Dear Ms. Bohac:

I would suggest I am exactly the type of person who needs to be accepted as a requestor. I have concerns that are not shared by the general public and certainly cannot be represented by the Office of Public Interest Counsel. Also, the comment that I do not physically live on the property is of no legal consequence. The law does not say that in order to be a requestor you must live on the land is question. Will the counsel for BLM's next claim be that only land owners be allowed to vote?

There is no doubt that the torrential rains we periodically receive on the disposal site will result in water moving from the application location. I understand that concept is not contemplated in the original permit but all the more reason for the question to be raised. The consequences of such an event must be vetted and contemplated. As previously stated, flood events cause water to cover my property, my property not the general public's property, which is contiguous with Arenosa Creek. These flood waters deposit upstream material, potentially from BLM's disposal site. The before mentioned land is grazed by livestock, my livestock, not the publics livestock, and wildlife. The water leaches through the soil into the Gulf Coast Aquifer which is located underneath my property. There needs to be an affected party granted the status of a requestor that can articulate the real life consequences of this application on my land, my livestock and wildlife. Additionally, the consequences of the aforementioned possibilities effect the value of my property, not the property of the general public.

Individuals who will suffer the significances of the actions allowed by TCEQ permits must have a seat at the table. These matters must not be left to the legal counsel of the power brokers affiliated with this permit.

This disproportionately affected Texan and Victoria County landowner respectfully appeals to the commission to be granted the status of a requestor.
