We have cattle and raise hay in the land adjoining the proposed location, both of which would be negatively impacted by the increase in dust and the chemicals it contains that would be emitted into the air. quality of the air that this concrete facility will create will not promote enjoyment of the country air and being outdoors. This is an agriculture and residential area, not an industrial area. DR Horton has purchased property to the south of the location and are planning to expand their Villages of Melissa subdivision northward, this impacts the residents of that neighborhood as well as the residents of Country Ridge when the north winds blow. If this concrete plant is to support the upcoming hwy 75 expansion, there are much closer properties for such a plant and there are already concrete plants off of hwy 5 and at the hwy 5/121 intersection. Daytime Phone Number: 214-763-6354, Applicants name: BARTOO READY MIX, LLC. Applicants Registration Number 120783, I, Cynthia L, Davis, request a contested case hearing. My husband and I own 3 acres of property with a permanent dwelling where we reside 370 yards of the proposed batch on County Road 364. This batch plant would adversely affect my health as I am in Stage 3 renal failure. I

have to eat a restricted diet, and my kidney cannot withstand any extra pollutants. I was born with only one kidney, and it is not functioning well. More pollutants may cause me to go into final stage renal failure and dialysis which is expensive and involves taking medications that affects other organs in my body negatively, therefore shortening my life. Also, my husband's uncle lives with us. He is 71 years old, and he has COPD. He often coughs uncontrollably when in contact with dust and pollutants. My mother is 80 years old, and plans on living with us in the near future. These air pollutants would be hard on her health. This plant is located on land that has ground water running underneath the surface. How can the residents confirm that the plant is complying with these regulations if we are not allowed on the plant property? How do we know they are complying with air quality regulations? I would like to know why 440 yards was the selected number for a case hearing. Are the residents in the 440 yards adversely affected? What is the difference between 440 yards and one mile? Obviously, this number was selected for some reason. Can you explain? This plant is planning on having several trucks that will emit more emissions and cause more pollutants. In addition, they will cause a traffic hazard since the road was not designed for large trucks. If you approve this plant, I would ask that you at least have some stipulations to protect the public health. Since the concrete company is causing a change in our lifestyles, I think they should be responsible for providing hepa filters to houses with the 440 yards, limit their operating hours to 5 to 5, Monday through Friday, and build a wall around the baghouse stack. I realize we virtually have no rights, but I would beg you to please consider our health, and how this plant will affect our lives. Thank you, Cynthia L. Davis





See my comments above about Operating Requirements, section (K).) "The following distance limitations must be met: If the plant is located in an area that is NOT subject to municipal zoning regulation, (this is in Melissa, TX ETJ and Collin County Texas which cannot legally set zoning regulations) the Central Bag house must be located at least 440 yards from ANY building used as a single or multifamily, school, or place of worship at the time the standard permit registration is filed with the commission". Bartoo Ready Mix, LLC air quality permit application should NOT be approved.

3 Comment 2/TCEQ Response 2- Monitoring

This response states that the TCEQ does not require continuous air monitoring. Why not? Per the public meeting comments by the TCEQ representatives it is up to the neighbors and citizens to police the Concrete Batch Plant's emissions by notifying the TCEQ of a potential problem. I have first hand experience of how the TCEQ handles these type complaints. In January of 2006 I along with affected neighbors near Slayter Creek and Throckmorton Creek (which runs along the entire eastern boundary of my 32.87 acres) had raw sewage running in the creeks going on into Lake Lavon (which is the main water source for many citizens in Collin County Texas). The City of Anna, TX had a Wastewater Treatment Facility immediately downstream of Lake Anna where it went into Slayter Creek. There were three (3) ponds that acted as a septic system on top of the ground. The growth in Anna exceeded the systems capacity and the sewage couldn't stay in the ponds long enough for the solid matter to break down before going into Slayter Creek that then runs into Throckmorton Creek. The smell was unbelievably bad

