AGENDA SETTING FILED BY THE COUNSEL FOR THE "SCOTT FAMILY"**

TO THE HONORABLE (ACTING) GENERAL COUNSEL OF THE TCEQ, CELESTE  
BAKER:


Now comes the County Line Water Supply Corporation ("CLWSC") and filed this opposition to the Motion for Continuance that has been filed by the counsel for the Scott Family and in support states the following:

1. This Application has been pending before the TCEQ since December 2005 when it was declared administratively complete. The requested delay will have the effect of further delaying the much needed conversion that the Applicant seek so that it can issue tax exempt bonds for urgently needed infrastructure projects.
2. If this administrative process in not completed in time, rate payers will have to finance the infrastructure projects with taxable bonds at greater expense to the ratepayers; indeed, such an event would have the effect of frustrating the Legislative intent of creating Special Utility Districts so that rate payers could take advantage of tax exempt financing.
3. The sole issue in this case is the reasonableness of the Impact Fee. The requested fee was reviewed by the Commission Staff and found to be reasonable. The Scott Family

seeks a lower fee for their property at the risk of causing all other property owners more expense.

4. Applicant attempted to have this case referred directly to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) as allowed by Rule §55.254 of the TAC and expeditiously resolve the issues raised by the Scott Family; however, Council for the Scott Family would not agree to the direct referral causing further delay. Indeed, but for the unwillingness of the Scott Family counsel to move this process along, we would have already been heard by the SOAH.
5. The Scott Family is represented by a large law firm with many attorneys. Clearly, someone else could attend the December 19, 2007 hearing at which no oral argument will be permitted.
6. Applicant believes that the administrative process is being used, wittingly or unwittingly, to hurt the interest of our client and the rate payers. We urge that this matter be allowed to proceed so that the only remaining issue can be expeditiously resolved.



TO THE MEMBERS OF THE TEXAS COMMISSION ON ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY:

The Office of Public Interest Counsel (OPIC) of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ or the Commission) responds to the Motion for Continuance filed by S.R. Scott Family L.P. (Scott Family or Movant) in the above-referenced matter:

**I. INTRODUCTION**

The Movant has requested a contested case hearing regarding the application filed by County Line Water Supply Corporation (County Line or Applicant) for conversion to a Special Utility District (SUD) and for approval of an impact fee. County Line has already assented to the contested case hearing and on August 1, 2007 filed a motion for direct referral of this matter to the State Office of Administrative Hearings. Despite the Applicant's agreement to the contested case hearing that the Movant has requested, the Movant has refused to agree to direct referral stating it cannot agree on issues to be referred or duration of hearing. Therefore, the Commission has now scheduled December 19, 2007 as the date to consider the Movant's hearing request. The Scott Family now seeks to continue this date because one of the Movant's two legal representatives, Ms. Celina Romero, is unable to attend the meeting for personal reasons.

## II. RESPONSE

OPIC notes that the request for continuance is signed by two legal representatives: Ms. Romero and Mr. John M. Joseph. While OPIC understands that Ms. Romero would not be able to attend, OPIC does not have any indication from the motion that Mr. Joseph would be unavailable. Having raised this point, OPIC will defer to the Commission's discretion regarding the continuance.



TO THE HONORABLE (ACTING) GENERAL COUNSEL OF THE TCEQ, CELESTE BAKER:

COMES NOW, the S.R. Scott Family L.P. (the "Scott Family"), the Protestant herein, and files this Motion for Continuance of the December 19, 2007 Agenda Setting and Dates for Filing Responses pursuant to 30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 10.3 and 10.4(b) and in support states the following:

I.

Due to a scheduling conflict caused by counsel's previously scheduled medical procedure, the Scott Family seeks a short continuance of the date on which the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality ("Commission") will consider its request for a contested case hearing on the above-identified application and a corresponding continuance of the deadlines for filing responses to the request for hearing and replies to the responses. This matter is now set for Commission consideration at its December 19, 2007 Agenda. Currently, written responses to the request for hearing filed on the County Line Water Supply's application are due on November 26, 2007, and written replies to responses are due on December 10, 2007. The Scott Family respectfully requests that this Agenda date be continued to the next Commission meeting date of January 16, 2008, and that the deadline for filing responses to the request for

hearing and replies to the responses be set for December 21, 2007 and January 7, 2008, respectively. Counsel for the Scott Family has a previously scheduled surgery on December 19, 2007, and respectfully requests a short continuance to accommodate that procedure.

II.

CERTIFICATE OF CONFERENCE

Counsel for the Scott Family has consulted with counsel for the Executive Director, counsel for the Office of Public Interest Counsel ("OPIC") and counsel for the Applicant. Counsel for the Executive Director does not object to this continuance. Counsel for the OPIC and counsel for the Applicant, however, object to the continuance on the stated basis that the Applicant has filed a request for direct referral to the State Office of Administrative Hearing. This basis is not, however, a basis to object to the continuance now sought by Protestant. A direct referral has not been obtained because the Scott Family and the Applicant have not been able to reach an agreement on the list of issues and maximum expected duration of the hearing pursuant to 30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 55.254(g).

III.

