1. The location of the proposed Aspen power facility is actually zoned for industrial use by the City of Lufkin but and oversight of a dwelling within the specified limits was omitted on the initial approval of the proposed facility. The Aspen spokesman utilized the phrase that the site has been approved by TCEQ which authorizes a site if all applicable statues, rules and regulations are met. No emphasis has been given on the family within this prohibited limit of the proposed facility.

2. Concerning the matter of identity theft and fraudulent signature, the matter is being pursued and will continue to be pursued until all avenues have been exhausted!

Concerning the affidavit by George Harris.

George Harris and a individual known locally as Dr. Jones made several attempts to visit with me according to my wife with no avail. She opened the door because she was familiar with George Harris because of his son. After that date George Harris and the Dr Jones visited with me twice together. They assured me the plant was coming and presented me with the enclosed document which I would not sign. It is different from the forgery which was filed at the office of the TCEQ. The document evidentially considered one or both of them as a representative but no names were listed nor did they have a copy of the air dispersion report that showed any improved controls over the original application. On July 30<sup>th</sup> 2008 I (A Hartsfield) went to the conclusion of a weekly meeting and approached George Harris and asked him if he knew who forged my and my wife signatures. He stated he did not know anything about it. I also informed three ladys outside about what had occurred(1. Sally Jefferson). I must say I was surprised by the affidavit but not shocked because of the treatment my neighbor and I have endured since the original letters of comments. I DID NOT MAKE ANY STATEMENT TO GEORGE HARRIS ABOUT SIGNING A LETTER OF SUPPORT NOR SOLICIT EMPLOYMENT FOR ANY MEMBERS OF MY FAMILY.

3. My neighbors and I live in the neighborhood and have a right to be concerned about the air dispersion models. Some components of the facility will rely on equipment with no guidelines to govern them and preliminary inspections may not be adequate or the standard for which we may be exposed to. Year round we watch the limbs and leaves on the trees as the wind swirls. We feel it may be devastating for extended periods of times for certain areas and the plant would operate 24 hours a day and 365 days each year.