especially at night. The smell would take your breath away. We were prisoners in our own homes. First we reported it to the Director of Public Works for the City of Anna. His response was that a beaver had built a dam where the Slayter Creek crossed CR 366 (Foster Crossing Rd.). This was a crazy explanation; the situation was that raw sewage was being discharged by the City of Anna into the creeks because the volume of waste exceeded the capacity of the wastewater treatment plant. We made a complaint to the TCEQ, hoping for some help. The TCEQ sent Suzanna M. Perea to Investigate our complaints. The official report (which I have included) says the visit to the sewer treatment was "unannounced". This is NOT true because she and my husband, Robert Norris met at our property and she told him she had spoken to James Parkman, Director of Public Works for Anna before her trip. When she left our property she was going to meet Mr. Parkman. While at our property she wanted to get a sample of the water in Throckmorton Creek but she came with medium high heeled shoes and said it was unsafe for her to go down the bank of the creek to get a sample. My husband Robert Norris offered to climb down to the water and get a sample for her in her one gallon plastic jug but she said that Robert "was not qualified" to take a proper sample of the water. So she took no sample and left to meet Mr. Parkman. When she closed the report/complaint it stated that it was an "Unannounced" visit and that she surmised that "some unknown person had dumped some chemical in a sewer manhole that made it into the treatment facility ponds and killed the bacteria in Anna's sewer treatment facility". The problem with her conclusions, hence the TCEQ's conclusion is that the City of Anna, TX Wastewater Facility Operator was supposedly testing the water coming out of their facility daily (the tests are to insure compliance to the TCEQ requirements) and the test results showed no measurements out of the range set by the TCEQ which can only mean they were faking these test results. We received no relief on this matter until the city of Anna got a new sewage treatment facility on line and the sewage was washed by rain and cleaned water coming from Lake Anna. I have attachments 1 & 2 which are printouts from the TCEQ website that show complaint tracking # 70861, received 01/25/2006, Investigation No. 432623. RN Number: RN102754199. SUZANNA M. PEREA Environmental Investigator, Sid Slocum TCEQ Supervisor, Slayter Creek WWTP, 4000' W ST HWY 5 & 4600' S FM 455, Anna, TX 75409, Latitude: 33.3315 Long: -96.566917. I don't believe the TCEQ can be trusted to follow up on citizens' complaints without the tipping off of the operator, Bartoo Ready Mix, LLC and give them time to correct the problem before the "Official Visit" by the TCEQ investigator. Therefore, if this plant is approved I request continuous air quality monitoring in all directions that is not at the discretion of the operator (Bartoo Ready Mix, LLC) and a monitoring company. I demand monitoring that the company (Bartoo) has no control over as to when it is done, just for Bartoo to pay for the monitoring. Not just for one year but for as long as he operates the plant. Results should be sent to the TCEQ AND the affected parties (see my list above of the affected parties that live in the 440 yard zone). Also, we need assurances that if this permit is approved no asphalt manufacturing or recycling will be permitted at this site. From the TCEQ's response it is if after they (The TCEQ) issue the applicant a permit and then they don't want to be involved any longer. Bartoo Ready Mix, LLC air quality permit application should NOT be approved.

4 Comment 3/Response 3 - Sign posting/Newspaper Notice

The applicant, Bartoo Ready Mix, LLC placed the two (2) signs notifying the public of the batch plant site were placed behind trees and were not visible from a vehicle when driving by. After I made a comment

on the TCEQ website that the signs couldn't be read from the road they were moved out from behind the trees and closer to the road, clear deception by the applicant, Bartoo Ready Mix, LLC. Bartoo Ready Mix, LLC air quality permit application should NOT be approved.

5 Comment5/Response 5 – Permit Application Inaccuracies

The applicant made numerous errors in his original application but when the errors were pointed out by commenters on the TCEQ website, the applicant was allowed to correct them even though the applicant signed the paragraph below on the application stating there were criminal penalties for false statements on this application. Bartoo Ready Mix, LLC air quality permit application should NOT be approved.

6 Comment 6/Response 6 – TCEQ Permits/Mission Statement

Yes in the public meeting the TCEQ representative's response to a question was that the TCEQ had NOT denied an Air Quality Permit Request in over ten (10) years. That statement in itself shows that the TCEQ has no plans to "Do the Right Thing" by denying this air quality permit request. The TCEQ says they have no authority about the road (CR 364), The City of Melissa (even though we are in their ETJ) says they can't keep big trucks off the road and set any zoning requirements, and the county, Collin County Texas says that the State Legislature does not give the County the ability to regulate zoning on roads and bridges unless there is a substandard bridge on CR 364 (which is not the case), all Collin County can regulate are junk yards and Sexually Orientated Businesses. So, unless Bartoo Ready Mix, LLC starts storing old cars or opens a massage parlor Collin County can't do anything to keep out this batch plant. Every entity has an out. Bartoo Ready Mix, LLC air quality permit application should NOT be approved.

