadequate monitoring; air pollution; soil contamination; and property devaluation.

The concerns of requestors in Group B include: volume of traffic and adequacy of the roads for plant operations; use of facility vehicles in a manner that poses a hazard to members of the general public; protection of human health; provision of adequate runoff protections; sufficient provisions for the storage, treatment, and disposal of contaminated water; adequate monitoring of contaminants; provision for the safe passage of any internal or externally adjacent floodwaters; correct documentation of the 100-year floodplain; sufficiency of plans to safely withstand a 100-year flood; protection of wetlands; alteration of natural drainage patterns; adequate screening; land use incompatibility conflicts; protection of wildlife, including endangered species; compliance with the Houston-Galveston Area Council (HGAC) regional solid waste management plan; and provision for closure and post-closure plans and cost estimates.

The concerns of requestors in Group C include: safe passage of any internal or externally adjacent floodwaters; correct documentation of the 100-year floodplain; sufficient plans to safely withstand a 100-year flood; contamination of water sources; protection of human health; and protection of wildlife.

The concerns of requestors in Group D include: clustering of landfills; land use incompatibility conflicts; decreased property values; failure of the Applicant to take into account the volume of traffic and the adequacy of roads for plant operations; use of facility vehicles in a manner that poses a hazard to members of the general public; alteration of natural drainage patterns; lack of provision for the safe passage of any internal or externally adjacent floodwaters; contamination of water sources; destruction of the wetlands; and protection of wildlife, including endangered species.

The concerns of requesters in Group E include one or more of the following: need; clustering; contamination of water sources; failure of the Applicant to take into account the volume of traffic and the adequacy of the roads for plant operations; use of facility vehicles in a manner that poses a hazard to members of the general public; provision for safe passage of any internal or externally adjacent floodwaters; correct documentation of the 100-year floodplain and inclusion of sufficient plans to safely withstand a 100-year flood; nuisance conditions, including odor, debris, dust, and vectors; inadequate screening; fear that the facility will be converted to a Type I facility and then sold to another operator; contamination of water sources; inadequate lining; inadequate run-on and runoff protections; storage, treatment, and disposal of contaminated water; alteration of natural drainage patterns; destruction of wetlands; land use compatibility conflicts; destruction or adverse modification of the critical habitat of endangered or threatened species; noncompliance with the Houston-Galveston Area Council (HGAC) regional solid waste management plan; closure and post-closure plans and cost estimates; decreased property values; opposition to the facility by public officials and administrative bodies; noise nuisance; unnecessary capacity and height of facility; potential gas releases; loss of possible tax revenue; use and enjoyment of property; competency of the Applicant's engineer; Applicant's status with the Texas Secretary of State; Applicant's competency to own and operate a dangerous business; lack of financial means to construct a landfill; appropriateness of site selection; lack of Applicant's ownership interest in the land where the proposed facility will be located; incorrect identification of churches, licensed daycare facilities, or hospitals within one mile of the proposed site; air pollution; insufficient public meetings; negative effects on economic or business interests; and the applicability of Health and Safety Code §361.123.

Requestor Alan B. Sadler, county judge in Montgomery County, submitted a hearing request indicating that the attached resolution against Montgomery County landfill by the Montgomery County Commissioners' Court was the basis of his request. It is unclear from this correspondence whether Mr. Sadler was requesting a hearing in his personal capacity or with representative authority to speak on behalf of the Commissioners' Court. OPIC recommends that Mr. Sadler be named a party and allowed the opportunity to present an additional resolution or other documentation of his authority to represent the Montgomery County Commissioners' Court as party to the contested case hearing if that was his intent.

OPIC finds that each of the interests raised by the above group and individual hearing requestors are protected by the law under which the application will be considered¹¹ with the exception of: inadequate alternative language notice, opposition by public officials and administrative bodies in Montgomery County, protraction of the permitting process due to Applicant's errors, burden upon the communities effected by the permit in being compelled to retain counsel at the residents' expense, lack of need, clustering and redundancy of facilities, lack of commitment by Applicant to operate the facility in the future, property devaluation, fear that the facility will be converted to a Type I facility and then sold to another operator, unnecessarily large capacity and height of facility, loss of possible tax revenue, competency of the Applicant's engineer, Applicant's status with the Texas Secretary of State, Applicant's competency to own and operate a dangerous business, lack of financial means to construct a landfill, availability of a different site selection, and disproportionate impact on minorities and people receiving low incomes.

