Reference: Proposed Air Quality Permit Numbers: 83378 and PSDTX1105
Madison Bell Partners, LP (subsidiary of Navasota Energy)

Dear Chief Clerk:

Please be aware of the fact that the proposed site for the location of the proposed power plant owned by Madison Bell Partners (subsidiary of Navasota Energy) was the former business site for a pesticide/herbicide spraying operation owned by Gene Welch. At times chemicals such as 24D, P+D, Grayson P+D, Simeron, and Brushkiller 245-T were likely to have been deposited on the land.

Because of this likelihood, soil tests should be run on the land before water is taken from this location and distributed in any manner. The possibility of contamination of humans and plants in runoff is a real possibility.

I request a contested case hearing based on the facts stated above as well as the following (as previously stated in a letter dated December 20, 2007.):

1. the welfare of wild turkeys and wild ducks on my property (Texas Parks and Wildlife-October, 1993, on Amy Boatwright Survey, approximately 508 acres)
2. the welfare of my family as we engage in our ranching livelihood
3. the welfare of my cattle
4. the addition of contaminants to the air already present due to the proximity of a sour gas plant on adjoining property
5. traffic congestion on State Highway 21 where it intersects with Strawther Road

I can be reached by email at dawn@tconline.net or by phone at 936-348-6009. I am located less than two miles from the proposed site. My physical location is 6501 Highway 21 West. My acreage indirectly joins the proposed site at the back of my property that is NOT on Highway 21.

Due to the emissions from the sour gas plant, I feel that the limit of contaminants in my immediate atmosphere has been reached and therefore this permit should be denied.
