Gentlemen:

Recently residents in the area serviced by the Polk County Fresh Water District #2 received a Certified Mail advising all residents that the District has applied to the TCEQ for authority to adopt and impose an annual standby fee of \$24.00 per single family connection at will for a period of three (3) years on unimproved property within the District.

The governing Board of Idlewilde Property Owners Association (IPOA) have voted to oppose the \$24.00 standby fee if and when the District chooses to increase the standby fee from \$2.00 to \$24.00 anytime within the next three years.

IPOA property owners already pay an annual fee which is imposed by the District based on Polk County property assessments and issued with the County and School assessment annual bill. In addition, each IPOA resident receives a monthly District bill of approximately \$28.00 on each sewer connection plus a standby fee of \$2.00 per month on each unimproved lot. The annual Polk County District #2 annual assessment fee plus the monthly charges add up to quite a sum of money.

Again, the IPOA Board has authorized me to send this letter protesting any decision by TCEQ to allow the Polk County Fresh Water District #2 to increase the Standby Fees. Thanking you for your considerations.
