On October 1, 2010, Protestant Goliad County received Judge Wilfong's cover letter and Proposal for Decision by mail in the above referenced matter. Judge Wilfong's letter established October 17, 2010 as the deadline for submitting exceptions, and October 27, 2010 for submitting replies to any exceptions filed. See Attachment 1. However, Jim Blackburn and I are scheduled for a contested case hearing the week of October 11, 2010 through October 15, 2010. In light of this scheduling conflict, Goliad County respectfully requests a deadline extension for all parties to submit exceptions and replies to exceptions until October 22, 2010 and November 1, 2010, respectively. Pursuant to 30 T.A.C. § 80.257, Goliad County conferred with all parties regarding the proposed extensions. The Applicant, ED and OPIC have all indicated they are unopposed to the request. On October 4, 2010, Judge Wilfong responded by letter indicating that he also is unopposed to the requested extension. As requested by TCEQ, Judge Wilfong's letter is attached. See Attachment 2. Therefore, Goliad County respectfully requests that the TCEQ grant their request for extension.

Dear Mr. Trobman:

Enclosed are copies of the Proposal for Decision (PFD) prepared in the above-referenced matter. You will note that I am not presenting a proposed order to the Commission at this time, because there remain unresolved issues which preclude a recommendation that the applications be granted at this time. The PFD recommends that the applications be remanded for additional evidence to be developed and made part of the record, or in the alternative, that the applications be denied. Thus, it is uncertain how the Commission may proceed with this case. If the Commission adopts the recommendation to remand, the ALJ can prepare a supplemental PFD and proposed order following the re-convened contested case hearing and close of the record.

Any party may file exceptions or briefs by filing the documents with the Chief Clerk of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality no later than October 17, 2010. Any replies to exceptions or briefs must be filed in the same manner no later than October 27, 2010.


