

### PETITIONER'S REQUEST FOR INQUIRY

MESA WATER, L.P. ("Petitioner") files this request for an inquiry relating to joint groundwater management planning in Groundwater Management Area 1 ("GMA 1"), consisting of Hemphill County Underground Water Conservation District ("Hemphill"), North Plains Groundwater Conservation District ("North Plains"), Panhandle Groundwater Conservation District ("Panhandle"), and High Plains Underground Water Conservation District No. 1 ("High Plains") (collectively "Districts"). Petitioner respectfully shows the following:

1. Mesa Water, L.P. is a limited partnership formed pursuant to and authorized to do business under the laws of the State of Texas. Mesa's address is 8117 Preston Road, Suite 260, Dallas, Texas 75225. Mesa Water, L.P. is a person with a legally defined interest in groundwater in three of the four groundwater conservation districts comprising Groundwater Management Area 1 ("GMA 1").

2. GMA 1 is a Groundwater Management Area ("GMA") comprised of all of Hemphill County Underground Water Conservation District, all of North Plains Groundwater Conservation District, all of Panhandle Groundwater Conservation District, and a portion of High Plains Underground Water Conservation District No. 1, designated by the Texas Water Development Board ("TWDB") pursuant to TEX. WATER CODE § 35.004.

3. Pursuant to TEX. WATER CODE § 36.1071, a groundwater conservation district is required, in coordination with surface water management entities on a regional basis, to develop

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a comprehensive management plan that uses the district's best available data to address in a quantitative manner the desired future conditions ("DFCs") of the groundwater resources. Pursuant to TEX. WATER CODE § 36.108, if two or more groundwater conservation districts are located within the boundaries of the same management area, the districts are to meet at least annually to conduct "joint planning" with the other districts in the GMA. Not later than September 1, 2010, and every five years thereafter, the districts are to establish DFCs for the relevant aquifers within the management area.

4. Pursuant to TEX. WATER CODE § 36.108(d), the groundwater districts within GMA 1 adopted the following DFCs for the Ogallala aquifer in GMA 1 Resolution No. 2009-01:

- 40% volume in storage remaining in 50 years ("40/50 DFCs") in the following:
  - North Plains GCD consisting of all or parts of the following counties Dallam, Hartley, Moore and Sherman; and
  - Parts of the following counties that are not in a Groundwater Conservation District will also fall under the 40/50 DFCs, those counties being Dallam, Hartley and Moore
- 50% volume in storage remaining in 50 years ("50/50 DFCs") in the following:
  - High Plains Underground Water Conservation District consisting of parts of the following counties: Armstrong, Potter and Randall;
  - North Plains GCD consisting of all or parts of the following counties: Hansford, Hutchinson, Lipscomb and Ochiltree;
  - Panhandle Groundwater Conservation District consisting of all or part of the following counties: Armstrong, Carson, Donley, Gray, Hutchinson, Potter, Roberts and Wheeler; and
  - All or parts of the following counties that are not in a Groundwater Conservation District will also fall under the 50/50 DFCs, those counties being Hutchinson, Oldham and Randall
- 80% volume in storage remaining in 50 years in Hemphill County.<sup>1</sup>

6. Attached as Exhibit 1 is a copy of Resolution 2009-01.

7. Petitioner has diligently attempted to obtain certified copies of the following documents:

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<sup>1</sup> GMA 1 Resolution 2009-01 went on to describe a specific 390 acre tract that might—or might not—be excepted from the 80% DFC established for Hemphill County.

- a. A certified copy of the board resolutions calling for joint planning between the Districts in GMA 1;
- b. Evidence that joint planning meeting notices were received by the Districts in GMA 1;
- c. Publishers' affidavits of joint planning meeting notices; and
- d. Copies of the joint planning meeting minutes and accepted handouts certified by the Districts that attended the meetings.

8. Attached as Exhibit 2 is correspondence regarding Petitioner's efforts to obtain the above documents and the responses received to date. Petitioner believes that there is no dispute regarding whether joint planning was initiated and conducted, nor is there any dispute regarding notice of meetings at which Resolution 2009-01 was adopted by the Districts. Accordingly, Petitioner believes that the referenced documents, although required by TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 293.23, are not specifically relevant to this Petition.

