
This letter is in response to the above-referenced Motion to Overturn (Motion) filed by Reed Lamar Bowers Shrimp Farm ("Applicant") concerning the Executive Director's decision, by letter dated July 15, 2010, to approve the renewal of the Applicant's TPDES Permit No. WQ0004005000. The renewal permit, as approved, contains copper and selenium monitoring requirements. The Applicant requests that the permit be remanded back to the Executive Director for the purpose of allowing a retest requirement for copper and selenium in lieu of the monitoring and effluent requirements that were incorporated into the renewal permit. A complete copy of the Motion, the Executive Director's issuance letter, and the draft permit may be obtained from the Office of Chief Clerk, TCEQ, Mail Code 105, P.O. Box 13087, Austin, Texas 78711-3087.

The Office of General Counsel, having reviewed the Motion and related filings, has decided to set this matter for the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality's public meeting of **Wednesday, September 29, 2010**, beginning at **9:30 A.M.**, pursuant to the Commission's Resolution issued on February 2, 2009 in Docket No. 2009-0059-RES. The meeting will take place in Room 201S of Building E, 12118 N. Interstate 35, Austin, Texas.

The Commission will take oral argument on this matter. The Applicant should be prepared to present the item to the Commission and will have five minutes of oral argument time. The Executive Director and the Office of Public Interest Council will each have five minutes of oral argument time.
