Re: ALJ's Proposal for Decision and Proposed Order regarding the application of El Paso Electric Company for Air Quality Permit Nos. 102294 and PSD-TX-1290; TCEQ Docket No. 2012-2608-AIR; SOAH Docket No. 582-13-1520.

This letter concerns the scheduling of oral presentations before the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality's (Commission) deliberation and decision on the above-referenced matter. As previously notified, this matter has been set on the Commission's public meeting scheduled to begin at 9:30 a.m. on **Wednesday, December 11, 2013**. The Commission's meeting will take place in Room 201S of Building E, 12100 Park 35 Circle, Austin, Texas. 30 TAC § 80.263 provides as follows:

In proceedings where a judge has held a public hearing and has issued a proposal for decision or other report to the commission, all oral presentations before the commission shall be limited to five minutes each, excluding time for answering questions, unless the chairman or general counsel establishes other limitations. Before the commission meeting, the general counsel may allot time for oral presentations. Oral presentations and responses to questions shall be directed to the commission.

The Office of General Counsel hereby extends the time for oral argument to 10 minutes for the Applicant and 10 minutes for the Protestants collectively. The Executive Director and the Office of Public Interest Counsel's oral argument time will remain at the 5 minutes each. The Applicant may save some time for rebuttal, as it bears the burden of proof.

Furthermore, if the Commissioners need additional information, they may ask questions of the parties after oral argument is completed. In light of the oral argument time periods previously found sufficient in more complex matters and given the Commissioners' ability to question the parties to clarify any issues, the Office of General Counsel finds that the time period provided to the parties should be sufficient.