9. The GMA planning process failed to result in adequate planning. The GMA planning process did not establish reasonable future desired conditions for the Ogallala aquifer in GMA 1. Attached as Exhibit 3 is a certified statement from Steve Stevens, an officer of Mesa Water, L.P. Exhibit 3 outlines the reasons Petitioner believes that adequate planning was not achieved in GMA 1 and that the planning process did not establish reasonable future desired conditions for the Ogallala Aquifer in GMA 1. Attached as Exhibit 4 is the certified statement of Robert Harden supporting the statements outlined in Exhibit 3. Exhibits 3 and 4 constitute evidence upon which Petitioner relies in connection with this petition for inquiry, and the statements therein are incorporated by reference in this petition.

10. Tex. Water Code Sec. 36.108 creates a mutual, joint and several responsibility among and between the Districts to jointly plan and manage the groundwater resources of the groundwater management area. Each of the Districts is charged with the responsibility of adopting rules designed to achieve the DFCs for “the groundwater resources of the groundwater management area.” As noted more fully in Exhibits 3 and 4, the Districts have failed to discharge their joint planning responsibilities. Further, the Districts will be unable to discharge those responsibilities because the DFCs adopted by them are not reasonable.

11. As noted in Exhibits 3 and 4, the rules adopted by the Districts are not designed to achieve the desired future condition of the groundwater resources in the GMA. Further, the groundwater in the management area is not adequately protected by the rules adopted by the Districts. Additionally, the groundwater in the management area is not adequately protected due to the failure of the Districts to uniformly enforce substantial compliance with their respective rules. Finally, the groundwater in the management area is not adequately protected due to the failure of the Districts to adopt rules designed to achieve the DFCs in adjoining districts and in areas of GMA 1 that are not in districts.


12. Based on the above and the attached materials, Petitioner requests an inquiry regarding the matters set forth herein. Following the inquiry, Petitioner requests a list of findings and recommended actions including but not limited to the following:

- a. Issuing an order requiring the Districts to adopt a single Desired Future Condition for each of the subdivisions the Ogallala aquifer in GMA 1 and to adopt and equitably enforce rules designed to achieve the Desired Future Condition;

- b. Dissolving the boards of directors of the Districts within GMA 1 pursuant to TWC 36.305 and 36.307; or
- c. Dissolving the Districts in accordance with TWC 36.304, 36.305, and 36.308.

RESOLUTION NO. 2009-01

OF THE GROUNDWATER MANAGEMENT AREA 1 JOINT PLANNING COMMITTEE  
ADOPTING DESIRED FUTURE CONDITIONS FOR THE OGALLALA AND RITA  
BLANCA AQUIFERS

WHEREAS, Groundwater Management Area 1 ("GMA-1") is comprised of eighteen counties in the northern section of the Texas Panhandle and encompasses four groundwater conservation districts - the Hemphill County Underground Water Conservation District ("Hemphill District"), portions of the High Plains Underground Water Conservation District ("High Plains District"), the North Plains Groundwater Conservation District ("North Plains District"), and the Panhandle Groundwater Conservation District ("Panhandle District");

WHEREAS, the Ogallala Aquifer and the Rita Blanca Aquifer are referenced as one layer in the Northern Ogallala GAM, any references to the "Ogallala Aquifer" in this document shall also include and apply to any groundwater in the Rita Blanca Aquifer in those portions of GMA 1;

WHEREAS, GMA-1 unanimously supports the following goals, ideals and standards for GMA-1. The GMA-1 member Districts have worked to learn the rules and goals of each individual district, along with the history of how each District has arrived at their different management philosophies. The members of GMA-1 agree and support the Desired Future Conditions ("DFCs") as set out below. These conditions are viewed only as starting points for GMA-1 to go forth for the next five years as charged. The members of GMA-1 agree that constant monitoring from each District is necessary to measure the depths and scope of the Ogallala Aquifer and the Rita Blanca Aquifer, where it exists, and to manage these groundwater resources to achieve these DFCs;

WHEREAS, pursuant to TEXAS WATER CODE ANN. § 36.108, the presiding officer, or his designee, from each of the four Districts in GMA-1 are obligated to engage in ongoing joint planning to, among other things, establish the DFCs of the aquifers within GMA-1;

WHEREAS, such joint planning has been undertaken, and is ongoing, by the four presiding officers or designees of the Districts, and this body has come to be known as the GMA-1 Joint Planning Committee (JPC);

WHEREAS, the JPC in GMA-1 has met as required by Section 36.108 of the Texas Water Code for joint planning not only to set the initial DFCs, but also to move towards improved conservation of the Ogallala Aquifer within its boundaries;

