To the Members of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality:

I am submitting my reply to the Executive Director's Response and NTMWD to Hearing Request filed documents on September 16, 2013 .

- 1.) Reference comment 27: Directors response (pg 15 /4.) agreed with this issue is relevant. I strongly disagree with NTMWD stating that Comment 27 and including Comments 18 and Comment 28 not be recommended to SOAH. There have been two statements/request submitted three separate times, the first in February 2013 in the written Statement, the second in an email to Mario Perez, Mario.perez@tceq.texas.gov, OPENRECS openreecs@tceq.texas.gov on Wed., July 3rd, 2013 and the third in an Open Records Request dated July 8, 2013. None were ever addressed.

"In addition, the Written Statement filed in February 2013 also reported the South Tributary (specifically at 2315 Windsor, Richardson, TX) was impacted similarly and I have no indication that this area was sampled as part of the Spring Creek investigation, or that your NOV's included this area as well.

- 2.) recommendation to SOAH. NTMWD (pg. 9 item (G) referred to as Contamination from Gun Range but in fact had been mentioned in response from me that there is contamination in the area including the site for the new transfer station, the old fire training center. As stated above for NOV's.
- 3.) Reference comment 18: Not acknowledged in Executive Director , needs to be considered for recommendation to SOAH. NTMED (pg 9 item (D) for an environmental impact study. I cannot see how this is ignored with so much contamination on the north and south side tributaries and the impact on the whole area with so much surrounding parks, homes. Etc.
- 4.) Reference pg 17 b) 1. Executive Director stated issue to SOAH, I would like to add if the permit application had pictures surrounding the area past the ¼ mile to extend to the 1 mile the perspective is much different than what has been presented. This should be considered for the SOAH.
