
To Whom it may concern,

This letter is to request a public meeting and a contested case hearing regarding the re-issuing of permit # 2345, which would re-open the abandoned and deteriorating asphalt plant owned by H&B Contractors. I was unaware until now that this permit has been requested.

I have expressed my concern about this plant for many years. If allowed, the plant will be operating within 1000 yards of my place of residence. The gases and noise associated with the operation of this plant will be an unhealthy environment to live in. In previous years, this permit has been denied in part because of the unhealthy environment it created, and the inability of the plant to meet the required health and safety standards.

My wife died a horrible death from cancer just 4 years ago, and her death was most certainly associated with years of living in close proximity to this functioning plant. As she struggled to live, her pleading was heard and the previous attempts to reopen this plant were denied. She was promised that the plant would never be allowed to harm another person. Unfortunately, that promise seems to have been forgotten. I wish to repeat her plea, so that the operation of this plant cannot harm any others. As the area around the asphalt plant continues to develop, it is almost certain that hundreds of more people will be exposed to the harmful effects that certainly lead to the death of my loved one.

Please advise me of the date and time of the hearing I have requested. I appreciate your sincere consideration of this most important matter, which will negatively affect the lives of so many people.