WHEREAS, the Ogallala Aquifer consists of substantially different characteristics and conditions across its boundaries and pursuant to TEXAS WATER CODE ANN. § 36.108, when considering the adoption of DFCs, the JPC is obligated to and has considered the "uses or conditions of an aquifer within the GMA that differ substantially from one area to another" and may adopt different DFCs for different areas overlying an aquifer;

WHEREAS, the JPC also believes the DFCs to be generally consistent with the 2006 Panhandle Regional Water Plan and the 2007 State Water Plan;

WHEREAS, the DFCs adopted by the JPC on this date are subject to revision in the future;

WHEREAS, the JPC desires to honor the mandates of Chapter 36 of the Texas Water Code, including private property rights, and desires to treat everyone in a reasonable manner given the extreme diversity through the area;

WHEREAS, the JPC desires to inform the citizens of the Texas Panhandle about the Ogallala Aquifer, the diversity of the aquifer and its uses and conditions, and the challenges of groundwater management with minimal impact to the local economy;

WHEREAS, the JPC has worked closely with the Texas Water Development Board, their hydrologists and other qualified professionals to base the adopted Desired Future Conditions on the best available science;

WHEREAS, the JPC is striving towards the intent of the joint planning process and is fully committed to continuing this important process and achieving the ultimate goal to conserve and preserve the aquifer;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE JOINT PLANNING COMMITTEE OF GROUNDWATER MANAGEMENT AREA 1 THAT:

1. All the preceding statements formed the basis for the decision by the Groundwater Management Area 1 Joint Planning Committee to adopt on this date, the DFCs set forth herein:
2. The following Desired Future Conditions are hereby adopted for the Ogallala Aquifer within Groundwater Management Area 1 as described below:
  - 40% volume in storage remaining in 50 years in the following:
    - North Plains GCD consisting of all or parts of the following counties Dallam, Hartley, Moore and Sherman; and
    - Parts of the following counties that are not in a Groundwater Conservation District will also fall under the 40/50 DFCs, those counties being Dallam, Hartley and Moore
  - 50% volume in storage remaining in 50 years in the following:
    - High Plains Underground Water Conservation District consisting of parts of the following counties: Armstrong, Potter and Randall;
    - North Plains GCD consisting of all or parts of the following counties: Hansford, Hutchinson, Lipscomb and Ochiltree;
    - Panhandle Groundwater Conservation District consisting of all or part of the following counties: Armstrong, Carson, Donley, Gray, Hutchinson, Potter, Roberts and Wheeler; and

- o All or parts of the following counties that are not in a Groundwater Conservation District will also fall under the 50/50 DFCs, those counties being Hutchinson, Oldham and Randall
- 80% volume in storage remaining in 50 years in Hemphill County; provided that, in the event it is legally determined that the roughly 390-acre tract of land located in southwest Hemphill County and described more particularly in Attachment A (the "390-acre tract") lies within the jurisdiction of the Panhandle Groundwater Conservation District and not within the jurisdiction of the Hemphill County Underground Water Conservation District, then the Desired Future Condition for the 390-acre tract shall be 50% volume in storage remaining in 50 years and the Desired Future Condition for the remainder of Hemphill County shall be 80% volume in storage remaining in 50 years.

The JPC recognizes that each District's boundaries may change due to the consolidation or annexation of land in GMA 1 that is either in or out of a district, therefore, the consolidated or annexed land will follow the rules, regulations, and Desired Future Conditions of the receiving District. The members of the JPC for GMA 1 unanimously agree that these are the goals for the DFCs in GMA -1 for the next five years.

3. These DFCs shall become effective on the date indicated below and shall remain in effect for five years, unless modified or repealed sooner by the JPC in accordance with applicable law.
4. The members of the Groundwater Management Area 1 Joint Planning Committee agree to continue to work in good faith on joint planning efforts in a manner consistent with applicable law.
5. All Districts in Groundwater Management Area 1 are unified in fulfilling the charge, set forth in Section 36.0015, Texas Water Code, to "provide for the conservation, preservation, protection, recharging, and prevention of waste of groundwater, and of groundwater reservoirs or their subdivisions, and to control subsidence caused by withdrawal of water from those groundwater reservoirs or their subdivisions, consistent with the objectives of Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, groundwater conservation districts may be created as provided by this chapter. Groundwater conservation districts created as provided by this chapter are the state's preferred method of groundwater management through rules developed, adopted, and promulgated by a district in accordance with the provisions of this chapter."




BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority, on this day personally appeared Curtis "Steve" Stevens, who, being duly sworn by me, deposed and stated as follows:

1. My name is Steve Stevens. I am over the age of 18 years, of sound mind, and capable of making this Certified Statement. The facts stated in this Statement are within my personal knowledge and are true and correct.

