Re: Application of the City of Alton to Amend Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 20809 in Hidalgo County and Application of the City of Mission to Amend CCN No. 20768 in Hidalgo County; SOAH Docket Nos. 582-08-3825 and 582-09-3548; TCEQ Docket Nos. 2008-0955-UCR and 2009-0350-UCR.

This letter is in response to the titled "Motion for Continuance" (Motion) filed by the City of Mission requesting an additional seven days to extend the deadline to file its Response to Exceptions to the Proposal for Decision and Motion to Reopen the Record filed by the City of Alton. The Motion requests an extension of at least seven days until August 19, 2010 for the filing of said Response. The Motion represents, among other reasons, that the Lead Counsel for the City of Mission has recently changed and that the additional time is necessary for current counsel to prepare said Response. The Motion also represents that counsel for the City of Mission has contacted the other parties to the proceeding and that they do not oppose the requested deadline extension.

After having reviewed the Motion filed by the City of Mission, OGC finds that extending the deadline to August 19, 2010 for all parties to file a Response to Exceptions, including the City of Mission, is appropriate under the circumstances. Therefore, the deadline for all parties in this matter who wish to file a Response to Exceptions (also known as a "Reply to Exceptions") is hereby extended until 5:00 p.m. on August 19, 2010, pursuant to 30 TAC §80.257(b).
