
Dear Ms. Brauer:

Thank you for your request for a public meeting in your letter dated July 16, 2007 on the application submitted by Orangefield Water Supply Corporation. In order to determine whether a public meeting should be held, the Executive Director considers the factors set out in 30 Texas Administrative Code Section 55.154. These rules require that a public meeting be held if: (1) the Executive Director determines that there is a substantial or significant degree of public interest in an application; (2) a member of the legislature who represents the general area in which the facility is located or proposed to be located requests that a public meeting be held; or (3) when a public meeting is otherwise required by law. The Executive Director has determined not to hold a public meeting on this application.

As you requested, I have included copies of the Notice of Application and Preliminary Decision (Attachment A) and Draft Permit No. WQ0014772001 (Attachment B). Due to the large number of documents that make up the permit application, and the size of the various maps included with the application, please call the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality's (the Commission or TCEQ) Office of the Chief Clerk at (512) 239-3300 to arrange to have these documents copied and mailed to you. There will be a fee for providing you with these copies. You may also examine and photocopy these documents during normal office hours at the TCEQ's Office of the Chief Clerk, located at 12100 Park 35 Circle, Bldg. F, Austin, Texas 78753. Finally, the permit application, Executive Director's preliminary decision, and draft permit are available for viewing and copying at the Orange County Courthouse, 801 West Division, Orange, Texas 77630.