2. I am Vice President of Mesa Water, L.P.

3. Petitioner believes the joint planning process in Groundwater Management Area 1 ("GMA 1") failed to result in adequate planning, including the establishment of reasonable desired future conditions of the Ogallala aquifer, for the reasons set forth below.

a. Petitioner relies on the services and expertise of Robert D. Harden of Austin, Texas in connection with the acquisition, development and management of its groundwater rights. I have reviewed the certified statement of Robert D. Harden attached to Petitioner's request for an inquiry, and have relied on that statement, which is incorporated verbatim herein. Additionally, I have formed my own opinions and conclusions based on my experience in managing and attempting to develop groundwater rights belonging to Petitioner, and those opinions and conclusions are expressed below.



b. GMA 1 has not adopted reasonable DFCs based on "uses or aquifer conditions" that "differ substantially". A long standing hydrologic principle, the aquifer subdivision, provides clear guidance on what are the proper management units of an aquifer. GMA 1 has ignored the appropriate aquifer subdivisions and instead relied on political areas, both counties and groundwater districts, to delineate the "uses or conditions of an aquifer" that "differ substantially". Resolution 2009-01 has a clear statement that if district authority changes for a particular property, then the DFC of the receiving district is to apply. This use of political areas to delineate differences in use or aquifer characteristics is unreasonable in that it does not hydrologically consider common areas of groundwater recharge, discharge, and flow characteristics. These are standard principles used by hydrologists to delineate reasonable groundwater management units.

c. Section 36.108(f)(2) requires each district to have or adopt rules to "achieve the desired future condition of the groundwater resources in the groundwater management area". Related provisions in Section 36.108 reinforce the obligation for each district to adopt, and to enforce, rules to adequately protect the groundwater in the groundwater management area.

d. Groundwater conditions abide by well known hydrologic and scientific principles of groundwater recharge, discharge, and groundwater flow.

e. Since the adoption of the GMA-1 DFCs in June 2009, no district has passed any new rules designed to protect the groundwater and achieve the DFCs. Further, none of the districts had rules in place before the adoption of Resolution 2009-01 that are

designed to achieve the subsequently adopted desired future condition of the groundwater resources in the groundwater management area.

f. Both North Plains and High Plains have failed to adopt rules designed to achieve the desired future condition of the groundwater resources in the groundwater management area. Neither district has a rule that addresses aquifer storage remaining, nor quantifies how the DFCs are to be complied with. North Plains has repealed both their Rule 4 – Acceptable Decline Rate and Rule 5 – Strategic Conservation Area.

g. Hemphill has failed to adopt rules designed to achieve the desired future condition of the groundwater resources in the groundwater management area. Existing Hemphill Rule 5.107(a)(4) – Acceptable Decline Rate is not designed to achieve the desired future condition of the groundwater resources in the groundwater management area, and the groundwater is not adequately protected by the rules adopted by the district. Rule 5.107(a)(4) limits the acceptable decline rate to 1% and this does not ensure a DFC of 80% remaining in Hemphill County will be achieved. In addition, Hemphill has also recently extended the delay for requiring groundwater users to obtain and conform to a production permit. This is further evidence of a lack of rules, or lack of enforcement of rules, that are designed to achieve the desired future condition.

h. If Panhandle Rule 15 – Depletion and Production Management is the rule Panhandle uses to achieve the desired future condition of the groundwater resources in the groundwater management area, then the groundwater in the management area is not adequately protected due to the failure of the district to enforce substantial compliance with its rules. In that regard, Rule 15.1(c) of the Panhandle rules

provides that to achieve the 50% remaining in 50 years standard, the district may establish an acceptable annual decline rate. Under that same rule, the acceptable annual decline rate is currently 1.25% of the saturated thickness of the aquifer. Under Rule 15.3 of Panhandle's rules, the district declares a "conservation area" for an area surrounding the area exceeding the acceptable annual decline rate. When an area is declared a conservation area, the district purports to be able to mandate reductions in production until compliance with the acceptable annual decline rate is achieved in that area. Panhandle has allowed Canadian River Municipal Water Authority ("CRMWA") to exceed the District's acceptable annual decline rate for several years. Although Panhandle staff proposed to enforce its rules by declaring the area around CRMWA's well field a conservation area, the Panhandle board of directors recently declined to do so. Many other areas of the Panhandle district also currently exceed the acceptable decline rate, and no enforcement action designed to achieve the DFCs has ever been taken by the district. The district justifies these excessive decline areas as acceptable because groundwater production within the areas of excessive decline is estimated to be less than the Panhandle "floor rate". However, production outside these areas can be the cause of the excessive depletion and the Panhandle district fails to enforce existing Rule 15 on those groundwater users causing the excessive decline.

