Our firm represents Waco Composites I, Ltd. in connection with the above referenced matter. Pursuant to the September 2, 2008 letter from the Chief Clerk this is a formal written response to the hearing requests.

As part of the process of requesting the above-referenced permit, our client retained the services of Dr. Robert A. Haberlein, Ph.D, QEP of Engineering and Environmental Consulting Services to perform studies and analysis to determine what permit requirements would be appropriate. After extensive work by Dr. Haberlein, our client has fully and completely complied with all of the requirements of the requested permit (even though the permit has not yet been granted). Accordingly, if the permit is granted, Waco Composites will unquestionably be in compliance with the requirements.

Significantly, since the permitting process began, our client has not received a single complaint or notice of any complaint by the requestors or anyone else living in the vicinity.
