My name is Ronald R Davis and my wife is Nelda S Davis. We live at 1789 S Cranes Mill Rd., New Braunfels, Texas 78132.

We are deeply concerned about the future of our home and land and the legacy we will be leaving for our two children.

If our ground water is polluted with sewage effluent or surface water runoff from a large semi-urban area as proposed on the Meyer Ranch, our property will be rendered all but worthless. This entire area is fragmented limestone and caves which make it a direct conduit to wells and other groundwater sources including the Trinity Aquifer and the Edwards Aquifer which lies below that. Without water you cannot exist and a homestead cannot either.

There are a number of areas out by where we live on S Cranes Mill Rd. that do not have a WCID, a MUD, or a Wastewater Treatment Plant. There is no need for any of this as this Comal County requires 1 acre lots for septic tanks and water is readily available from Canyon Lake Water.

Our County Government has already voted to disallow a WCID due to the lack of need in this area and the potential spoilage of the countryside.

My family and many others are beseeching you to help us by not allowing a WCID, MUD, or a new illegal rezoning of this rural property into a high density area of (small lots and almost a thousand homes). This is what the developer is planning and which is why he keeps seeking WCID and MUD status along with his Wastewater Treatment Plant. which any of these things will cause.

None of this is necessary except for the mindset of the developer to squeeze as much money out of this ranch and to get the public to pay for his infrastructure.