- i. If Panhandle Rule 15 – Depletion and Production Management is not the rule Panhandle uses to achieve the desired future condition of the groundwater resources in the groundwater management area, then Panhandle has failed to adopt rules designed to achieve the desired future condition of the groundwater resources in the groundwater management area.

j. The districts of GMA 1 have adopted spatially variable, "politically based" DFCs. Yet, groundwater conditions do not conform to, nor abide by, political boundaries and groundwater production in one politically delineated area can affect the groundwater conditions and water supply in an adjoining politically delineated area. Each of the districts (North Plains, Panhandle, Hemphill, and High Plains) has failed to pass rules that consider the effect of in-district production on the DFC in an adjoining political area. Clearly, the districts have failed to pass rules designed to achieve the desired future condition of the groundwater resources in the groundwater management area that are not part of their respective districts but are hydrologically connected to their districts. For instance, neither North Plains nor Panhandle have passed rules designed to achieve the 80% DFC for Hemphill County when also considering Hemphill's rules. Today, production in North Plains or Panhandle can cause decline rates in wells in Hemphill County in excess of Hemphill Rule 5.107(1)(4). Additionally, North Plains has not adopted rules to protect the 50% DFC criteria even though groundwater production in the 40% DFC areas can affect achieving the DFC in adjoining 50% areas. Lastly, not one of the districts has passed rules designed to achieve the DFC in an adjoining non-district area even though in-district production can affect achieving the DFC in adjoining area not within a district. Yet, the Texas Water Code specifically requires for rules to be "designed to achieve the desired future condition of the groundwater resources in the groundwater management area". To summarize, the DFCs now require the districts to pass cooperative sets of rules that 1) achieve the common DFC within each district, 2) also address the disparate DFCs within a district (North Plains) that are hydrologically connected to other areas


of the district, 3) also address in-district production effects on achieving the DFC within an adjacent district that is hydrologically connected, and 4) also address in-district production effects on achieving the DFC within an adjacent area that is not in a district but that is hydrologically connected. This is likely impossible when the DFC areas do not honor the standard principles of an aquifer subdivision.

k. In Texas, aquifer subdivision has been a standard groundwater management principle since at least 1949. Aquifer subdivision is clearly defined in the Water Code – "...a definable part of a groundwater reservoir in which the groundwater supply will not be appreciably affected by withdrawing water from any other part of the reservoir...". The hydrologic complexity caused by subdividing aquifer subdivisions and assigning DFCs on political bases creates great difficulty for the districts to pass clear rules that are designed to achieve the desired future condition of the groundwater resources in the groundwater management area.


1. The districts have failed to pass rules to define what compliance with the DFCs means. Is 50% of the water to remain throughout the four identified areas of 50% remaining, or on average within this total area, or on average by district and out-of-district within the 50% remaining zone, or by some other "to be defined" area? In looking closely at the adopted language of the DFCs in Resolution 2009-01, each of the DFCs is defined by an amount of storage to remain in 50 years *in* an area. The TWDB assumed this is to mean three different areas regardless which district exists or does not exist. In calculating the MAG, the TWDB assumed there are three areas and the average storage remaining within each area is to be 40%, 50%, or 80% remaining. However,

the adopted DFCs must literally be interpreted as applying to seven areas as these are distinctly identified as such in Resolution 2009-01. The 40% criterion is identified to apply to two distinct areas (one being within the North Plains district in Dallam, Hartley, Moore and Sherman Counties, and the other being areas of the aquifer not in the North Plains in these counties), the 50% to four distinctly identified areas, and the 80% to one area. Additionally, several of the districts have also indicated the DFC applies at a scale less than the applicable DFC area. Panhandle has a 9-sq. mile area criteria that applies under its Rule 15. Hemphill has a 1% at a wellbore criteria. Resolution 2009-01 has a statement "the Desired Future Condition for the 390-acre tract shall be...". The districts lack clear and uniform rules that identify the basic meaning of the DFCs, specify the precise area to be averaged to demonstrate compliance, and spell out enforcement procedures. This causes great regulatory uncertainty. The uncertainty directly precludes prudent water system design and engineering for compliance with rules because the rules and enforcement principles are unknown and undefined. This uncertainty has grave consequences for responsible planning, development, and conservation of Texas' groundwater resources.



BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority, on this day personally appeared Robert D. Harden, who, being duly sworn by me, stated as follows:

1. My name is Robert D. Harden. I am over the age of 18 years, of sound mind, and capable of making this affidavit. The facts stated in this affidavit are within my personal knowledge and are true and correct.
2. I am Vice-President of R. W. Harden and Associates, Inc. For nearly four decades the firm has been involved with groundwater planning, groundwater development, groundwater rights valuations, and conservation of Texas' groundwater resources. I received a Bachelor of Science and a Master of Science from the University of Texas. Each of these degrees specializes in water resources. I have 18 years of experience in connection with the Ogallala aquifer, working for clients such as the City of Amarillo, SAA Properties, Quixx Corporation, Mr. Mark Nichols, High Plains Groundwater District #1, Mesa Water, Courson Family Land Partnership, Burnett Oil Company, and others. I am a Licensed Professional Engineer in the State of Texas.
3. I am familiar with and have studied the Desired Future Conditions ("DFCs") proposed by the groundwater districts comprising Groundwater Management Area 1 ("GMA 1"), and I have reviewed GMA 1 Resolution 2009-01. Further, I have reviewed various Groundwater Availability Model ("GAM") runs performed by the Texas Water Development Board ("TWDB") staff, including the model simulation associated with report GAM 09-001, report GAM 09-001 Supplemental, GAM Run 09-026 MAG, and have personally conducted similar model simulations to better



understand the applicability of the GAM use and interpretation of the results.

4. I am familiar with and have studied the existing management plans and rules of the North Plains Groundwater Conservation District (North Plains), the Panhandle Groundwater District (Panhandle), the Hemphill County Groundwater District (Hemphill), and the High Plains Groundwater Conservation District No. 1 (High Plains).
5. In the capacity as a Licensed Professional Engineer, I routinely plan and engineer water supply systems. Complying with applicable rules and regulations is an important component of my work.
6. Attached as Attachment 1 is a map of the area covered by GMA 1, showing the Ogallala aquifer DFCs adopted by the Districts through Resolution 2009-01. Three different amounts of the percent volume in storage remaining in 50 years are stated. These are 40%, 50%, and 80% volume in storage remaining in 50 years. Each percent remaining is stated to apply to different "bulleted" areas. Because the bullets are separated by semicolons, I now deduce these identify distinct areas the percent remaining applies to. I replace the bullets with a sequential numbering system for better identification. The areas the three different percent remaining apply to are:
  - 40% volume in storage remaining in 50 years in the following:
    - Area 1. North Plains GCD consisting of all or parts of the following counties Dallam, Hartley, Moore and Sherman;
    - Area 2. Parts of the following counties that are not in a Groundwater Conservation District will also fall under the 40/50 DFCs, those counties being Dallam, Hartley and Moore.
  - 50% volume in storage remaining in 50 years in the following:
    - Area 3. High Plains Underground Water Conservation District consisting of parts of the following counties: Armstrong, Potter and Randall;
    - Area 4. North Plains GCD consisting of all or parts of the following counties: Hansford, Hutchinson, Lipscomb and Ochiltree;

Area 5. Panhandle Groundwater Conservation District consisting of all or part of the following counties: Armstrong, Carson, Donley, Gray, Hutchinson, Potter, Roberts and Wheeler;

Area 6. All or parts of the following counties that are not in a Groundwater Conservation District will also fall under the 50/50 DFCs, those counties being Hutchinson, Oldham and Randall.

- 80% volume in storage remaining in 50 years in the following:

Area 7. Hemphill County<sup>1</sup>.

7. Attachment 2 is a map of the Ogallala aquifer as it exists in the area underlying GMA 1. The Ogallala aquifer is a specific subsurface water-bearing reservoir having ascertainable boundaries, and these boundaries are the extents of Quarternary and Tertiary age sediments. Attachment 3 shows that under current water level conditions, the Ogallala aquifer has a hydraulic boundary associated with the Canadian River, which currently divides the Ogallala aquifer into two distinct aquifer subdivisions. Each aquifer subdivision exists continuously (where Quarternary and Tertiary sediments exist) without significant hydrological or hydraulic boundaries. As such, within each aquifer subdivision the nature of the Ogallala aquifer is such that groundwater flows across all county lines and all groundwater conservation district boundaries without hydrologic interruption. As water is pumped from the Ogallala, the saturated thickness declines as water is removed from storage until the wells radius of influence captures recharge equal to the pumping rate. Further, no district or county within GMA 1 entirely encapsulates the Ogallala aquifer or either subdivision of the aquifer; groundwater

