

Dear Judge Seitzman:

This letter is to request an extension of time to file exceptions to the Supplemental Proposal for Decision issued May 30, 2007. Defendants have not been served with the Supplemental PFD prior to this date. I was made aware of the Supplemental PFD only today as a result of conversation with Mr. Paul Munguia who subsequently faxed me a copy of the document. The date for filing exceptions was June 6 which is obviously passed and thus Defendant has been deprived of an opportunity to make its exceptions known to the Court.

Additionally, the notice of publication in the Texas Register was June 15, 2007. The public is allowed 30 days for comment from the date of publication. The comment period will not close prior to the scheduled June 27 hearing date set for the Commission thus depriving the public of its full opportunity to participate in the people's business. For the foregoing reasons I ask that the time for filing extensions be reopened and the date for hearing by the Commission be reset.