An important factor in the determination of whether a requestor is an affected person, as articulated in 30 TAC §203(c)(3), is the establishment of a reasonable relationship between the interest claimed and the activity regulated. The relative location of each requestor to the proposed facility was not available to OPIC at the time of this response. Without information relating to the distance between the homes and businesses of each individual requestor and the proposed facility, OPIC cannot make individual recommendations at this time as to whether a reasonable relationship exists between each requestor and their respective interests. Given the myriad of personal, justiciable interests raised by each requestor, OPIC therefore recommends that each requestor from Groups A-E within a reasonable distance from the proposed facility, as determined by the Commissioners, be found to have met the requirements of 30 TAC §203(c)(3) as affected persons.

B. Issues Raised in the Hearing Request

1. Was adequate alternative language notice provided to the Spanish-speaking community?
2. Does opposition by local and state public officials and administrative bodies provide grounds for denial of the permit?
3. Has the Applicant's protraction of the permitting process due to its own errors placed an unfair burden upon the communities affected by the permit by compelling residents to retain counsel?
4. Is the proposed landfill needed in Montgomery County?
5. Will the proposed facility result in unnecessary clustering and redundancy of facilities?
6. Is the Applicant committed to operating the facility in the future?
7. Will the proposed facility result in devaluation of surrounding property?
8. Will the facility be converted to a Type I facility in the future and then sold to another operator?
9. Is the facility unnecessarily large in capacity and height?
10. Will loss of tax revenue ensue if the proposed facility is constructed?
11. Is the Applicant's engineer competent?
12. Is the Applicant in good standing with the Texas Secretary of State?
13. Is the Applicant competent to own and operate a dangerous business?
14. Does the Applicant lack financial means to construct a landfill?
15. Should the facility have been located at another site?
16. Will construction and operation of the facility have a disproportionate impact on people receiving low incomes and on minorities?
17. Was alternative language notice provided in compliance with applicable provisions?

18. Does the proposed permit comply with the regional solid waste management plan promulgated by the Houston-Galveston Council of Governments (H-GAC)?
19. Is the proposed site of the facility incompatible with land use such that human health and the environment will be adversely impacted?
20. Does the application completely and accurately provide data on both the availability and adequacy of roads Applicant will use to access the site and volumes of vehicular traffic on access roads within one mile of the proposed facility?
21. Will the vehicles and equipment being used for the collection and transportation of waste be operated so as to minimize health and safety hazards to solid waste management personnel and the public?
22. Does the application completely and accurately provide data demonstrating that construction of the facility will not result in alteration of natural drainage patterns?
23. Will the facility's run-on and run-off management systems perform adequately?
24. Does the application provide for a sufficient site liner?
25. Will the facility adequately protect groundwater and surface water?
26. Does the application provide adequate provisions for groundwater monitoring?
27. Does the application provide adequate provisions to prevent contamination of soil and nearby property?
28. Does the application provide sufficient provisions for the storage, treatment, and disposal of contaminated water?
29. Does the application contain adequate provisions for the safe passage of any internal or externally adjacent floodwaters?
30. Does the application correctly document the location of the 100-year floodplain and include sufficient plans to safely withstand a 100-year flood as required by agency rules?
31. Does the application completely and accurately include information pertaining to the wetlands?
32. Does the application provide sufficient provisions for screening the deposited waste materials?
33. Does the application correctly identify and provide for the protection of endangered species?
34. Does the application propose adequate funds provisions for closure and post-closure measures?
35. Does the application include adequate provisions to control spilled and windblown waste and clean up spilled waste in compliance with agency rules?
36. Does the application provide adequate provisions to control odor nuisance?
37. Does the application provide adequate provisions to control vectors in compliance with agency rules?
38. Does the application provide adequate provisions to prevent a dust nuisance in compliance with agency rules?
39. Does the application provide adequate access control provisions in compliance with agency rules?
40. Does the Applicant possess a sufficient ownership interest or right to use the property, including the access route thereto, on which the proposed facility will be located in compliance with agency rules?
41. Does the application include adequate provisions to manage landfill gas in compliance with agency rules?

42. Will operation of the Applicant's facility interrupt the use and enjoyment of requestors' property?
43. Does the application completely and accurately identify churches, licensed daycare facilities, or hospitals within one mile of the propose site in compliance with agency rules?
44. Will the Applicant's facility negatively affect requestors' existing business interests that utilize property likely to be affected by facility operations?

C. Issues raised in Comment Period

All of the issues raised in the hearing request were raised in the comment period and have not been withdrawn. 30 TAC §§55.201(c) & (d)(4), 55.211(c)(2)(A).

D. Disputed Issues

There is no agreement between the Applicant, the Executive Director, and the Requestor on the issues presented above.

E. Issues of Fact

If the Commission considers an issue to be one of fact, rather than one of law or policy, it is appropriate for referral to hearing if it meets all other applicable requirements. See 30 TAC §55.211(b)(3)(A) and (B). All of the above issues are issues of fact except for the question of adequate alternative language notice.

