TPDES Permit No. WQ0015314001.**

Ms. Bohac:

On behalf of Frederick, Perales, Allmon & Rockwell, P.C. ("FPAR"), I am submitting these comments regarding the above-referenced matter.

Randolph Todd Company proposes to discharge wastewater into an area where it will negatively impact our valuable hill country environment. The proposed permit is not sufficiently protective of the receiving waters and streams, nor is it sufficiently protective of human health.

Pollutants such as oxygen-demanding materials, sediment, nutrients and bacteria within the discharge will adversely impact the receiving streams. Dry Comal Creek is already impaired with respect to Bacteria. The proposed discharge will include bacteria, thus further contributing to this impairment. Accordingly, the conditions of the permit do not ensure that the permitted discharge will not cause or contribute to a violation of the state water quality standards. Consequently, the permit should be denied. As a result of the discharge of these pollutants and other pollutants, the discharge will result in a greater than *de minimis* lowering of water quality in the receiving streams.<sup>1</sup> Yet, the analysis required by 30 TAC § 307.5(b)(2) has not been performed. Thus, issuance of the permit also violates the Tier 2 anti-degradation requirements of the TCEQ rules.

<sup>1</sup> Notably, FPAR's concern is not limited to the pollutants explicitly identified herein. FPAR's concerns relate to the overall impact of the discharge in light of all pollutants which it will potentially contain.

Bacteria is not the only contaminant of concern for the proposed discharge, however. Oxygen-demanding substances and nutrients contained in the wastewater also have the potential to adversely impact the receiving waters to an unacceptable degree. The discharge of these contaminants as authorized by the permit will potentially lead to the excessive growth of algae in the receiving waters, and adverse impacts on aquatic wildlife. The Hill Country is known for the presence of several different endangered and threatened species, and the facility and discharge pose a threat to such sensitive species.

Also, the siting of the plant does not comply with TCEQ's rules. The site does not minimize the potential for groundwater and surface water contamination. With regard to groundwater, the proposed discharge is near the boundary between the contributing zone and the recharge zone, but apparently over the recharge zone. Given this proximity, there is a high likelihood that a spill from the plant would contaminate the Edwards Aquifer. Further, the effluent is likely to travel into groundwater, including the Edwards aquifer, given the local environment. It has not been shown that the proposed plant is adequately protective in light of floodplain conditions at the site and wetland conditions. Furthermore, it has not been shown that the design and operation of the plant is adequate to control odors. In short, the siting of the plant is not consistent with the requirements of 30 TAC §§ 309.10 – 309.14.


Furthermore, the issuance of the permit is not consistent with Texas' regionalization policy. No need for the facility has been demonstrated. Applicant's asserted plans for development are merely speculative.

It has not been demonstrated that the draft permit complies with TCEQ's general criteria set forth at 30 TAC § 307.4. For example, it has not been shown that the proposed discharge will not adversely impact the aesthetic qualities of the receiving waters. Furthermore, it has not been shown that the proposed discharge will be adequately protective so as to prevent the excessive growth of algae due to the discharge of nutrients.

FPAR is further concerned that the unpleasant odor quality of the effluent will have an adverse impact on the Comal River in Segment No. 1811. The treated wastewater to be discharged will potentially have a foul smell, which will potentially interfere with the recreational use of the receiving waters, including the Comal River.

**COMMENTS:** My name is Amy Collins and I live at 1470 S. Cranes Mill Road. I am protesting the Proposed Permit No. WQ0015314001. This permit contains many flaws pertaining to the affected areas that will impact many more families and business than what they are saying. I was not considered to be in the affected (by their assessment) area so I was not legally notified of the proposed permit. This goes against my legal right to be informed, and the person who put this permit together should be fined. After reviewing the neighbors list

