Hof Creek Ranch is my home , where I have an agriculture and wildlife exemption, a cattle co. and a deer management plan. Flagtail Creek runs through the center of my ranch. A low water crossing on the ranch is the only way to gain access to the other side. It is a natural rain runoff for the surrounding land. It is not entended for a private business to dump their unwanted resources.

The creek stays full of water year round. Allowing a new daily flow of water into flagtail creek will instantly cause water levels to rise above a noncrossing stage . This will not allow me to cross myself, or cattle.

This effects my cattle, deer population, my livelihood, erosion of the creek, constant repairing of the concrete leavey, flooding and no access to private property will lower land value. Two inches of rain will cause creek to be impassible for three days.

Tenaska has thus far been a good neighbor, I am willing to work with them .

However, I request a contested case hearing.