At the time the original application was declared administratively complete, alternative language notice newspaper publication requirements were only applicable to air permits. However, after filing its amended application on September 7, 2007, the Applicant was required by 30 TAC §39.405(h) to publish its second NAPD in both English and Spanish. The second NAPD was published in the Spanish language newspaper of general circulation in Montgomery County, *El Sol*, on December 21, 2007. The notice stated that technical review of the application had been completed, that a draft permit had been issued, and that a copy of the approval and draft permit was available in the Montgomery County library. Nothing further is required of the

Applicant under agency rules, and no issue of fact remains as to whether alternative notice was properly issued.

F. Relevant and Material Issues

Certain issues raised by the requesters are relevant and material to the Commission's decision on the application. Relevant and material issues are those that are governed by the substantive law under which this permit is to be issued.¹² In order to refer an issue to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH), the Commission must find that the issue is relevant and material to the Commission's decision to issue or deny this permit.¹³

The requestors' concerns regarding compliance with the regional solid waste management plan;¹⁴ compatible land use conflicts;¹⁵ availability and adequacy of roads and characterization of vehicular traffic within one mile of the proposed facility;¹⁶ waste collection and transportation vehicle safety hazards;¹⁷ alteration of natural drainage patterns;¹⁸ run-on and run-off managements systems;¹⁹ site liner sufficiency;²⁰ groundwater and surface water protection;²¹ groundwater monitoring;²² soil contamination;²³ storage, treatment, and disposal of contaminated water concerns;²⁴ safe passage of internal or externally adjacent floodwaters;²⁵

100-year floodplain calculations and engineering plans;²⁶ protection of wetlands;²⁷ adequate screening;²⁸ protection of endangered species and critical habitats;²⁹ closure and post-closure provisions;³⁰ spilled and windblown waste control and remediation;³¹ odor nuisance;³² vector control;³³ dust nuisance;³⁴ access control;³⁵ sufficiency of Applicant's ownership interests in the proposed site;³⁶ landfill gas management;³⁷ continued use and enjoyment of property by affected residents;³⁸ accurate identification of nearby churches, hospitals, and licensed daycares;³⁹ and affected requestors' business interests⁴⁰ are all relevant and material to the Commission's decision under the requirements of 30 TAC §§ 55.201(d)(4) and 55.211(c)(2)(A). These issues are addressed by the substantive law governing this application, are within the jurisdiction of the TCEQ, and can be addressed in a hearing on the pending application.⁴¹

Additionally, OPIC finds that the question of whether Health and Safety Code §361.123(b) forbids construction of the proposed Type IV municipal solid waste landfill in Montgomery County is material and relevant to the permitting decision, despite the fact that that particular section only applies to facilities whose application was received after the effective date of the Act, June 18, 2005. OPIC finds that the major amendment to the permit may have so fundamentally changed the proposed facility that the amended application received by the

Commission on November 10, 2006 may have constituted an entirely new application, as it did for notice provisions. Therefore, OPIC finds this issue is also appropriate for referral to the State Office of Administrative Hearings.

The requestors also state issues that are not material and relevant to the Commission's permitting decision. Issues which are speculative or otherwise not addressed by the substantive law governing this application and therefore cannot be considered relevant and material to the Commission's decision include: opposition by public officials and administrative bodies; protraction of the permitting process due to Applicant's errors; burden upon the communities in being compelled to retain counsel at their own expense; lack of need; clustering and redundancy of facilities; lack of commitment by Applicant to operate the facility in the future; property devaluation; fear that the facility will be converted to a Type I facility and then sold to another operator; unnecessary capacity and height of facility; loss of possible tax revenue; competency of the Applicant's engineer; Applicant's status with the Texas Secretary of State; Applicant's competency to own and operate a the facility; lack of financial means to construct a landfill; and the question of whether a preferable site is available.

The issue of disproportionate impact on people receiving low incomes and minorities is a matter which the Commission takes very seriously and which has been addressed in the Commission's environmental equity policy. However, the lack of specific standards applicable in this instance prevents this issue from being properly justiciable in a court of law. OPIC therefore finds that the issues discussed in this section are inappropriate for referral to the State Office of Administrative Hearings.