submitted with the applications it showed many inaccuracies. The permit states that Dry Comal Creek only runs for a few miles (few means 2 or 3). Dry Comal Creek goes all the way in to down town New Braunfels and empties into the Comal River at Wurst Hall, in actuality, it is over 35 miles long so their assessment is incorrect. Dry Comal Creek runs on 2 full sides of my property that is 900 feet long by 600 feet wide, so I will be tremendously affected myself and my family. I live less than 1500 feet from the proposed area where the Chemical sewage discharge plant will be. I also have a large living cave that is in the Dry Comal Creek bed on my property. Dry Comal creek is a Dry Creek 95% of the year. Any natural flow of water will enter the cave area. I have a cavern system under my property, which we discovered when we drilled for my well. The cavern is a porous system of limestone rock which will eventually connect to the Edwards Aquifer at some point it will be in contact with the Edwards Recharge Zone. It is illegal to dump straight discharge over the Edwards Aquifer. Even though they are trying to bypass the Edwards Aquifer by pumping farther up the Creek bed, it still will run down to the Edwards Aquifer recharge zone. Signs for the Edwards Aquifer Recharge Zone are a half mile up the road from my property. As dictated by the Permit the Discharge System will be discharging 390,000 gallons "average" per a day which means it is going to be a running body of water all year. Because we do not get enough natural rain water, this treated sewage will not be diluted which will pose a major threat to eco system and water quality. This permit proposes that the treated sewage will be released directly to Dry Comal Creek. This procedure is not commonly used since most chemical treatment plants use drip or spray out to outside field areas away from natural water ways. It is illegal to do straight discharge over the Edwards Aquifer. The developer is also attempting to create a treatment plant larger then they have ever built before and therefore does not have the proper knowledge and experience with the amount of sewage that will be produced. The permit does not include the Port or pipe diameter at the discharge point, therefore allowing the developer to make this decision. Nowhere in this report is there an ecological study of the effects of dumping chemically treated sewage down Dry Comal Creek, a naturally dry creek, which will be detrimental to the wild life, cattle, pets, people, plants, eco system and plants because there is no natural water flow to wash it away. The developer has no plans for a detention pond to filter the treated sewage to break it down more to make it safer. The odor from this discharge sewage plant will be awful, the permit says that it the fumes will blow in a certain direction. We get all different directions of winds down S. Cranes Mill Road. I personally have experience living next to a Sewage treatment plant (Live on Rio Drive in New Braunfels which was across the river from the treatment plant) and it always smelled terrible, where you did not want to be outside, especially on a warm day. We would call and complain on a regular basis, and the plant operator would tell us they are working on it. This smell does not ever go away, it will ruin the natural beauty we have out here in the hill country buy smelling like a sewer, and lower our value of our property. The developer has better and safer options, but they have chosen not to use them. Subsurface irrigations is a safer and better option, but this developer is choosing to pump the treated sewage down Dry Comal Creek and then trucking the sludge out in many trucks all day from 4:30am to the end of the day. Trucking this sludge will create a dangerous amount of traffic on our small 2 lane road down S. Cranes Mill Road. Our road is not equipped to support this traffic. The chemically treated sewage will seep into our wells due to porous rock, I personally drink this water as does my family, and my pets and cattle. This will be contaminated water and can cause disease and fungal issues caused by the microorganisms for form in this environment. The proposed permit is also asking to build on lots that are smaller than they are supposed to build on, which is why they are needed to go to the Discharge sewage plant. Other property owners and subdivisions are following the guidelines, but this developer is going against this stipulations. This is just greed with no regard for our environment.

