We believe that the Executive Director's decision should be reconsidered because of the potential environmental harm this permit could cause. All of Hill Country Camp's neighbors, the City of Kerrville, and the UGRA are opposed to the approval of this permit that would allow the direct discharge of treated wastewater into a tributary that flows into Town Creek. We are including a petition with 470 signatures of concerned members of the Hill Country community who are also opposed to the permit application submitted by Hill Country Camp (We have compiled all information into an alphabetical master list, attached to this letter, in addition to the originals). How can the TCEQ feel confident in granting the permit when there are so many people against it? There are more eco-friendly alternatives to direct discharge available to Hill Country Camp. They have over 125 acres with which to implement no-discharge alternatives, i.e. land application, to limit the negative impact that a wastewater treatment facility would have on the environment.

I live downstream, just off the Guadalupe in east Kerr County, where the waste water will eventually pass. I believe the that Guadalupe and our other five streams are the reason we enjoy great beauty in our area and that we want to live here. Pollution will no doubt have long term effects to the ecology and the animals and beings who live here. Will we soon be forced to shut up the swimming, picnicking, fishing, and other water-based, outdoor activities. Please don't let this.

As a private business in Gillespie County I would never expect to get penalties to what Hill Country Camps has asked for. Any commercial enterprise should be held to an even higher standard. The natural beauty of this hill country area is due in large part to the CLEAN water here. We don't have very much water but what we have must be kept clean. I am concerned to the situation of our water treatment. There is a need to invest in new water treatment.

Just wishes in keeping the creek clean.

As a person who has held a class D sewage plant operators permit, I am concerned that proper maintenance and discharge levels will not be maintained because few operators of small plants have the discipline and desire to run a plant properly. Constant oversight is required to assure that the operator does all the proper testing and does it with the required frequency. This specific situation is made worse by the fact that with only two other wastewater plants in the county, a dedicated inspector from the health department cannot be regularly monitored.

I am sad that any type of pollution being fed into Town Creek. I have a home on the creek that my family uses for fishing, boating, and swimming. My family, which includes three children, 9.6.5 that enjoy playing at the dam on the creek. They fish and also boat on the creek. We have raised several groups of ducks from babies and they come up every day for corn. We have "blue" heron that lives here on the creek. For the past four years we have had ducks and geese from the north. We have had two beautiful white swans come in to join us. Our property is one of the most unique on the creek this side of I-10 and before you get to town.

Let keep the Hill Country as it is.




