I join them in requesting that a public meeting be set to allow community input and education regarding the Reserve at Ammann Road Wastewater Permit Application. The Army is concerned about this wastewater permit and related development due to water quality concerns and due to water quantity issues that this development poses to Camp Stanley and Camp Bullis.

Also of concern is that such a development with sewage outfall over karst ground is too risky for the aquifers and wells in that area. Their water source would come primarily from the western Comal PGMA, so it is questionable whether the underlying development plant is sustainable or in the public interest.
