RE: Formal Comments on Wheatcraft Quarry Proposed Air Quality Permit #76508

Welcome and thank you for taking your time to hold this hearing in order to listen to the concerns of the citizens and entities of Kerr County regarding the Wheatcraft Quarry's Proposed Air Quality Permit # 76508.

For the record, I am Ray Buck, General Manager of the Upper Guadalupe River Authority. On behalf of and at the request of the Upper Guadalupe River Authority Board of Directors, I am pleased to submit formal comments for your consideration.

Allow me to read our mission statement. The mission of UGRA is as follows: The Upper Guadalupe River Authority will work independently or cooperatively with entities that have mutual interest in stewardship of the Upper Guadalupe River and tributaries through:

- 1) Scientific Investigation
 - a) To build a knowledge base relating to the interaction of spring flow and the river flow to support the establishment of sound public policy.
- 2) Water Quality
 - a) Maintain an active monitoring program to insure clean waters; and,
 - b) Promote conservation programs and measures throughout Kerr County; and,
 - c) Encourage the restoration of the Guadalupe River watershed through proper land management practices.

3) Water Development

- a) Promote the development of a dependable water supply for Kerr County; and,
- b) Promote and encourage regional wastewater systems for the protection of water quality and as a source of reuse water.

4) Public Education

- a) Actively facilitate the understanding of water issues, programs, conservation, and preservation to achieve the cooperation of the citizens of Kerr County in maintaining and promoting the health and enjoyment of the Upper Guadalupe River Basin.

In its effort to fulfill our mission statement, UGRA has formed a Quarry Research Committee which is currently studying the issues associated with quarries near the Guadalupe River. We note that air quality permits are not in UGRA's jurisdiction; however, an accepted management practice for controlling airborne particulates does involve the use of substantial amounts of water. We understand that the Wheatcraft Quarry is planning to use surface water from the Guadalupe River, and this is the basis for our comments. To date UGRA has identified the following concerns:

1. The applicant proposes to use his water rights for airborne particulate control through a permit he owns which is designated for agricultural uses not for mining or quarrying operations. UGRA understands that Mr. Wheatcraft has applied for a change of use; however, to date he has not received the change of use. An initial visit by UGRA staff discovered that Mr. Wheatcraft was pumping from the river for quarry operations.
2. All water permits contain a specific point of diversion. UGRA staff found a pump in the river at the Wheatcraft Quarry site and reported the observation to TCEQ. Mr. Wheatcraft was cited by TCEQ for pumping water without a permit. To our knowledge the applicant has not received a change to his point of diversion for his permit.
3. It is unknown to UGRA whether or not Mr. Wheatcraft's surface water permit contains a sufficient amount of water to control the airborne particulate as may be required under this proposed Air Quality Permit.
4. The UGRA Quarry Research Committee studying this issue received information from the Brazos River Authority (BRA) regarding water turbidity and water quality adjacent to quarrying operations. BRA learned that it is difficult to measure the turbidity in the water created by quarry activities because the heavier particles settle too fast to be accurately measured. Potential silting in or along the river bank near the quarry could lead to an unknown degradation of water quality which would only be determined after the damage occurs.
5. UGRA staff discovered that Mr. Wheatcraft was operating the quarry without a Storm Water Discharge Permit and reported the activity to TCEQ. Mr. Wheatcraft was cited by TCEQ for operating the quarry without the proper water quality safeguards in place.

UGRA looks forward to working closely with TCEQ regarding this issue and finding a reasonable resolution. We appreciate your interest in our concerns, the citizens of Kerr County, and our river. The Guadalupe with its scenic beauty and pristine waters forms the basis of our economic engine, and its protection is vital to our future. Thank you for allowing us to submit our concerns and for your sincere interest in our "crown jewel", the Guadalupe River.

Over one year has elapsed since TCEQ conducted its last public meeting in Center Point, Texas, regarding the Wheatcraft, Inc., Application for Air Quality Permit No. 76508.

Needless to say, my constituents in the Eastern part of Kerr County, most directly affected by the Wheatcraft operation, as I, are beginning to wonder if, and when TCEQ intends to issue its findings and rulings in this matter. When might we expect a ruling from TCEQ?

The result of this lengthy delay on TCEQ's part has created a situation where Wheatcraft, Inc., literally operates with indifference and impunity to the health and safety concerns of the community.

I am enclosing for your information and review an email with photo attachments of the dust problem being created by the inordinate number of trucks that enter and leave this mining area. In addition to the dust problem, this amount of traffic exiting onto SH 27 has created safety issues for travelers in this area.

It seems realistic to me that, notwithstanding the delays in ruling on the Wheatcraft Air Quality Permit, TCEQ would seek to enforce reasonable operational standards that protect the health and safety of the general public living and working in the immediate area.

I live on a small ranch (57 acres) on Red Bird Loop in Center Point and we have discussed the Wheatcraft Quarry previously at your office. Can you take time to go see the dust being created by the large gravel trucks going in and out of the site on Hwy 27? With the strong southerly winds driving the dust directly across the paths of vehicles on Hwy 27 and the continual large trucks that slow down to enter and exit slowly backing up traffic on Hwy 27, it is only a matter of time when someone is killed. This is a dangerous situation plus the dust can create problems for anyone living down wind with breathing problems. I have attached a couple of photos that are typical of the daily situation.

As part of the Wheatcraft Rock Crusher permit process they are to wet down their roads and as yet I have never seen that done. I know the permit has not been approved, but I believe owner does not care about how their operations impact homes, the environment nor the potential of causing a serious traffic accident.

As our commissioner I would hope you can impact this situation quickly. I have copied the TCEQ Environmental Complaint address as well.


