To Re-Examine the Disputed Issues, Violations and Non Compliance of Statutory, Regulatory Requirements, Failed Obligation to follow the

Letter of the Law of Relevant Disputed Issues and Facts. On this basis a Personal Justiciable Interest Related to my Legal Rights, Privilege and

Economic Interests is Affected. The Likelihood of Adversly Affecting Health, Livestock, Wildlife, Aquatic Ecosystems, Local Rivers, Lakes, Streams, Creeks, Fish, Environment and Safety. For these violations I express my concerns.

Affected Person and the Disputed Issue of Policy Violation; Notice was not Published in an alternative language, Newspaper is not circulated

in the affected area, and the Library is 30 miles from the area, this kept the residents from being able to respond as required by Texas Education

Code Chapter 29, Subchapter B, and 19 Texas Administration Code Subsection 89.1205 (a).

Affected Person and the Disputed Issue of Policy Violation; Submission of Incorrect Information and Misrepresentation on application

stating the Wrong Elementary School, Wrong Address on the Permit, constitutes a Violation of the Texas Water Code and the Texas Health and

Safety Code, Grounds for Enforcement Action 30 TAC Subsection 305.62 and 305.66, Texas Water Code Section 7.302.

Affected Person and the Disputed Issue of Policy Violation; Adjacent Land Owners did not receive notice by mail, Frequent and longer Power

outages by the Electric Provider than indicated in Permit. Water Well on the property is Non- Compliance of buffer zone of 250 feet. These are

subject to Administrative, Civil and Criminal Penalties under Texas Water Code Subsection 7.051-7.075 (Administrative Penalties), 7.101-7.111

(Civil Penalties) and 7.141-7.202 (Criminal Offences and Penalties).

Affected Person and the Disputed Issue; Federal Biosolids Rule 40 CFR Part 503 include Limit Concentration of Dioxin like Compounds,

Evaluation of the Site Suitability to Examine Water Supply, Soil Characterstics, Slopes, Elevation, Vegetation, Grasses needs and distance to surface

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Control Odor, Traffic, Noise, Dust and Manage Nutrients as per the Clean Water Act Section 404, Safe Drinking Water Act Code of Federal Regulations @ Title 40 Part 136, also 40 CFR Parts 401-503 WW Part 136, or 304 (H) Methods, Analytical Methods Sections 301 (a), 304 (h) and 501 (a), Effluent Limitations Guidelines Discharge To Surface Water, Sewage Sludge (Biosolids) Rule (Section 405) and (40 CFR Part 503)

Must be licensed and Regulated Haulers. Health and Safety Code Section 368.011 and 368.011 and 368.012. The Solid Waste Disposal Act, Chapter 361, Health and Safety Code, 361.014 (b).

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



Dear Mr. Hyde,

My office recently received a list of constituent complaints from Grimes County expressing concern over a Permit to Discharge Wastes, which was granted last year by the TCEQ to Grimes Co. Water Reclamation, LLC. My constituents assert that the process to approve the permit's application garnered insufficient input from some of the most important stakeholders: the residents living near the site.

I write today to ask that your legal staff review my constituents' concerns and determine whether, in light of these potential permitting defects, they retain the right to have their commentary considered in a public hearing with TCEQ. Conversations between my constituents, my staff, and TCEQ staff have raised the following issues regarding public notice:

- My constituents claim that the Navasota *Examiner* is not distributed in their town of Plantersville.
- Because the Navasota Independent School District has an alternative language program, the public notice published in the Navasota *Examiner* was required to be in Spanish as well as English, but it was not.
- After receiving a copy of the original application from TCEQ, my constituents also found a technical error that describes the wrong school (John C. Webb Elementary School) as being the closest school to the facility, when it is actually High Point Elementary.
- My constituents also claim the facility's address in TCEQ paperwork is another technical error.
- Two affected parties are Spanish-speaking only, but their notice by mail was sent only in English.

- My Constituents claim that two of the eight adjacent landowners did not receive their notice by mail at all.
- Landowners adjacent to the site claim that their notice was *not* sent by certified mail.

My constituents have several environmental and safety concerns that were not addressed in the permitting process but could be discussed in public hearing:

- TCEQ issued a permit before its staff ever physically visited and investigated the property.
- Residents complain of frequent power outages from the local electric provider, and these outages last longer than the amount of time specified by Grimes Co. Water Reclamation, LLC in its paperwork.
- A water well was recently discovered on the property where the facility is being constructed, and even TCEQ staff agree that it may not conform with the buffer requirements in agency rules to be a certain number of feet from the facility.
- No topographical study exists to address potential runoff into surface from the area applied with treated waste, which sits at a higher elevation than a creek on the property and a pond adjacent to the property line.

Based on the reasons listed above, I request that your office provide me with the legal status of a request for a public hearing with the TCEQ regarding the permit issued to Grimes Co. Water Reclamation.
