Dear Commissioners,

I urge you to deny the application submitted by the Randolph Todd Company, LLC to build a sewage treatment facility as proposed on the Meyer Ranch for the following reasons:

- Excessive and still uncorrected errors in the application, some of which are significant and material.
- The misrepresentation in the application asserting that Randolph Todd Company, LLC is the owner of the Meyer Ranch property which is, based on documentation I have seen submitted for this hearing, still false and thus does not conform to TCEQ rules.
- The disallowance of public participation by narrowing the affected individuals list down to people within ½ mile of a sewage facility that proposes to dump 390,000 gallons of waste water per day into the Dry Comal Creek of the Edwards Aquifer recharge zone. Because this is a “dry” creek that only has intermittent water flow during significant rains, there will be no dilution effect and the undiluted effluent will clearly infiltrate surrounding drinking water wells, caves, and underground waterways (that contain protected species).
