Re: Third Court of Appeals' Remand of the application of Williamson County for MSW Permit Amendment No. 1405B; TCEQ Docket No. 2005-0337-MSW; SOAH Docket No. 582-06-3321.

The above-referenced matter has been remanded to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (Commission) by the Texas Third Court of Appeals. In accordance with the Third Court's opinion, the remand is for the limited purpose of allowing the Commission to explain the reasoning and grounds for changing the Administrative Law Judges' (ALJs) recommendation on the hours of operation of heavy equipment and transportation of materials to and from the landfill in reference to Williamson County's permit amendment application.

The Office of General Counsel is providing an opportunity for the parties in the above-referenced matter to file briefs on the limited issues that have been remanded by the Third Court of Appeals. Briefs on these limited issues will be due by **5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, June 26, 2013**, and any replies to the briefs will be due by **5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, July 10, 2013**.