I have a bachelor's degree in Science with a concentration in Ornamental Horticulture, so I know what damages this chemical discharge will create with my landscaped gardens. My garden is maintained using organic solutions, because it is the best for the environment and the best for my gardens. Spray out of chemically treated sewage has regulations that we as business have to abide by. I expect new development to abide by the same rules as our business. Spray out that goes out to a fielded area will kill or create fungal diseases with everything it comes in contact with. This is why the regulations of spray out need to be far enough away from any home dwelling or open water ways. This proposed permit is not suggesting spray out, it is wanting to do straight chemically treated sewage into Dry Comal Creek which will filtrate into the Edwards Aquifer Recharge Zone. The permit states that Dry Comal Creek only runs for a few miles (few means 2 or 3). Dry Comal Creek goes all the way in to down town New Braunfels and empties into the Comal River at Wurst Hall, in actuality, it is over 20-30 miles long so their assessment is incorrect. Dry Comal Creek runs on 2 full sides of my property that is 900 feet long by 600 feet wide, so my business will be tremendously affected. The business is less than 300 feet from the proposed area where the Chemical sewage discharge plant will be located. . As dictated by the Permit the Discharge System will be discharging 390,000 gallons "average" per a day which means it is going to be a running body of water all year. Because we do not get enough natural rain water, this treated sewage will not be diluted which will pose a major threat to eco system and water quality that will be filter into my well system which them will be irrigated into and onto my garden. My gardens are the base beauty of my business so without it looking healthy I will lose business. If this develop does go through I will continually have my water tested and gauge it against the water testing that I am now doing to provide evidence of the contamination. You will be informed by any damage or disease to my gardens cause by this chemically treated sewage. The developer is also attempting to create a treatment plant larger then they have ever built before and therefore does not have the proper knowledge and experience with the amount of sewage that will be produced. The permit does not include the Port or pipe diameter at the discharge point, therefore allowing the developer to make this decision. Nowhere in this report is there an ecological study of the effects of dumping chemically treated sewage down Dry Comal Creek, a naturally dry creek, which will be detrimental to the wild life, cattle, pets, people, plants, eco system and plants because there is no natural water flow to wash it away. The developer has no plans for a detention pond to filter the treated sewage to break it down more to make it safer. The odor from this discharge sewage plant will be awful, the permit says that it the fumes will blow in a certain direction. We get all different directions of winds down S. Cranes Mill Road. I personally have experience living next to a Sewage treatment plant (Live on Rio Drive in New Braunfels which was across the river from the treatment plant) and it always smelled terrible, where you did not want to be outside, especially on a warm day. We would call and complain on a regular basis, and the plant operator would tell us they are working on it. This smell does not ever go away. This smell will make me loose clients which will affect my business by smelling like a sewer. It will also lower the value of our property. The developer has better and safer options, but they have chosen not to use them. Subsurface irrigations is a safer and better option, but this developer is choosing to pump the treated sewage down Dry Comal Creek and then trucking the sludge out in many trucks all day from 4:30am to the end of the day. Trucking this sludge will create a dangerous amount of traffic on our small 2 lane road down S. Cranes Mill Road. Our road is not equipped to support this traffic. This will create contaminated water and can cause disease and fungal issues caused by the microorganisms that form in this environment.

**COMMENTS:** This permit represents a clear attempt to circumvent Chapter 213 of TCEQ rules, prohibiting new discharges on the Edwards Aquifer Recharge Zone (EARZ). The proposal as I understand it is to locate a wastewater treatment plant on the EARZ. The wastewater effluent will then be piped into the Edwards Aquifer Contributing Zone (EACZ), discharged, releasing it into the Dry Comal Creek, emphasis on the word dry. From there the wastewater effluent will flow down the Dry Comal Creek, past the wastewater treatment plant that

*MWD*

generated the wastewater effluent, if it has not all gone into the aquifer before then. The vast majority of the time, there will not be any practical difference between releasing the wastewater effluent into the Dry Comal Creek near the plant site and piping it away from the plant site into the EACZ. There will not be any dilution of the wastewater effluent, prior to it flowing back into the EARZ. The applicant's proposal to pipe the wastewater effluent away from the plant site, over the EARZ, into the EACZ amounts to smoke and mirrors, not protection of the Edwards Aquifer. No miraculous change or magic will take place between the wastewater effluent discharge point, and the wastewater entering the EARZ. Any reasonable person taking an impartial look at what this permit represents, would simply characterize it as a new discharge in the EARZ, prohibited by current rules. If the TCEQ, developers, etc. feel that current TCEQ rules are too prohibitive and are harming job creation, business creation, etc., the honest, above board approach to these issues is to change the rules, not this current smoke and mirrors approach to circumvent current TECQ rules. Changing the rules would allow input from the public, legislators, etc. resulting in a fair and democratic process to address issues of concern to the State. Governing by fiat and unsupportable interpretations of rules and regulations, rather than governing by legislation and rule of law is what Texans have long accused the EPA, BLM and other Federal Agencies of. This is very unbecoming of the TCEQ and not protective of the Edwards aquifer. This is simply circumventing clear legislative intent to protect the Edwards Aquifer. Issuance of this permit will also serve to take property rights from affected land owners. There aren't any Waters of the State present in the Dry Comal Creek the vast majority of the time. Dry is the status quo. Issuance of this permit would unbalance the status quo. Issuance of this permit would impact use and enjoyment of property owners downstream of the wastewater treatment plant. Livestock graze in this area and crops are grown along the Dry Comal Creek. Wastewater effluent treated to these permit standards is not safe for direct contact with livestock for human consumption or direct contact with crops for human consumption.

