COMES NOW Fannin County, Texas, by and through the Fannin County Commissioners Court, c/o the County Judge, Fannin County Courthouse, Bonham, Texas 75418, (903) 583-7455 (Protestant) and file this, its request for hearing, and, in support thereof would respectfully show the following:

I. Summary

Protestant requests a contested case hearing. Protestant understands that the hearing requested is more than a public meeting for submission of comments.

The affected persons are the citizens of Fannin County, and therefore, Fannin County, by and through the Fannin County Commissioners Court, seeks to protect their interest and the interest of the county as a whole. Further, Fannin County maintains county roads and transportation infrastructure that will be affected by the project. The project will also affect the taxable property within the county for ad valorem property taxes. Finally, the County is responsible for economic development and water supply resources for the citizens of the County.

II. Protestant Represents Affected Persons

The Protestant herein is a political subdivision of the State of Texas, and meets the tests of affected persons, including those listed in 30 TAC Chapter 55. The County and its constituents have the specific interests that are intended to be protected by the

Texas Health and Safety Code. They would be adversely affected in ways not common to those of the general public. The proposed activity is to be conducted within Fannin County.

III. Conclusion

WHEREFORE, Protestant respectfully requests that a hearing be granted and that Fannin County be named a party to the hearing.