G. Issues Recommended for Referral

OPIC recommends that the following disputed issues of fact be referred to the State

Office of Administrative Hearings for a contested case hearing:

1. Does the proposed permit comply with the regional solid waste management plan promulgated by the Houston-Galveston Council of Governments (H-GAC) as directed in agency rules, including 30 TAC §330.635(a)(2)(C)(vi)?
2. Is the proposed site of the facility incompatible with land use such that human health and the environment will be adversely impacted in violation of agency rules, including 30 TAC §33.53(b)(8)?
3. Does the application completely and accurately provide data on both the availability and adequacy of roads Applicant will use to access the site and volumes of vehicular traffic on access roads within one mile of the proposed facility in compliance with 330.53(b)(9)?
4. Will the vehicles and equipment being used for the collection and transportation of waste be operated so as to minimize health and safety hazards to solid waste management personnel and the public in violation of agency rules, including 30 TAC §330.33(a)?
5. Does the application completely and accurately provide data demonstrating that construction of the facility result in alteration of natural drainage patterns in contravention of 30 TAC § 330.55(b)(5)(D)?
6. Does the facility's run-on and run-off management systems comply with 30 TAC §330.55(b)(2)&(3)?
7. Does the application provide for a site liner sufficient to meet agency requirements, including 30 TAC §330.200(e)?
8. Will the facility adequately protect groundwater and surface water in compliance with agency rules, including 30 TAC §330.5?
9. Does the application provide adequate provisions for groundwater monitoring in compliance with agency rules, including 30 TAC §330.231(a)?
10. Does the application provide adequate provisions to prevent contamination of soil and nearby property in violation of 30 TAC §330.5(a)(3)?
11. Does the application provide sufficient provisions for the storage, treatment, and disposal of contaminated water in compliance with agency rules, including 30 TAC §330.56(o)?
12. Does the application contain adequate provisions for the safe passage of any internal or externally adjacent floodwaters in compliance with 30 TAC §330.56(f)?
13. Does the application correctly document the location of the 100-year floodplain in accordance with 30 TAC §330.55(f)(3), and include sufficient plans to safely withstand a 100-year flood as required by agency rules, including 30 TAC §§330.55(f)(4)(B)(i) & 330.301?
14. Does the application completely and accurately include information pertaining to the wetlands and comply with applicable agency rules, including 30 TAC §302?
15. Does the application provide sufficient provisions for screening the deposited waste materials as directed by 30 TAC §330.138?
16. Does the application correctly identify and provide for the protection of endangered species as required by agency rules, including 30 TAC §§330.129 & 330.53(b)(13)?

17. Does the application propose adequate funds provisions for closure and post-closure measures, in compliance with agency rules, including 30 TAC §§330.254-330.256?
18. Does the application include adequate provisions to control spilled and windblown waste and clean up spilled waste in compliance with agency rules, including 30 TAC §330.120?
19. Does the application provide adequate provisions to control odor nuisance in compliance with agency rules, including 30 TAC §330.125(b)?
20. Does the application provide adequate provisions to control vectors in compliance with agency rules, including 30 TAC §330.126?
21. Does the application provide adequate provisions to prevent a dust nuisance in compliance with agency rules, including §330.127(b)?
22. Does the application provide adequate access control provisions in compliance with agency rules, including 30 TAC §330.116?
23. Does the Applicant possess a sufficient interest in or right to use the property, including the access route thereto, on which the proposed facility will be located in compliance with agency rules, including 30 TAC §330.62?
24. Does the application include adequate provisions to manage landfill gas in compliance with agency rules, including 30 TAC §§330.130 & 330.56(n)?
25. Will operation of the Applicant's facility interrupt the use and enjoyment of requestors' property in violation of agency rules, including 30 TAC §55.203(c)(4)?
26. Does the application completely and accurately identify churches, licensed daycare facilities, or hospitals within one mile of the propose site in compliance with agency rules, including 30 TAC §330.52(b)(4)(A)(iv)?
27. Will the Applicant's facility negatively affect requestors' existing business interests that utilize property likely to be affected by facility operations in violation of agency rules, including 30 TAC §55.203(a)?
28. Does Health and Safety Code §361.123(b) forbid construction of the proposed Type IV municipal solid waste landfill in Montgomery County?

H. Maximum Expected Duration of Hearing

Commission Rule 30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 55.115(d) requires that any Commission order referring a case to SOAH specify the maximum expected duration of the hearing by stating a date by which the judge is expected to issue a proposal for decision. The rule further provides that no hearing shall be longer than one year from the first day of the preliminary hearing to the date the proposal for decision is issued. To assist the Commission in stating a date by which the judge is expected to issue a proposal for decision, and as required by 30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §55.209(d)(7), OPIC estimates that the maximum expected duration of a hearing on this

application would be one year from the first date of the preliminary hearing until the proposal for decision is issued.

IV. CONCLUSION

OPIC recommends denying the requests for reconsideration and the contested case hearing request of Representative Ruben Hope, and granting the contested case hearing requests of CAML and each affected requestor in Groups A-E. OPIC also recommends referring the matter to SOAH for an evidentiary hearing on the issues recommended above. OPIC suggests a hearing duration of one year.


