

Re: TCEQ Docket No. 2013-0437-MSW: Motion to Overturn filed by the City of Carrollton ("Movant"), concerning the Executive Director's decision to grant the City of Farmers Branch's and Camelot Landfill TX, LP's (collectively, "Applicants") application for a permit modification to authorize the use of alternative daily cover at the Camelot Landfill

This letter relates to Movant's Motion to Overturn ("Motion"), filed on February 27, 2013, concerning the Executive Director's issuance of a permit modification to Municipal Solid Waste Permit No. 1312A on January 22, 2013 (by letter dated February 6, 2013), authorizing the use of contaminated soils as alternative daily cover. In a letter dated March 8, 2013, the Commission's Office of General Counsel extended the time for the Commission to act on the Motion until April 25, 2013 and invited the Applicants, the Executive Director, and the Office of Public Interest Counsel to file responses to the Motion and invited the Movant to file a reply. Complete copies of the Motion and related responses may be obtained from the Office of the Chief Clerk, TCEQ, Mail Code 105, P.O. Box 13087, Austin, Texas 78711-3087.

The Office of General Counsel, having reviewed the Motion and related filings, has decided to set the above-referenced matter for consideration by the Commission at its public meeting on **Tuesday, April 23, 2013**, starting at **9:30 a.m.** in Room 201S, Building E, 12100 Park 35 Circle, Austin, Texas 78753.

The Commission will take oral argument on this matter. The Movant should be prepared to present the item to the Commission and will have five minutes of oral argument time, including time for rebuttal. The Applicants (collectively), the Executive Director, and the Office of Public Interest Counsel will each have five minutes of oral argument time.