CONTINUANCE NOT SOUGHT FOR DELAY

The Scott Family seeks this continuance not for the purpose of delay but so that in the event that the Commission has questions about the Scott Family's issues and concerns with the application that counsel for the Scott Family might be present to answer those questions.

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, the S.R. Scott Family L.P., respectfully requests that the General Counsel grant this Motion for Continuance pursuant to 30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 10.3 and 10.4(b) and continue the date of the Commission's Agenda at which the request for hearing will be considered to January 16, 2008, and set the deadline for filing

responses to the request for hearing for December 21, 2007, and for filing replies to the responses for January 7, 2008, and for such further relief to which it has shown itself entitled.

The meeting will begin at 9:30 a.m. in Room 201S of Building E, at the Commission's offices located at 12100 Park 35 Circle in Austin, Texas.

In accordance with Commission rules, copies of the request(s) have been forwarded to the applicant, the Executive Director of the TCEQ, and the Public Interest Counsel of the TCEQ. They may file written responses to these requests on or before 5:00 p.m. on **November 26, 2007**. Persons who filed requests (requesters) may file a written reply to responses on or before 5:00 p.m. on **December 10, 2007**. All responses and replies must be filed with the Chief Clerk of the TCEQ, and sent on the same day to all individuals on the attached mailing list. The address of the Chief Clerk's Office is: Chief Clerk, ATTN: Agenda Docket Clerk, Mail Code 105, P.O. Box 13087, Austin, Texas 78711-3087 (Fax 512/239-3311). The procedures for evaluating requests are found in Chapter 55 of the Commission's rules. Commission Rules 1.10, 1.11, and 55.254 concern the filing and serving of documents.

The Commissioners will not take oral argument or public comment on this matter, but may wish to ask questions of the applicant, hearing requesters, or staff. The Commissioners will make their decision based on the requests, written responses to the requests, any written replies to those responses, and any response to questions.

Copies of all requests have also been referred to the Alternative Dispute Resolution Office, where they will be evaluated to determine if informal, voluntary mediation might help resolve any dispute.

The attachment to this letter is intended to help you better understand public participation and the processing of requests. Individual members of the public may seek further information concerning the application, public participation, the processing of requests, copies of Commission rules, or the attachment, by calling the TCEQ Office of Public Assistance, toll free, at 1-800-687-4040.

## Public Participation in TCEQ Proceedings

The Commission encourages public participation. The Commission's Office of Public Assistance (OPA) provides individual members of the public information on applications, and on Commission procedures. OPA may respond to your inquiries in writing and provide you with information. OPA may be reached, toll free, at 1-800-687-4040.

The formal way for public participation is through the contested case hearing. The law allows for holding contested case hearings on certain types of applications; the remainder of this document provides an overview of the processing of requests for a contested case hearing. It describes the requirements for a hearing request and how the Commission processes hearing requests.

A hearing request must:

- (1) give the name, address, and daytime telephone number of the person who files the request. If the request is made by a group or association, the request must identify one person by name, address, daytime telephone number, and, where possible, fax number, who shall be responsible for receiving all official communications and documents for the group;
- (2) identify the person's personal justiciable interest affected by the application;
- (3) request a contested case hearing;
- (4) provide any other information specified in the public notice of application;
- (5) be timely filed with the Chief Clerk, as set out in the public notice; and
- (6) be pursuant to a right to hearing authorized by law.

The three Commissioners determine the validity of hearing requests, and vote to approve or deny the hearing requests during a public meeting, which are usually held every other Wednesday in Austin. Leading up to the meeting, the following occurs:

- (1) the written hearing requests are distributed to the Executive Director, the Public Interest Counsel, and the Applicant; these persons may file a response to the hearing requests 23 days before the meeting;
- (2) the hearing requester may then file a reply to the responses nine days before the meeting; this is the hearing requester's opportunity to correct any deficiencies in the hearing request that have been identified by TCEQ staff or the applicant. The hearing requester should be sure to submit any information (for example, maps or diagrams showing the requestor's location relative to the applicant's proposed activities) by this deadline he or she wishes the Commissioners to consider; and
- (3) the Commissioners read the hearing requests, the responses to the hearing requests, and the replies, before the public meeting. Then during the public meeting the Commissioners discuss the application and the hearing requests, and vote to grant or deny the hearing requests.

If the Commissioners deny the hearing requests then they often will proceed and vote to approve or deny the application. If the Commissioners grant the hearing requests they will refer the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH), which will conduct a contested case hearing. A SOAH judge will then submit a recommendation to the Commission to approve or deny the application.

The Commission's evaluation of a hearing request is based on Texas Water Code Chapter 5, which provides the Commission need not grant a hearing request if the requester does not have a personal justiciable interest. The

Commission's rules on processing hearing requests are at 30 Texas Administrative Code, Chapter 55. The "personal justiciable interest" requirement means that a hearing requester must be impacted personally, not just as a member of the general public, by the Commission's decision on the application. Also, the hearing requester's interest must be "justiciable," meaning the Commission will grant hearing requests only if the requester complains of matters within the Commission's authority. So a hearing request complaining of other matters outside the Commission's authority would be denied.

The Alternative Dispute Resolution Office may contact hearing requesters to learn if they would participate in informal discussions with the applicant and a mediator. The Public Interest Counsel may also provide information on the processing of hearing requests.