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<sup>1</sup> There is dispute over a 390 acre tract located in Hemphill County that was annexed into the Panhandle district prior to the creation of the Hemphill district. GMA 1 has adopted that the DFC for this tract is dependent upon which groundwater district has jurisdiction ... "in the event it is legally determined that the roughly 390-acre tract of land located in southwest Hemphill County lies within the jurisdiction of the Panhandle Groundwater Conservation District and not within the jurisdiction of the Hemphill County Underground Water Conservation District, then the Desired Future Condition for the 390-acre tract shall be 50% volume in storage remaining in 50 years and the Desired Future Condition for the remainder of Hemphill County shall be 80% volume in storage remaining in 50 years." The mere fact that the DFC for this tract is dependent upon which groundwater district the tract belongs to provides a clear example that GMA 1 has not established reasonable DFCs based solely on "uses or conditions of an aquifer" that "differ substantially".

therefore flows from district to district and from county to county. Within either aquifer subdivision, groundwater production in a given district or a given county can affect and impair the groundwater supply in an adjacent area, district or county.

8. Attachment 4 is a map of the projected regional water flow in the Ogallala aquifer resulting from the adopted DFCs and production of the managed available groundwater (MAG). This regional flow pattern is the product of the TWDB's groundwater availability modeling associated with the DFCs stated in Resolution 2009-01 and as unanimously adopted by GMA 1 member districts.
9. In consideration of the above, my professional opinions include:
  - a. GMA 1 has not adopted reasonable DFCs based on "uses or aquifer conditions" that "differ substantially". In Texas, a long standing hydrologic principle (legally and technically), the aquifer and aquifer subdivision, provide clear guidance on what are the proper management units of an aquifer. GMA 1 has ignored the appropriate aquifer subdivisions and instead relied on political areas, both counties and groundwater districts, to delineate the "uses or conditions of an aquifer" that "differ substantially". Resolution 2009-01 has a clear statement that if district authority changes for a particular property, then the DFC of the receiving district is to apply. This use of political areas to delineate differences in use or aquifer characteristics is unreasonable in that it does not hydrologically consider common areas of groundwater recharge, discharge, and flow characteristics. These are standard principles used by hydrologists to delineate reasonable groundwater management units necessary for successful aquifer management and water planning.
  - b. Section 36.108(f)(2) requires each district to have or adopt rules to "achieve the desired future condition of the groundwater resources in the

groundwater management area". Related provisions in Section 36.108 reinforce the obligation for each district to adopt, and to enforce, rules to adequately protect the groundwater in the groundwater management area.

- c. Groundwater conditions abide by well known hydrologic and scientific principles of groundwater recharge, discharge, and groundwater flow.
- d. Since the adoption of the GMA-1 DFCs in June 2009, no district has updated its management plan to contain goals and objectives consistent with achieving the desired future condition of the Ogallala aquifer. No district has passed any new rules designed to protect the groundwater and achieve the DFCs. Further, none of the districts had rules in place before the adoption of Resolution 2009-01 that are designed to achieve the subsequently adopted desired future condition of the groundwater resources in the groundwater management area.
- e. Both North Plains and High Plains have failed to adopt rules designed to achieve the desired future condition of the groundwater resources in the groundwater management area. Neither district has a rule that addresses aquifer storage remaining, nor quantifies how the DFCs are to be complied with. North Plains has repealed both their Rule 4 – Acceptable Decline Rate and Rule 5 – Strategic Conservation Area.
- f. Hemphill has failed to adopt rules designed to achieve the desired future condition of the groundwater resources in the groundwater management area. Existing Hemphill Rule 5.107(a)(4) – Acceptable Decline Rate is not designed to achieve the desired future condition of the groundwater resources in the groundwater management area, and the groundwater is not adequately protected by the rules adopted by the district. Rule 5.107(a)(4) limits the acceptable decline rate to 1% at the wellbore and this does not ensure a DFC of 80% remaining in Hemphill County will be

achieved. In addition, Hemphill has also recently extended the delay for requiring groundwater users to obtain and conform to a production permit. This is further evidence of a lack of rules, or lack of enforcement of rules, that are designed to achieve the desired future condition.