9 Comment 11/Response 11 – Trucks/Traffic Hazard/Roads/Noise/Light

This is just a response like most of the previous responses and is just like the TCEQ is telling us “It’s Not My Job”! Bartoo Ready Mix, LLC air quality permit application should NOT be approved.

10 I have problems with allergy’s. My doctors tell me it is caused by dust, dirt, pollen, and pollution in our air. Now the TCEQ is going to allow Bartoo Ready Mix, LLC to build a Concrete Batch plant 398.06 yards from my house when the TCEQ’s own guidelines state:



The TCEQ says they have no authority about the road (CR 364), The City of Melissa (even though we are in their ETJ) says they can't keep big trucks off the road and set any zoning requirements, and the county, Collin County Texas says that the State Legislature does not give the County the ability to regulate zoning on roads and bridges unless there is a substandard bridge on CR 364 (which is not the case), all Collin County can regulate are junk yards and Sexually Orientated Businesses. So, unless Bartoo Ready Mix, LLC starts storing old cars or opens a massage parlor Collin County can't do anything to keep out this batch plant. Every entity has an out. Bartoo Ready Mix, LLC air quality permit application should NOT be approved.

7 Comment 9/Response 9 – Negative Economic Impact/Enjoyment of Property

The TCEQ's response of blaming their inability to act to prevent this plant being built is a "cop out". Hundreds of commenters and affected parties have commented against this plant being issued a permit to build their plant and the TCEQ just goes along with the applicant, Bartoo Ready Mix, LLC. Not ONE comment has been in favor of approving this permit. Bartoo Ready Mix, LLC air quality permit application should NOT be approved.

8 Comment 10/Response 10 – Water Quality/Quantity

There have been many legitimate concerns poised about water use and water runoff and the TCEQ tells us to notify them if we see a problem or take our complaints to civil court, it is of no concern in reference to this air quality permit request 120783. Bartoo Ready Mix, LLC air quality permit application should NOT be approved.


9 Comment 11/Response 11 – Trucks/Traffic Hazard/Roads/Noise/Light

Based on this statute alone, I/we don’t know how you can issue a permit to the applicant because my residence is within the 440 yards (398.06 yards).

I will be a prisoner in my own house and will require the wearing of goggles and a filter mask when doing work outside. And, we the affected parties will have to police the batch plants output. Bartoo Ready Mix, LLC air quality permit application should NOT be approved. PLEASE do not approve Air Quality Permit Application 120783.





In TCEQ document "Air Quality Standard Permit for Concrete Batch Plants with Enhanced Controls" section IV (Permit Condition Analysis and Justification), Sub Section (3)(K) states the following: "Subsection (3)(K)

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requires a facility to maintain more than 100 feet from the central baghouse exhaust to the nearest property line. If the plant is located in an area that is not subject to municipal zoning regulations, this subsection requires that the central baghouse must be located at least 440 yards from any building used as a single or multifamily residence, school, or place of worship at the time the standard permit registration is filed with the commission." My residence at 571 County Road 364 is located 210 yards from the proposed site and is not subject to municipal zoning regulations. This has already been established by the city of Melissa and the Collin County Commissioner, Chris Hill. There are also 10 other single family residents that are less than 440 yards from this proposed facility. My wife also has allergies. The county has a letter on file from her doctor. If another letter from her doctor is required it will be provided at any time. The TCEQ's letter stated that "The proposed facility will emit the following air contaminants: particulate matter including (but not limited to) aggregate, cement, road dust, and particulate matter with diameters of 10 microns or less and 2.5 microns or less." This letter doesn't state that this facility could emit this matter. The letter states the facility "will emit" the air contaminants. The additional air contaminants given off by this facility will cause my wife's allergies to worsen. Here is another quote from the EPA's own web page. (<http://www.epa.gov/oar/particlepollution/>) The size of particles is directly linked to their potential for causing health problems. EPA is concerned about particles that are 10 micrometers in diameter or smaller because those are the particles that generally pass through the throat and nose and enter the lungs. Once inhaled, these particles can affect the heart and lungs and cause serious health effects. The EPA groups particle pollution into two categories: •"Inhalable coarse particles," such as those found near roadways and dusty industries, are larger than 2.5 micrometers and smaller than 10 micrometers in diameter. •"Fine particles," such as those found in smoke and haze, are 2.5 micrometers in diameter and smaller. These particles can be directly emitted from sources such as forest fires, or they can form when gases emitted from power plants, industries and automobiles react in the air. If the EPA is concerned about this particulate matter, then why is the TCEQ not concerned?
