This letter is in response to the Executive Director's request for an agenda setting for the Commission to consider an order setting the compensation amount for the decertification of Monarch Utilities I, L.P. ("Monarch") from a portion of Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") No. 12983, in Hays County, Texas, pursuant to Section 13.254(a-5) of the Texas Water Code. The Commission will consider the appraisals of the decertified area conducted on behalf of Monarch, the landowner EB Windy Hill, L.P. ("Landowner"), and the Executive Director. The Commission's Office of General Counsel is hereby setting the matter for consideration by the Commission at a public meeting to be held on **Wednesday, November 20, 2013 at 9:30 a.m.** in Room 201S, Building E, 12100 Park 35 Circle, Austin, Texas 78753. The parties should be available to respond to questions from the Commission at the public meeting. Monarch, the Landowner, the Executive Director and the Office of Public Interest Counsel will each have five minutes of oral argument time.

The Commission's Office of General Counsel will provide an opportunity to file briefs with regard to the appraisals for the compensation determination for the expedited CCN release. These briefs must be filed with the Chief Clerk's Office no later than **5:00 p.m. on Friday, November 1, 2013**. The response briefs may be filed electronically at <http://www10.tceq.state.tx.us/epic/efilings/> or by filing an original and 7 copies with the Chief Clerk of the TCEQ. The parties must also mail a copy of the response briefs to all other persons on the attached mailing list on the same day the briefs are submitted to the Office of Chief Clerk.
