Dear Sir:

I am writing in response the Notice of Application received in the mail regarding a Wastewater permit for Honey Holding I Ltd., Permit No. WQ 0005155000. Under this proposed permit Honey Holding I is permitted to discharge up to 5,000 gallons per day of honey container wash-water directly into a roadside ditch which parallels Interstate Highway 10, and which flows directly in front of my property. As my property is adjacent to Honey Holding I, the waste water flow should be heaviest in front of my land. I am therefore concerned about the continual water discharge and the adverse effect that it will have. The slope of the ditch is almost non-existent and it is likely that wastewater will pool and create a stagnant situation which could lead to mosquito infestation, overgrown weeds, and bad odors. We the undersigned therefore request a contested case hearing.
