COMMENTS: To whom it may concern: I would like to express my deep concern for the pending approval of the coal mining permit. To begin with, I have lived in this community for the past 35 years. I'm a married mother of 4 children ranging in ages from 11 years old to 6 months. I work as an educator in one of our local junior high schools. In the year 2000 my middle son was diagnosed with Neuroblastoma cancer at the age of 10 1/2 months. Cancer is a devastating disease. When he was first diagnosed the oncologists told my husband and I that they have seen a rise of cancer along residents living near the Rio Grande. Its no secret to us that our water is contaminated from other big corporations dumping their chemicals in to the water. But we do not want even more contamination combined with asbestos causing dust. I am aware of all the information concerning coal mines and the horrible effects they have in the communities they are in. I'm also aware that coal being a fossil fuel is used for electricity and without it we might as well live in the stone age. Regardless of this, I'm completely opposed to the opening of the coal mine. There is not one thing that I have found that is good about a coal mine. On the contrary, research shows coal mines bring lung cancer, asbestosis, COPD, asthma, pollution, contamination of water etc. The most affected will be our elderly, children and those with weakened immune systems. My middle son falls under this category. Please I beg of you, do not approve this permit. We have a wonderful community. I know a coal mines existed here once before, and the contamination is probably still there. But why add more, we must think about our children. Sure the "coal mine" will bring money and jobs to our community. But at what cost, money is worthless without your health. The health problems will take years to show their ugly faces and by that time a lawsuit is pointless when your watching your children and grandchildren succumbing to cancer and other diseases. Our dirty politicians have kept this issue very quiet. The community is barely becoming aware of the situation through word of mouth. They chose to have the hearing in Seco Mines Community Center. Why would a place that only 100 people can fit be chosen when we have a new facility called the International Trade Center. In that location over 1000 people could have gone to voice their opposition. The reason is they want to keep the community quiet to continue with there money making project. There is not much time left to stop this permit. I know I'm one voice but please hear it. I speak for countless others that feel the same way. We are completely opposed to the coal mine. Money isn't important we the people are. PLEASE, PLEASE, DO NOT APPROVE THIS PERMIT WE BEG YOU.

From sampling conducted during a pilot study ~~during the~~ performed a few years ago and used as the basis for design of the treatment plant, the average concentration of iron in the Rio Grande was determined to be 0.2 - 0.3 ppm. Since the discharge permit allows for a release of iron of 6.0 ppm ~~and~~ there could be a concern. Additionally, the average concentration of Manganese was determined to be 0.01 - 0.02 ppm and the permit allows for a discharge up to 4.0 ppm. Although, there is of course a ~~drift~~ dilution factor due to the large flow of Rio Grande water ~~mixing~~ that would mix with discharges from the mine, the potential for affecting treatment operations exists since the discharges could be at levels higher than ~~in the river~~ in the river.



A RESOLUTION OF MAVERICK COUNTY, TEXAS, OPPOSING DOS REPUBLICAS PARTNERSHIP RENEWAL PERMIT #WQ0003511000 BEFORE THE TEXAS COMMISSION OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY.

WHEREAS, in July 2003, Dos Republicas Resources Co. entered into an investigation agreement with Coahuila Industrial Minera, S.A. De C.V. and Restructuradora Mexicana, S.A. De C.V.; and

WHEREAS, it has been stated in a deposition by Clark Moseley, a North American Coal Co. agent, that Coahuila's Industrial Minera, Grupo Acerero del Norte (GAN), and MICARE are all subsidiaries or affiliated in some way; and

WHEREAS, MICARE's work in the neighboring State of Coahuila has been condemned by the public and government for their disregard of underground water tables and lack of proper land reclamation; and

WHEREAS, discharge of chemically treated water and mine seepage from active mining areas into Elm Creek creates a serious risk of adverse impacts to Elm Creek and consequently to our drinking water resource, the Rio Grande River; and

WHEREAS, discharge of storm water and mine seepage creates a serious risk of polluting adjacent surrounding water wells within the area of the projected mine; and

WHEREAS, the mining operation may also affect the water supply of Eagle Pass, Piedras Negras, Coahuila, Mexico and other cities south of Eagle Pass, in both the United States and Mexico; and

WHEREAS, people who live in counties where coal is mined are much more likely to suffer from an array of chronic, life-threatening health problems, according to a study published in the April 2008 American Journal of Public Health; and

WHEREAS, the study found that these residents reported higher rates of cardiopulmonary disease, chronic obstructive pulmonary disease, hypertension, diabetes, lung and kidney disease; and

WHEREAS, there is a risk that the mine operations will create foundation problems and health hazards to children attending Pete Gallegos Elementary, Seco Mines Elementary and Texas Migrant Council Head-Start; and

WHEREAS, the thousands of Maverick County citizens in subdivisions such as Thompson Road, Deer Run, Elm Creek, Seco Mines, Siesta Acres, Hopedale Estates and many others living near mining operations will likely be exposed to and inhale dust from surface mining operations, coal preparation and cleaning plants, truck and train loading facilities; and
