Dear Sirs,

I am writing this letter, on behalf of the residents of Seven Coves, to enter into public record a complaint against Montgomery County MUD #2's waste water treatment plant located on FM 830 adjacent to the Seven Coves subdivision. The treated water discharge creek located in Section 4, block 12 along Green Belt reserves A&B, is in dire need if dredging. The silt buildup in places is 3 - 4 feet deep. This has drastically clogged the free flow of this creek into Lake Conroe and in places it is cut off completely. The silt has run as far as into the lake itself and has started to clog the cove of the lake to the point that boats can no longer enter into this part of the cove. The over grown debris has choked off the flow of water to the point that the remaining water in the creek is now able to stagnate. This causes a considerable health risk to all residents in the immediate vicinity of this creek. The smell coming from this creek ranges from disgusting to deplorable. This has had a significant negative impact to the property values in this area. In the warm season, the mosquito swarm from this stagnated water is abdominal. With the influx of the West Nile virus, and other mosquito transferred diseases, this is just a disaster waiting to happen.

To my knowledge, there has never been any maintenance to this creek in the entire 35 years of its operation. MUD#2 has now submitted plans to increase the capacity of this plant under permit number WQ0011271001.

We urgently request a public hearing with the TCEQ to discuss remediation of this problem before any new plans are considered.

Please contact me at one of the contacts below with the hearing date so I can inform all the neighbors affected.