- g. If Panhandle Rule 15 – Depletion and Production Management is the rule Panhandle uses to achieve the desired future condition of the groundwater resources in the groundwater management area, then the groundwater in the management area is not adequately protected due to the failure of the district to enforce substantial compliance with its rules. In that regard, Rule 15.1(c) of the Panhandle rules provides that to achieve the 50% remaining in 50 years standard, the district may establish an acceptable annual decline rate. Under that same rule, the acceptable annual decline rate is currently 1.25% of the saturated thickness of the aquifer. Under Rule 15.3 of Panhandle's rules, the district declares a "conservation area" for an area surrounding the area exceeding the acceptable annual decline rate. When an area is declared a conservation area, the district purports to be able to mandate reductions in production until compliance with the acceptable annual decline rate is achieved in that area. Panhandle has allowed Canadian River Municipal Water Authority ("CRMWA") to exceed the District's acceptable annual decline rate for several years. Although Panhandle staff proposed to enforce its rules by declaring the area around CRMWA's well field a conservation area, the Panhandle board of directors recently declined to do so. Many other areas of the Panhandle district also currently exceed the acceptable decline rate. The district justifies these excessive decline areas as acceptable because groundwater production within the areas of excessive decline is estimated to be less than the Panhandle "floor rate". However, production outside

these areas can be the cause of the excessive depletion and the Panhandle district fails to enforce existing Rule 15 on those groundwater users causing the excessive decline.

h. If Panhandle Rule 15 – Depletion and Production Management is not the rule Panhandle uses to achieve the desired future condition of the groundwater resources in the groundwater management area, then Panhandle has failed to adopt rules designed to achieve the desired future condition of the groundwater resources in the groundwater management area.


i. The districts of GMA 1 have adopted spatially variable, “politically based” DFCs. Yet, groundwater conditions do not conform to, nor abide by, political boundaries and groundwater production in one politically delineated area can affect the groundwater conditions and water supply in an adjoining politically delineated area. Each of the districts (North Plains, Panhandle, Hemphill, and High Plains) has failed to pass rules that consider the effect of in-district production on the DFC in an adjoining political area. Clearly, the districts have failed to pass rules designed to achieve the desired future condition of the groundwater resources in the groundwater management area that are not part of their respective districts but are hydrologically connected to their districts. For instance, neither North Plains nor Panhandle have passed rules designed to achieve the 80% DFC for Hemphill County when also considering Hemphill’s rules. Today, production in North Plains or Panhandle can cause decline rates in wells in Hemphill County in excess of Hemphill Rule 5.107(1)(4). Additionally, North Plains has not adopted rules to protect the 50% DFC criteria even though groundwater production in the 40% DFC areas can affect achieving the DFC in adjoining 50% areas. Lastly, not one of the

districts has passed rules designed to achieve the DFC in an adjoining non-district area even though in-district production can affect achieving the DFC in adjoining area not within a district. Yet, the Texas Water Code specifically requires for rules to be "designed to achieve the desired future condition of the groundwater resources in the groundwater management area". To summarize, the DFCs now require the districts to pass cooperative sets of rules that 1) achieve the common DFC within each district, 2) also address the disparate DFCs within a district (North Plains) that are hydrologically connected to other areas of the district, 3) also address in-district production effects on achieving the DFC within an adjacent district that is hydrologically connected, and 4) also address in-district production effects on achieving the DFC within an adjacent area that is not in a district but that is hydrologically connected. This is likely impossible when the DFC areas do not honor the standard principles of an aquifer subdivision.

- j. In Texas, aquifer subdivision has been a standard groundwater management principle since at least 1949. Aquifer subdivision is clearly defined in the Water Code – "...a definable part of a groundwater reservoir in which the groundwater supply will not be appreciably affected by withdrawing water from any other part of the reservoir...". The hydrologic complexity caused by subdividing aquifer subdivisions and assigning DFCs on political bases creates great difficulty for the districts to pass clear rules that are designed to achieve the desired future condition of the groundwater resources in the groundwater management area.
- k. The districts have failed to pass rules to define what compliance with the DFCs means. Is 50% of the water to remain throughout the four identified areas of 50% remaining, or on average within this total area, or on average

by district and out-of-district within the 50% remaining zone, or by some other "to be defined" area? In looking closely at the adopted language of the DFCs in Resolution 2009-01, each of the DFCs is defined by an amount of storage to remain in 50 years *in* an area. The TWDB assumed this is to mean three different areas regardless which district exists or does not exist. In calculating the MAG, the TWDB assumed there are three areas and the average storage remaining within each area is to be 40%, 50%, or 80% remaining. However, the adopted DFCs must literally be interpreted as applying to seven areas as these are distinctly identified as such in Resolution 2009-01. 


Ogallala Aquifer


