Such an amendment as the one requested by the Grumbles and the LCRA is not fair and not right. Nor is it legal, as it "flys in the face" of the very purpose of TCEQ's suspension of water rights on the San Saba River with seniority date 1900 and forward. It is an exception to the suspension. Are you going to make exceptions for all the rest of us water rights owners ? If not, you cannot make this one.
