We, Dick A. Hill and Patricia E. Hill, submit the following comments, complaints and concerns with the above applicant's request for a permit to construct a Rendering Plant to be located at 3255 West U.S. Highway 60.


Our home and acreage are in close proximity to Mr. Caviness's current plant. We are very concerned with the proposed construction of the rendering plant and feel we would be adversely impacted by the plant for the following reasons:

- (1.) Current companies and holdings operated by Mr. Caviness have not used the best available solutions in controlling odor and emissions of air contaminants. Odors are strongly offensive at various times of the day to the extent of causing eyes to burn. If we are working outside the stench is unbearable. Therefore, we are concerned that he will not control odors and emission of air contaminants with a new facility.
- (2.) Odors of present companies owned by Mr. Caviness have exceeded state and federal regulations.
- (3.) We are concerned with future health problems which might result from Mr. Caviness' lack of concern for quality air control. Especially when more pollutants will be emitted with the addition of a rendering plant.
- (4.) Our family dynamics are affected and will be more so adversely affected if a rendering plant is constructed within close proximity of our home. We have a four-year-old granddaughter who is a heart transplant recipient. Due to where we live and emissions of air contaminants, her physicians advise her parents not to bring her to our home.

Our hopes have been for the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality to enforce good air quality by Mr. Caviness' current holdings rather than allowing him to construct another facility that will increase the current air quality problems.

Please consider denial of the proposed air quality permit number 81570.
