**RESOLUTION REQUESTING A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE RENEWAL APPLICATION OF  
TPDES PERMIT NUMBER WQ0001481000**

**WHEREAS**, Hood County, Texas, is an administrative division of the State of Texas and situated around Lake Granbury, a Brazos River Lake; and

**WHEREAS**, DeCordova Power Company, LLC and Luminant Generation Company, LLC filed an application with the TCEQ on November 5, 2013 seeking renewal of TPDES Permit Number WQ0001481000 which authorizes the discharge of once-through cooling water and previously monitored effluent at a daily average flow not to exceed 1,041,480,000 gallons per day; and

**WHEREAS**, the future lake levels of Lake Granbury could be adversely affected by any action taken by TCEQ in granting or denying TPDES Permit Number WQ0001481000; and

**WHEREAS**, Hood County has grown and prospered since the completion of Lake Granbury in 1969; and

**WHEREAS**, the *Ad Valorem* values of all real properties in Hood County are enhanced by the beauty and recreational benefits of Lake Granbury; and,

**WHEREAS**, Hood County realizes the benefit of substantial sale taxes revenues from residents on the lake and from tourist and visitors to Lake Granbury; and,

**WHEREAS**, a public hearing on the renewal application for TPDES Permit Number WQ0001481000, if held before TCEQ takes any action on this application, would provide Hood County and its citizens an opportunity to address their concerns with the lake level and this permit application directly to the TCEQ;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF  
HOOD COUNTY, TEXAS:**

**Section 1**

The Commissioners' Court of Hood County, Texas, hereby finds and determines that the recitals made in the preamble of this Resolution are true and correct, and incorporates such recitals herein.

**Section 2**

The Commissioners' Court of Hood County by this Resolution hereby requests that TCEQ postpone any decision on DeCordova Power Company, LLC's and Luminant Generation Company, LLC's application for renewal of TPDES Permit Number WQ0001481000, until such a time as a public hearing has been scheduled within the territorial limits of the City Granbury so as to afford Hood County and all of her citizens an opportunity to be heard and to provide comments thereon.

The Commissioners' Court of Hood County hereby directs the County Judge to contact State Representative Jim Keffer and State Senator Brian Birdwell and make inquiry into their ability and willingness to request, on the County's behalf, that TCEQ hold a public hearing, prior to taking any formal action on the renewal application for TPDES Permit Number WQ0001481000, within the territorial limits of Hood County



**COMMENTS:** On April 2, I sent comments on this permit request by Luminant that was incorrect. On the web site that I looked up the gallons of water per acre foot of water, it appeared that there were 325+ MILLION gallons instead of 325+ THOUSAND gallons. This made my computation of the number of acre feet in 1 BILLION gallons of water off by a factor of 1000. Therefore, instead of 3 acre feet per day, 1 Billion gallons would be 3000 acre feet per day and over 1 Million acre feet in a year. Since Lake Granbury is currently at

*MM*

about 69,000 acre feet, that would indicate a 23 day supply. I believe most of this water would be returned to the lake (less evaporation) as hot water. What would the environmental impact of that volume of hot water per day? Before this permit is approved, I believe there should be hearings in Hood County. I tried to correct this input on April 4 but after filling out the form, it did not transmit due to a "communications problem."