The Texas Parks and Wildlife Department (TPWD) appreciates the opportunity to provide comment on the proposed new industrial wastewater discharge permit for the Randolph Todd Company, LLC's proposed new wastewater treatment plant permit (Permit No. WQ0015314001). TPWD is the agency with primary responsibility for protecting the state's fish and wildlife resources (Texas Parks and Wildlife Code §12.0011(a)). Furthermore, we are charged with providing information on fish and wildlife resources to any local, state, and federal agencies or private organizations that make decisions affecting those resources (Texas Parks and Wildlife Code §12.0011(b)(3)). Please be aware that a written response to a TPWD recommendation or informational comment received by a state governmental agency may be required by state law. For further guidance, please see Texas Parks & Wildlife Code Section 12.0011.

TPWD has several interests closely tied to this proposed discharge of treated domestic wastewater into Dry Comal Creek and thence to the Comal River. According to the Notice of Application and Preliminary Decision we received, the unclassified receiving water use is minimal aquatic life use for Dry Comal Creek. This statement appears to be in error as according to the 2014 Texas Integrated Report - Water Bodies Evaluated, Dry Comal Creek (Segment 1811A) is designated intermittent with perennial pools, thus warranting a limited aquatic life use rather than a minimal. According to scientists on the Surface Water Quality Monitoring Team at TCEQ and a TPWD regional biologist based in Wimberley, the nature of the stream being intermittent with perennial pools was confirmed as being the correct designation. While there are portions of Dry Comal Creek which follow subsurface drainage patterns, there are also reaches which maintain perennial pools. We request that this designation be corrected in the draft permit and that any calculations based on minimal aquatic life use be corrected in determining appropriate permit limits. Upon further investigation of this discharge location based on the latitude/longitude given in the notice, it appears the discharge location is into the West Fork Dry Comal Creek and not into Dry Comal Creek. This location discrepancy should be investigated further and corrected.

In addition, there are three federally-listed endangered species (the Comal Springs Riffle beetle, the Comal Springs Dryopid beetle, and the Peck's Cave Amphipod), as well as several other species of greatest conservation need (SGCN) which occur

in the Comal Springs. As Dry Comal Creek is a losing stream in places throughout the watershed, it is likely the Dry Comal Creek recharges the springs and therefore, protection of this critical habitat is of significant importance to TPWD. Water quality permit limits, especially nutrient limits, should be evaluated to be protective of these species.

My name is Steven Snyder and I am a legal intern with the environmental advocacy group Environment Texas based in Austin. We are always very interested to learn about facilities like this when they are proposed, particularly what kind of detrimental effects they may have on our water resources.

Of particular interest to me, the Dry Comal Creek has been on the TCEQ Texas Integrated Report of 303(d) listed water bodies as being out of limits on bacterial contamination since 2010, and I can't possibly see that the addition of the predicted amount of sewage this facility will be generating could possibly improve the situation. I would very much like to see quantifiable measurements provided by the TCEQ demonstrating the negligible impact of this facility. Is the executive director saying that this permit won't harm the creek due to the fact that the creek is already on the list? That's hardly what I would characterize as a progressive approach to improving our water quality.

Additionally, this area being in the Edwards Aquifer recharge zone, and this facility falling under the TCEQ's rules for parties who are required to submit an Edwards Aquifer Protection Plan for projects of this nature, I would just like to know if that has happened yet, and furthermore what are the qualifications required for such a plan to be acceptable to the TCEQ. We have heard how much wastewater this plant will be generating, and considering that it is non potable water in an aquifer recharge zone, I am just keenly eager to know how this can possibly be acceptable in the TCEQ's view.

With water being not only a local, state, or even national, but right now it is a global concern of immense importance, we cannot continue to behave irresponsibly with the limited water resources we have. We need to be progressive in our protection methods of our water supplies, and not let projects such as this one that can put our water resources in jeopardy continue forward without being closely scrutinized, and we largely depend on TCEQ to do that for us.
