Dear TCEQ:

We have 80+ acres of property on FM1771 with common fences backing and adjoining on 2 and possibly 3 sides (Tate has an interest in 3 sides) of the proposed rock pit/crusher to be opened and operated on FM 413 and CR 246. With the current constant gravel trucks traveling down FM1771 we will effectively be surrounded by this mining operation.

We are ***strongly opposed*** to this proposed rock pit operation that will generate a dust plume that will envelop our adjacent property. The proposed rock pit/crusher operation will cover us with windborne dust and cover our neighborhood with drifted dust. This is based on inspection and observation of the areas downwind from other rock pit/crusher operations in this general vicinity.

We chose this area after finding that the historic Blue Ridge community was the type of quiet rural farm environment we were seeking. We have spent a significant amount of our retirement funds on property development and established a small cow calf operation typical to the area.

A mining operation will effectively destroy any value as a home site for us or anyone interested in the area due to the environmental contamination by the mining operation. This operation is contrary to the established nature of the area.

The noise and dust resulting from a rock pit operation will degrade the environment, causing contamination of air quality, our hay field and stock pond. This is based on information others have reported, citing problems from constant dust and rock debris littering their hay/grazing fields as a result of similar rock pit operations. I'm concerned about toxic effects on the cattle and existing abundant wild life.

I would like to be kept informed of actions/meetings pertaining to this rock pit/crusher operation that will significantly impact my property.

I am respectfully requesting that your agency investigate this degradation of our environment and deny any permit to proceed with this poorly planned mining operation. This will benefit few and harm many.

**COMMENTS:**I would like to know how to file an objection to the permit for a commercial gravel pit. This operation will negatively impact the air, wildlife and life quality of the area. This area is a residential/farm area with a rich balance of wildlife including many rare bird species. The resultant air and noise pollution will endanger people, livestock and wildlife. Many people rely on ground water. Blasting will likely compromise the ground water source and potentially contaminate their only affordable option. The blowing dust settling on pasture land and on neighboring water sources, Will harm livestock and people alike. Primarily through inhalation and secondarily through ground contamination. This will ruin quality of hay production. Others who have dealt with this same group have had hay fields littered with large debris on a regular basis. Roads overrun with trucks dispersing dust and gravel debris in the area. We purchased this land as an investment and retirement home site. We will be financially impacted immediately and likely will never recoup our losses. The wonderful historic community of Blue Ridge will be forever devastated. This would be an extreme loss of monetary value, air health, and life quality in the largest investment that most of the people in this community have made in their land and


