

It is our understanding the APAC permit is up for renewal. We live right by The APAC facility. Our health and the health of the children is being adversely affected by this facility being only 2000 feet away from a public elementary school and only 600 feet away from the nearest neighborhood and the neighborhood next to that totaling over 1,800 homes. There are thousands of residents and school aged children that are being adversely affected by the emissions from this plant. Due to the growth in the area, this plant has increased its capacity since the Elementary School opened in 2004. We have been registering our complaints and concerns for years to the TCEQ and the City of Frisco asking for their help to remedy this situation. The study tested air near the APAC facility found the following chemicals of concern in concentrations above the long term health effects screening levels (HESL): acetaldehyde, formaldehyde, o-Tolualdehyde, bis (2-Esthyhexyl) phthalate, butylbenzylphthalate, aluminum (particulate). The study also found the following chemicals of concern above short-term HESL: propanal, carbon disulfide, carbonyl sulfide, calcium and sodium.

The facility also keeps high mounds of manufacturing material left uncovered. All of this is having an adverse effect on the citizens who live near the plant. There have been various complaints of burning eyes, throats, headaches, sinus complications and people suffering from asthma who can not tolerate the poor air quality in our neighborhood.

We respectfully request the Commission to look at renewing this permit and the impact it has had on the surrounding schools and residents. It is our belief that a manufacturing facility of this type should not be located so close to a school and residents.
