I live within a mile of the pipiline compression station in question and my waterwell and drinking water come from the privledge creek basin. There are also several subdivisions where elderly people have retired to within a miles distance of the station. I am requesting clarifacation of the contaminates to be released including the tonnage of said contaminates. How will they affect the enviromently sensitive areas surrounding the area in question. How will it effect the health and welfare of the elderly that live less than a mile from the station. Because the pipiline station is on a major highway(state hwy16) linking Bandera to San Antonio, how will it adversely effect the commuters having to pass thru this area during there daily commute to and from San Antonio? I feel strongly that the release of these contaminates will also affect the Medina River being that the sub station is less than a half mile from where Privildge Creek and the Medina River intersect and flow to Lake Medina where the public fish and enjoy water sports.I herby request a public meeting to reconsider the excutive director's decision.I would like to please ask the commission to reconsiderthe directors decision and hold a scheduled public meeting. I am very concerned about the safety and welfare of the public exposed to the contaminates.
